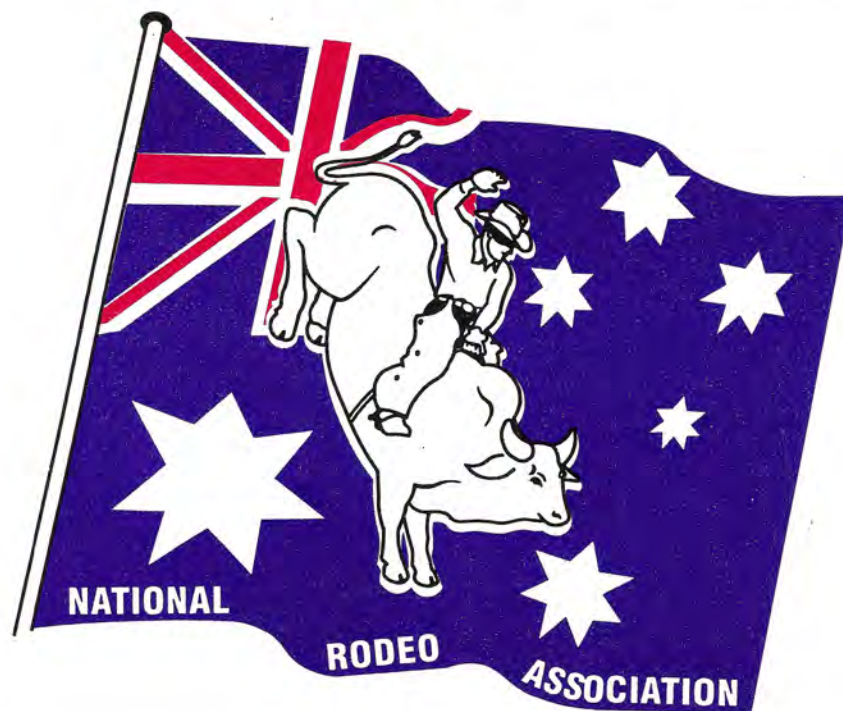

## ***Executive Director Livestock Management's Report***

As most of you will be aware the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) has recently introduced major changes to leisure horse movements across tick lines in Queensland.

Competition horses from the Tick Infected Area no longer require a spray treatment or inspection when travelling to rodeos in the Tick Free and Protected Areas providing they return home within five (5) days. However, competition horses from Tick Free and Protected Areas will still be required to undergo a spray treatment before returning home from a rodeo in the Tick Infected Area.

The Honorary Inspector scheme has now been replaced by the Accredited organisation (Tick Control) scheme which has been developed to allow horse organisations to treat their own members' horses for movement across Queensland Tick lines. Under this scheme, nominated Accredited Tick Control Personnel can perform any required spray treatments on our members' horses. If you are interested in becoming one of the Accredited Tick Control personnel of the NRA please contact me and I will discuss the details with you. A list of Accredited tick Control Personnel will be published under the NRA Contractors' List in the Newsletter when they have been approved by the DPI.

During this initial phase-in period, horses that require spraying will have to go to a DPI Inspection Centre during office hours as our Accredited Tick Control Personnel have yet to attend the compulsory training course and purchase spraying equipment and chemical.

However, to remove the inconvenience of attending a DPI Inspection Centre for spraying, the DPI has recommended that any members residing in the Tick Free and Protected Areas apply to have their stables or horse paddocks registered as a 'Classified Premise'. This then allows you to return home from a rodeo in the Tick Infected Area without first being sprayed provided that you return within five days of leaving and your horse receives a spray treatment within 24 hours of returning to the premises. This spray treatment can be performed by the owner or an authorised person.

To be registered as a 'Classified Premise' the stable or paddock must have a stock free buffer of at least ten metres from the nearest cattle. The DPI has informed me that this does not restrict you from practising on cattle during the week provided that when you return from a rodeo your horse is placed in the 'Classified Premise' and does not leave that area and come into contact with any cattle before it has received the required spray treatment.

## *Executive Director Girls Events Report*

Hello Everybody.

As this is my first report as Girls Executive director, I would like to take this opportunity to bring a couple of things to the attention of all those competing in girls events.

First of all, your new Barrel Racing Administrator is Janice Lancaster. If you have any queries about Barrel Racing, please direct them to your Barrel Racing administrator - Janice.

Your Breakaway Roping and Steer Undecorating Administrator will be myself. As there are very few Steer Undecorating events throughout the year I don't feel there is a need for a special administrator. I will be supplying all the ribbons and glue and would like to guarantee no more problems for steer undecorators so far as ribbons being stuck on is concerned. As there were no votes for Breakaway Roping I will also be responsible for that event.

### **Rule Reminders:**

I would like to remind all ropers that you need three (3) pieces of string in Breakaway Roping, tied to the bottom of your saddle horn. Barrel Racers, as you may or may not be aware, where necessary, depending upon entries and arena conditions, the barrel race may be split into two (2) rounds and possibly at some rodeos a round may be run in the slack. This will only be when the arena is remarked. When the Barrel Race is split in two (2) rounds, the course will then be raked after the first round.

I would also appreciate it if all girls in the Barrel Race can please wait until Central Entries are finished with your time sheets! You may then look at your times. Please do not interrupt the ladies at Central Entries when doing payouts - just look at your times.



Also to clear up a 'so-called' rumour I heard - "The electric timers failed to work at Rosewood Rodeo, therefore a stopwatch was used and the electric timer stands used as a start and finish point for time keepers."

