

## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

## Dalby Spring Rodeo

### Dalby Showgrounds, Sunday 14th September 1997

The inaugural Dalby Spring Rodeo will be Dalby's major sporting and community event for the spring of 1997. Although rodeos have been held in Dalby over recent years this will be the first community sponsored and co-ordinated event since the days of the Lions Rodeo's back in the late 70's.

The Committee is keen to provide sponsors and spectators with a professionally run event, electing to run with an Maximum Points NRA programme. We are looking to firmly establish rodeo in Dalby as an attractive spectator sporting option, with plans for this event to be reld annually in the Spring.

Royal Children's Hospital, "Leonard Lodge" has been selected as the events beneficiary. Leonard Lodge provides accommodation free of charge for families of kids from country and regional centres. The Lodge currently has a 98% occupancy rate, thus, the building of an additional 14 units.

Sunday 14th September was selected to run, being the day after Kingaroy, as a convenience to competitors particularly time event competitors hauling stock over the tick line from the coast.

It is a very comfortable 70 minute drive from Kingaroy to Dalby via Kumbia and Bell along the Bunya Highway. Be sure you get fuel in Kingaroy if travelling after dark.

Saturday night, at the showgrounds is Rustlers Grog and Grub Night, with a barbecue, refreshments, music and bonfire from 6.30 pm till late, all competitors and supporters welcome. There is NO cover charge, and only a modest fee for the fare.

Breakfast will be served Sunday, slack starts 7.00 a.m. and main programme 10.00 a.m.

The Committee of Dalby Spring Rodeo invites all members of the N.R.A. to help establish this event on the sporting calendar. This is our challenge.

Looking forward to seeing a strong N.R.A. contingent in Dalby on Sunday 14th September.

## Friendly Reminders

#### **REFERENCE NUMBERS:**

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo.

Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

#### **CANCELLATIONS:**

When cancelling, either by phone or on answering machine you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number, and membership number. Without this information cancellations cannot be processed and will **not** be accepted.

### PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed for (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by **Monday prior to the rodeo** at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc on that particular day. This will ensure your entries will be valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

### **MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:**

If a Medical out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a **medical certificate** must be obtained from the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is manditory.

**Insurance Claims forms**, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer (on the day) and must be completed and faxed through to the office (0754 957384) by **Monday following the Rodeo**.

## ST. VINCENTS STALWARTS

### Brian and Marlene Kofoed











The initial St Vincents Rodeo was held in 1955 at AML&F Yards at Harristown. There have been several venues since these early days, including the Toowoomba Showgrounds, Lindsay Street, and Middle Ridge Park, Stener Street. In 1993 St. Vincents changed the venue of their Rodeo to its present location, Toowoomba Showgrounds.

Brian started on the Committee in 1972 and became President in 1974, supported by his wife Marlene. In those days the Rodeo included a Baby Show, Chocolate Wheels, Raffles, Queen Quest, Foot Races and Side Shows.



St. Vincents Rodeo was always held on the third Sunday in October. About 1980 it was changed to coincide with the Carnival of Flowers, a Sunday in September. St. Vincents have a committee of ten (10) hard working members. The longest serving member is Kevin Hardwick, who has been with the St. Vincents committee since its inception in 1955 including being in the Pick-Up Team from 1956 to 1981.

1996 was the last year a Rodeo Queen Quest was held by the St. Vincents Committee.

In the twenty-two years Brian has been President, he and his committee have donated to St Vincents Hospital in excess of \$350,000.00 which has been spent on specialised equipment for the Hospital.

To Brian, Marlene and their hard working committee, congratulations on a job well done.

## **Central Entry Rules and Guidelines**

### **Entry Times**

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm.** If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number** AND **membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

### Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

**Resignation** from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

### Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$5 day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

### Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

### Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$5 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not.

### **Cancellations**

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the committee levy and \$5 will be paid. After 12 noon Friday NO cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

### **Fines**

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed. Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of \$25.

### **Contractors**

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
