Committee Report

LAIDLEY

Laidley Rodeo Association President Col Litfin is mustering the energy of his committee for the 1998 Charity Rodeo Spectacular on Saturday 28th March 1998.

Col and his committee have two very successful rodeos behind them now - having purchased for Laidley Hospital in 1996 a laser for the physiotherapy department and last year an electro cardiograph machine.

Colin presented the ECG machine to the Hon. Mike Horan, MLA, Minister for Health, himself an enthusiastic rodeo supporter. As well as providing the Laidley Hospital with specialised equipment to the value of some \$6,000, cash donations were also made to ten (10) other local caring agencies, including the two nursing homes and the Ambulance Service.

A new accident and emergency and new outpatients department is in the process of being built and a lift installed at Laidley Hospital. So Colin and his committee won't have any difficulty in finding some special pieces of equipment to purchase to compliment the services provided by these facilities.


A print of Jason Hall on "Crystal" has been enlarged and superbly framed by the Laidley Rodeo Committee Secretary/Treasurer and will hang in a prominent position in the hospital's new building.

We do appreciate the support we have had from N.R.A. members and their families over the past years. You can be assured that the proceeds raised from your contribution to this year's Rodeo Spectacular will be spent wisely.

Prize money will again be equal for Guys' and Gals' events, with the exception of the Bull Ride, which will have a \$500 purse, donated by Joanco feeds of Toowoomba.



Rule Changes

1. Cut Horse Fine:

\$50.00 fine to be allocated \$35.00 to contractor - \$15.00 N.R.A. The animal not to be bucked for 10 days.

2. Junior Day Membership:

- a) Be reduced from \$5.00 to \$2.00
- That local junior competitors be charged a \$2.00 insurance levy but no day membership.
 A local competitor is defined by the shire he/she resides in.

Cancellation:

Cancellation fee of \$5 up to 12 noon Monday preceding the rodeo.

- a) This fee to apply as from 1st January 1998
- b) \$5 is accountable for each cancellation.
- c) The fee is to accumulate to four (4) cancellation fees when they will be charged.
- d) If in the event of these four cancellations not being used in period of one (1) year, the account will be reviewed.

4. Bullfighters categories (A) and (B):

(i) Category (A)

Open Bull Fighter

Category (B)

Must have a Category (A) Bullfighter as part of the team

In the case of a clown who is Bull Riding - a second clown is not necessary

5. Junior Rope & Tie (15 to 18 years):

The time limit be extended from 30 seconds to 45 seconds.

6. Rookie Rodeo Category:

This category to be introduced and to be conducted by bonafide Committees only. \$250 per Event

Rookie or Novice Competitors - Day membership must be paid.



Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 5pm - 9pm. If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING you must give your reference number AND membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$5 day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$5 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not.

Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the committee levy and \$5 will be paid. After 12 noon Friday NO cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed. Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of \$25.

Contractors

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
