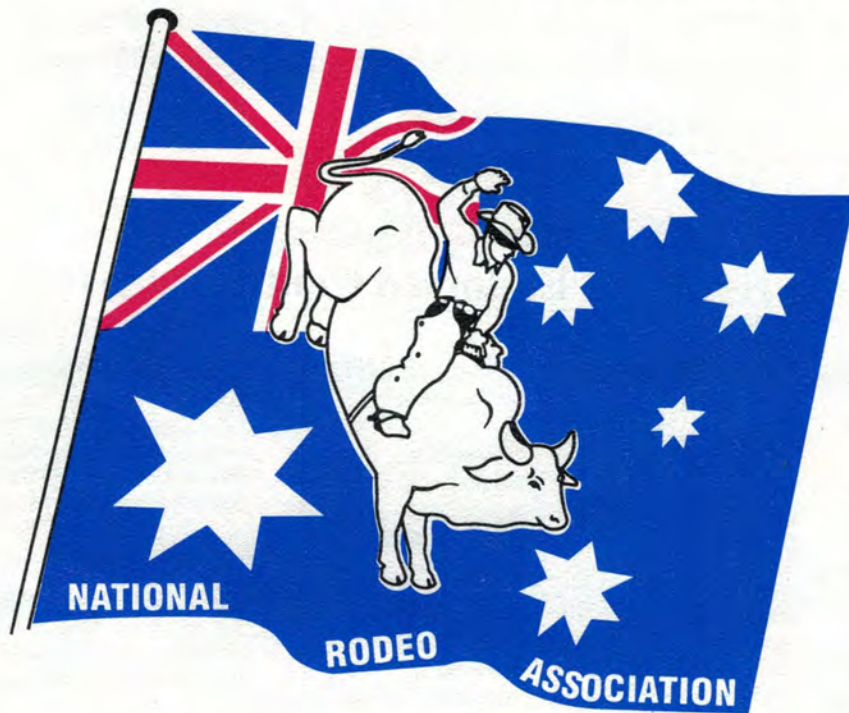

As this system has only just been introduced there are bound to be some hiccups so please be patient and voice any concerns through the appropriate channels. Having said this, however, the feed back received on the computer draws so far has been very positive from both the competitors and officials.

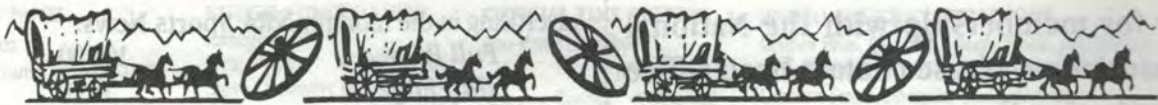
I believe that the introduction of the computer draws will help to strengthen our numbers particularly in the rough stock events. Although turnouts are inevitable, the number of competitors that enter should increase more than enough to outweigh this problem. The reason for this is that cowboys who live some distance away and would not normally travel to NRA rodeos will enter if they know what they are getting on before the rodeo. Hopefully, this should encourage some of the better cowboys who travel around to start entering our rodeos. A better standard of cowboy can only help to increase the standard of our rodeos.

Poddy Riders: Please Note ...

The Animal Welfare Code does not permit the handling of stock in the arena in a Poddy Ride. Contestants may be aided in the chutes. In the Arena the competitor may be aided but the animal must not be handled. No scores will be awarded to aided competitors.



All Bull Riders: (Junior, Novice and Open) A Reminder ...

From 1st April, 1999, it is mandatory that ALL competitors in a Bull Ride Event wear a PROTECTIVE VEST.

Rulebook

The New N.R.A. Rulebook is effective as at 1st May 1999.

Any additional or replacement Rule Books are available by contacting the N.R.A. Office – Price \$5.00.

Re resignation of membership:

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.



Memberships

Memberships received after 1st February will incur a \$10.00 late fee. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. Contractors and Arena officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial.

JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$55.00 (from \$40.00 to \$95.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$50.00 (from \$40.00 to \$90.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE!

--- >>> GST

Nomination fees will increase by 10% to include GST. This is effective as of the 1st August 2000. Not all entry fees have been adjusted so please check on entry of a rodeo for the adjusted nomination fees.

--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors please note – this came into effect as at 1st May. Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

--- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

--- >>> NOMINATION FEE INCREASE:

At the last Executive Board Meeting it was decided that nominations for all open events be increased by .50cents. This increase will cover the costs of Rookie Buckles for the End of Year Titles. (Administrators and competitors will no longer have to cover the costs of these buckles).