NO! Times were averaged between electric timers and stopwatches! Please approach your administrator or myself in future to get the real facts!

In general I would also like to ask all time event competitors to please be ready and move quickly when called for your run. Our Rodeos are starting to drag - due to the lack of attention from competitors and disorganised chutebosses.

## *Junior Rodeo Report*

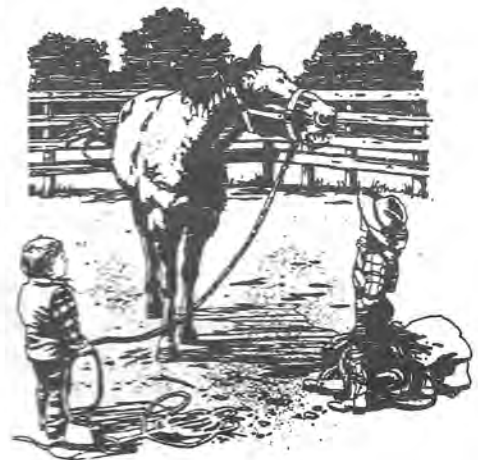
The N.R.A. Board has passed a resolution to change the format of trophies being presented at Junior Rodeos.

## ***Friendly Reminders***

### **REFERENCE NUMBERS:**

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry. If there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

### **NOMINATIONS:**

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure their nomination is correct. Please see your event director if you have a problem. After the commencement of the Rodeo no discrepancies will be looked into.

### **CANCELLATIONS:**

When cancelling, either by phone or an answering machine you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted.

### **SLACK:**

All members please note. Programs are set up by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are in the slack and or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the Competitor, to call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised.

### **PAYMENT OF FINES:**

Any money owed for (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

### **MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:**

If a Medical Out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer (on the day) and must be completed and faxed through to the office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

### **OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE Re INSURANCE:**

For persons officiating in the arena at a rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day before the rodeo commences if they require this cover.

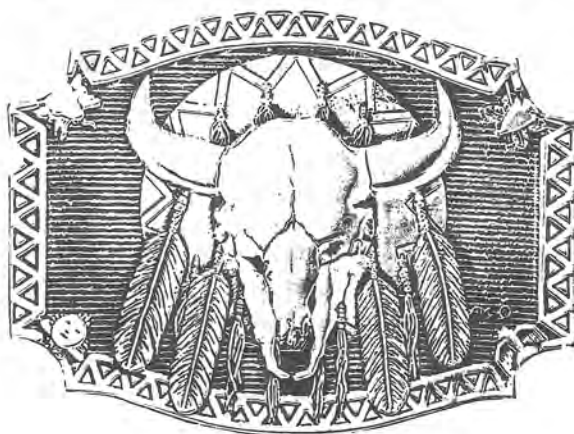


Rookie points will be recorded in the open standings - 'R' beside the competitor's name. Members wishing to be classified as a Rookie must do so in writing to the NRA Office.

Novice points will no longer appear in the standings in the newsletter. They will be tabulated in the office and be available to competitors through Central Entries and the Secretary on the day at Rodeos. As a competitor 'Breaks Open' he or she will be notified in writing from the office and recorded in the 'Break Open' Register. These competitors' names will be published in the monthly newsletter in a Break Open section.



## Rule Changes

1. **Cut Horse Fine:**  
\$50.00 fine to be allocated \$35.00 to contractor - \$15.00 N.R.A. The animal not to be bucked for 10 days.
2. **Junior Day Membership:**
  - a) Be reduced from \$5.00 to \$2.00
  - b) That local junior competitors be charged a \$2.00 insurance levy but no day membership. A local competitor is defined by the shire he/she resides in.
3. **Cancellation:**  
Cancellation fee of \$5 up to 12 noon Monday preceding the rodeo.
  - a) This fee to apply as from 1st January 1998
  - b) \$5 is accountable for each cancellation.
  - c) The fee is to accumulate to four (4) cancellation fees - when they will be charged.
  - d) If in the event of these four cancellations not being used in period of one (1) year, the account will be reviewed.
4. **Bullfighters categories (A) and (B):**
  - (i) Category (A)           Open Bull Fighter
  - Category (B)           Must have a Category (A) Bullfighter as part of the team
 In the case of a clown who is Bull Riding - a second clown is not necessary
5. **Junior Rope & Tie (15 to 18 years):**  
The time limit be extended from 30 seconds to 45 seconds.
6. **Rookie Rodeo Category:**  
This category to be introduced and to be conducted by bonafide Committees only.  
\$250 per Event  
Rookie or Novice Competitors - Day membership must be paid.



## Rookie and Novice

### Rookie Competition

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from **Open Competition only**.

### **Rookie Breaks Open**

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

**ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.**

### Novice Competition

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not before competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points until they **break open** and become an Open member and compete for money only.

**ALL NOVICE COMPETITORS MUST ENTER WITH CENTRAL ENTRIES AS A NOVICE EACH TIME THEY ENTER.**

# Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

## Entry Times

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm**. If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number** AND **membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

## Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

**Unfinancial** members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

**Resignation** from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

## Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. **Men \$15, Ladies \$12** (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and **Juniors \$2** day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by **12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo**. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

## Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

## Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a **\$20 late fine** and **Juniors \$5 late fine**. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not.

## Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of **committee levy plus \$5** (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur **full payment of entry fee** unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the **committee levy and \$5** will be paid. After 12 noon Friday **NO** cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

## Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus **\$25** turn out fine. *No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed.* Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of **\$25**.

## Contractors

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

**ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.**
