President's Report

This being my first report for some time, I would like to commence by thanking all outgoing directors for their efforts, and welcome the new faces.

The board of the N.R.A. now consists of eight (8) Executive Directors, namely President, Operations, Livestock, Finance, Committee, Girls, Rough Stock, Time Events. This Board meets once a month and these meetings are closed. However, if anyone seeks to attend, it is advisable to apply for an invitation. This will be granted if in the opinion of the Board, your request warrants discussing with them.

I will now endeavour to clarify the Board Positions.

President: This position is responsible for the chairing of all meetings, be the Senior Executive Director and be in charge of the Marketing Administrator.

Executive Director of Operations: This position is to oversee the management and smooth running of the Office Procedures and Central Entry Staff.

Executive Director of Finance: This Director is in control of keeping Account Records and payment of same, setting of budgets and compiling returns for Accountants and Government Depts. etc. This position is also responsible for the Junior Administrator.

Executive Director of Livestock Management: Nominated Director of this position has to manage livestock affairs, i.e. attend all meetings pertaining to this position and is also responsible for the Stock Contractors Administrator.

Executive Director of Committees: This position requires Director to have constant contact with committees and represent them at Board level. This Director is responsible for the Judges Administrator.

Executive Director of Girls Events: This position requires Director to represent all Girls Events at Board level, and to conduct meetings with Event Administrators.

Executive Director of Time Events: This position requires the Director to represent all Time Events at Board level and to conduct meetings with Event Administrators.

Executive Director of Rough Stock: This position requires the Director to represent all Rough Stock Events at Board level and conduct meetings with Event Administrators.

The Marketing Administrator: This position which is an appointment by the Board, is to be responsible for raising funds, advertising and is also the Representative of the Rodeo Queens and Princess. This position is answerable to the President.

Event Administrators: Each Event will be represented by an Event Administrator who is answerable to their respective Executive Directors. If a member is looking for advice, at first speak with your administrator and if you don't have satisfaction, then progress up the ladder. Each Executive Director has a direct line of communication with the President.

I trust this explanation will assist all members in their seeking out of the correct procedure should you require help.

We had good support from sponsors in 1997 and I trust the same will apply in 1998. I personally thank each and everyone that supported the N.R.A. last year. To complete this report I would like to congratulate all 1997 Champions and wish each and every member a successful 1998.




Some of the issues addressed during the past year:

- The introduction of a Central Entries Team consisting of five (5) staff used on a roster basis for office duties at rodeos. A communication line has been set up between the N.R.A. Head Office and the Rodeo Central Entry Office to relay information to and from Rodeos. Instructions from Head Office are issued to the Central Entry person on the day. This person is only working with the information received. If you have any queries please discuss with your event director or myself or if need be Head Office will be only too willing to assist wherever possible by contacting them during the week.
- New look newsletter (which I do encourage you the members to become involved e.g. stories, photographs etc.) Note newsletter material deadlines. The newsletter is now being issued by the 2nd week each month.
- New method for renewal of membership with cards processed promptly. (If you have changed your phone number recently, please advise the Central Entry person at a rodeo as there can be times that we need to contact you.)
- Most importantly, a closer relationship and better communication within our Office and between Members and Committees. Please feel free to contact the office whenever necessary.
- N.R.A. / W.A. Communication has been instigated with West Coast Rodeo Circuit in regard to getting feedback concerning Central Entries which may be of benefit to both Associations. If travelling to Western Australia their next Rodeo is 29th March Whiteman Park Maximum Point Rodeo. For further information please contact the W.A. Central Entries as per West Coast Circuit in the front of your newsletter.

To promote rodeo we must sell our sport through all avenues. A professional presentation must be evident throughout our office and in the way in which our members conduct themselves at rodeos.

I would finally like to thank all staff for their co-operation and teamwork throughout 1997.

Friendly Reminders



REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry. If there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure their nomination is correct. Please see your event director if you have a problem. After the commencement of the Rodeo no discrepancies will be looked into.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or an answering machine you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processes and will not be accepted.

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set up by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are in the slack and or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the Competitor, to call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed for (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer (on the day) and must be completed and faxed through to the office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day before the rodeo commences if they require this cover.

Rule Changes

Cut Horse Fine:

\$50,00 fine to be allocated \$35.00 to contractor - \$15.00 N.R.A. The animal not to be bucked for 10 days.

- 2 Junior Day Membership:
 - a) Be reduced from \$5.00 to \$2.00
 - That local junior competitors be charged a \$2.00 insurance levy but no day membership.
 A local competitor is defined by the shire he/she resides in.
- Cancellation:

Cancellation fee of \$5 up to 12 noon Monday preceding the rodeo.

- a) This fee to apply as from 1st January 1998
- \$5 is accountable for each cancellation.
- c) The fee is to accumulate to four (4) cancellation fees when they will be charged.
- If in the event of these four cancellations not being used in period of one (1) year, the account will be reviewed.
- Bullfighters categories (A) and (B):

(i) Category (A) Open Bull Fighter

Category (B) Must have a Category (A) Bullfighter as part of the team

In the case of a clown who is Bull Riding - a second clown is not necessary

5. Junior Rope & Tie (15 to 18 years):

The time limit be extended from 30 seconds to 45 seconds.

Rookie Rodeo Category:

This category to be introduced and to be conducted by bonafide Committees only.

\$250 per Event

Rookie or Novice Competitors - Day membership must be paid.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 5pm - 9pm. If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING you must give your reference number AND membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$2 day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$5 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not.

Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the committee levy and \$5 will be paid. After 12 noon Friday NO cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed. Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of \$25.

Contractors

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
