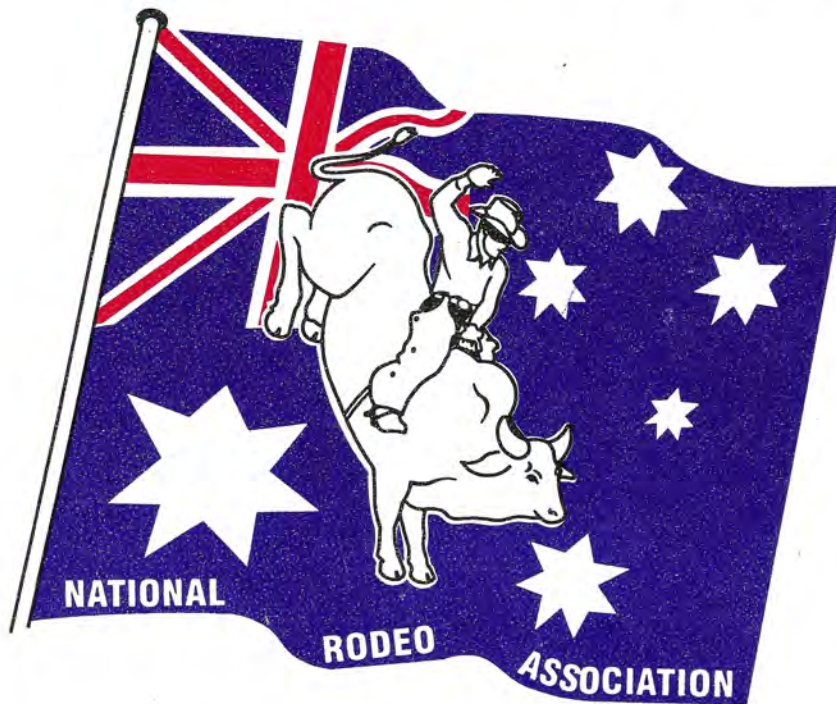

## Reports



### *Friendly reminders to Judges and Competitors*

The new rule book will be out soon so all judges and competitors make sure you are familiar with all the rules.

I know I have had to have talks with some of the Directors and some Competitors about some aspects of Judging. I myself, think some of us (judges) are too lenient with the mark out rule. I don't believe in "I thought he was trying" or "he's only a young fella so I let it go". If they miss the mark out, throw your flag or you could be taking money from someone who did mark his horse out. Just because a horse rears up on his way out, don't weaken. I believe for a horse to foul a rider in the chute enough to waive the mark out, he must pin the cowboy in the back of the chute.

In the Bull Riding, they pay an entry fee the same as all the other events so we should judge them the same way we judge the other rough stock events - from the ground or where you can get a good look at whether or not they get hit on the chute coming out. You can't see it from 30 yards! If you were riding bulls and were hit on the chute gate coming out, I'm sure you would like the judge to be in a position to see it and rule on it.

Also, competitors, if you aren't happy with some of the judging, why not do some judge's sheets and become a judge. We always need more judges.

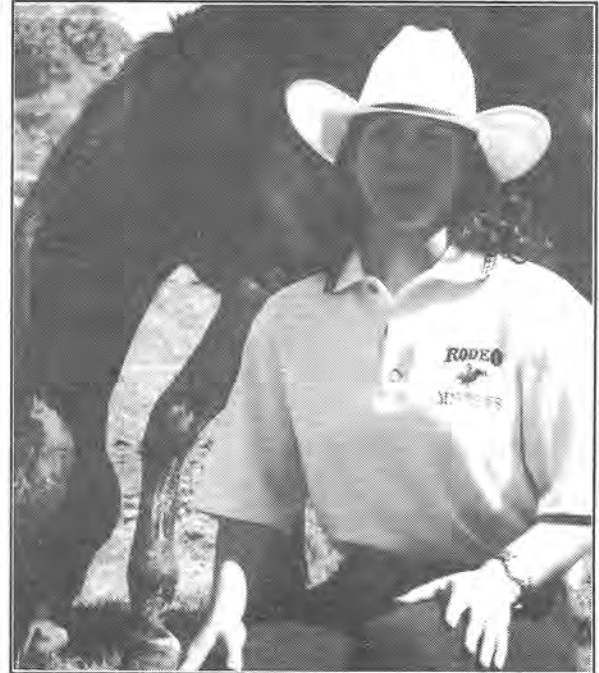

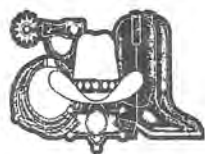
Thanks for your great support last year, the town is looking to see if we can produce the goods again. Safe travelling and a warm welcome to Dalby in the Spring.

## Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

### **Entry Times**

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 5pm - 9pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

### **Members**

When **NOMINATING** you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING**, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

### **Day Members**

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number:

Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$2 day membership (a parent's / guardian's signature is required on the day membership form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

### **Reference Number**

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

### **Late Entries**

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

### **Cancellations**

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

## Rules and Guidelines Contd.

### Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

### Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

### Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility complete the claim forms and deal directly with the insurer: Jardine Sport - 1800 814 830.

### Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

### Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