On advice from the National Rodeo Council of Australia Competitor Insurance for Bull Ride Events (the highest risk category) has been increased by an extra \$2.00 for Senior Competitors.

This extra insurance will provide an extra \$50.00 per week for loss of income with only a two (2) week waiting period. These increases will come into effect on 30th April 2000.

--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURE:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will advise the Insurance company and you will receive your claim forms from them.
4. The N.R.A. Office will send you Section B declaration which is to accompany your claim form when you return it to the Insurance Co.
5. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to Janelle at the National Rodeo Council on 0755963386.

An Important Announcement

GST

Competitors:

As from the 1st August all nomination fees will increase by 10% to include GST.

Prize money: All prize money is inclusive of GST unless notified by the committee.

Competitors or Arena Staff who have an ABN and are registered for GST will be required to issue the committee with a tax invoice stating their ABN for their prize money / services. It will be up to the individual competitors to remit GST to the tax office if they are running a business.

The procedure for a hobbyist (competitor, arena staff) will be to complete a declaration "Statement by a Supplier" form as provided by the ATO. If the hobbyist fails to provide a signed statement then 48.5% must be withheld by the committee and forwarded to the ATO. These declarations must be dated, contain the name and address of the hobbyist and state they are competing as a hobbyist and signed before payment is received.

Copies of these declarations are available from the NRA Office and will be available at Central Entries at every rodeo.

Committees:

Committees will need an ABN and will need to register for GST if their turnover is more than \$50,000 per annum.

Affiliation fees for 2001 will increase by 10% to include GST.

All Prize money must be inclusive of GST unless otherwise notified by the committee.

Committees must receive either a tax invoice or hobbyist declaration from a competitor or arena staff before that individual is eligible to collect their prize money / services. If a tax invoice or signed declaration is not received the committee must withhold 48.5% and remit it to the ATO.

It is a requirement of the ATO that tax invoices and declarations are kept by the committee for a period of five (5) years.

Unregistered committees will not be able to claim input tax credit for services they paid out for their rodeo.

Rules for Computer Draws

COMPUTER DRAWS

Computer draws will be conducted at the NRA office for maximum point and full point rodeos only. Stock draws will be done for all open rough stock events and position draws will be done for all other events. Stock draws for relevant time events will be conducted on the day of the rodeo.

STOCK NUMBERS

Stock contractors will be contacted by the NRA office on the Tuesday morning before the rodeo and will be advised of the numbers in each event. The stock contractor must then contact the NRA office before noon on that day with the relevant stock numbers for each event. All stock must be registered with the NRA office before they can be included in the draw. All stock must be clearly numbered when they arrive at the rodeo.

RERIDE NUMBERS

It is the responsibility of the chute boss to obtain the reride numbers from the stock contractor on the day of the rodeo, before the commencement of the event.

CALL BACK

Call back will be available during normal Central Entry hours.

SUBSTITUTE STOCK

If a head of stock is withdrawn from an event, after the draw has been conducted, the contestant who had that head of stock drawn shall be drawn another head of stock from the entire pen, including the replacement stock. The contestant that has their head of stock drawn away will then get the replacement stock. If there is more than two head of stock replaced then a complete redraw shall be conducted.

TURN OUT FINES

Any contestant who withdraws from an event after the stock draw has been done will incur a turn out fine.

MULTIPLE ROUNDS

Where an event is to be conducted over two or more rounds, draws will not be carried out for the second round until the completion of the first round and so on.

PREFERENCES

Preferences will be accepted and given where possible for all events where a position draw only is done before the rodeo. For any events that have a stock draw done before the rodeo it will be up to the contestant to trade out after the draw has been completed.

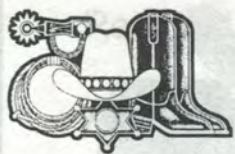

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event administrator.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. **PLEASE check cancel out penalties in Central Entry Guidelines.**

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to the call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo.

This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed - (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE – Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

Rookie points will be recorded in the open standings - 'R' beside the competitor's name. Members wishing to be classified as a Rookie must do so in writing to the NRA Office.

Novice points will no longer appear in the standings in the newsletter. They will be tabulated in the office and be available to competitors through Central Entries and the Secretary on the day at Rodeos. As a competitor 'Breaks Open' he or she will be notified in writing from the office and recorded in the 'Break Open' Register. These competitors' names will be published in the monthly newsletter in a Break Open section.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number:

Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$2 day membership (a parent's / guardian's signature is required on the day membership form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday. Claim forms will be sent directly from the insurer Jardine Sport - 1800 814 830.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
