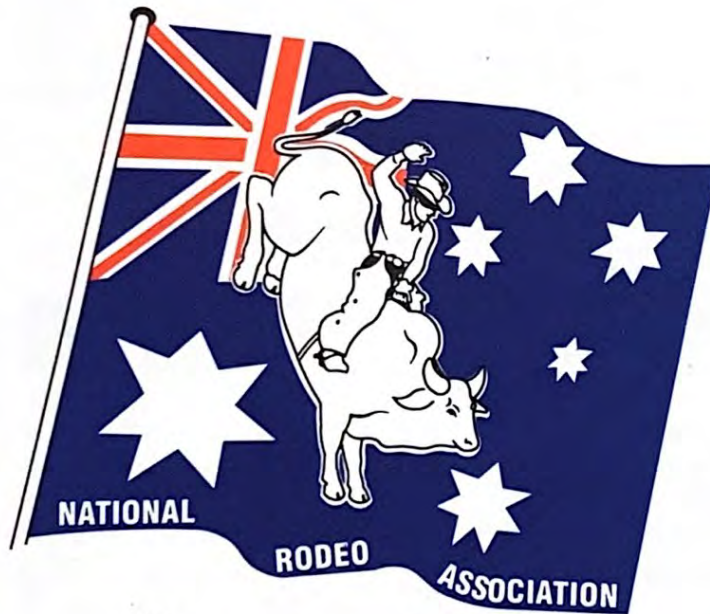

Executive Director's Report

GIRLS' EVENT DIRECTOR: *Maryanne Powell*

Over half the year has already gone, but with still a lot more rodeos to come, and the fight for titles is well underway. And a fight to the very end it will be for some titles up for grabs – it should make for great excitement going into the finals! Good luck to all that are contending for the 2000 titles, as well as the Jim Beam series and finals Aggregates. The Aggregate titles should hold much prestige this year with the possibility of 5 rounds of finals.

So much has happened this first half of the year with the introduction of the *automatic entry system and the computer draws*. The automatic entry system alleviates a lot of pressure for those of you that are unable to reach a telephone between the central entry times. If you have not taken advantage of this system, I strongly urge you to do so. You can still cancel out of Rodeos: regulations for this are as per central entries cancel out procedures. Also do not forget that you can add or delete to your automatic entry system any time you wish. Contact the office regards to an entry form, and simply send them the original (no faxes please).

The computer draws have been up and running now for some time, so remember that you can telephone the office during office hours on the Friday before the Rodeo to find your position draw. It is hoped that before too long that you will also be able to find out your stock numbers as well. The automatic entry and computer draw systems have been installed for the use of you, the members, so please use them.

Early May saw the judging of the Rodeo Queen Quest (NRCA Queen & NRA Queen), on the Gold Coast. The girls were judged for an entire week whilst at the Coast, and participated in an interview most of the day Friday. The awards banquet was held at Legends Hotel on the Gold Coast. At the banquet the girls were again judged whilst being interviewed on stage in front of the audience. Both Andrew White and myself had the privilege of taking part on the judge's panel. A great time was had by all at the banquet, and it was tremendous to see NRA members there in force. I am sure that we were the rowdiest lot there whooping and hollering for all the girls. If you have not taken the opportunity to attend the Queen Banquet, then you should really consider next year if you enjoy a good night out.

June saw the revival of the NR junior Committee, NRA actually had such a program many years ago, but fell by the way side due to the fact that majority of the kids graduated to Adults, and there were no longer parents willing to take on the time consuming task of being on the Junior Committee. Due to much interest generated by our members, interested parties were invited to show their expression of interest in reforming the Juniors. Much interest was shown, and a meeting was set up with these interested parties, and committee was formed. The NRA Executive Board decided to support this Junior Committee by giving them \$5,000 to get started. The NRA will be running an open Rodeo on Sunday September 10th at Rosewood, with a Juniors Rodeo the day before. These two Rodeos are totally NRA members run rodeos, and it is therefore required that as many members as possible turn up Saturday morning 9th September, to help with setting up. I also ask that all Administrators make themselves available to the juniors for the Junior Rodeo, as well as any other adult competitors. These children need our guidance and schooling and every bit of help you can give, whether it be advice, pulling ropes or just running up stock, will be very appreciative. Remember that most of these kids all look up to you, and you are their idols, so what about making their day and being there for them at their Junior Rodeos. Should you wish to contribute to the Juniors please contact Ken Pennell. You can find Ken listed inside the front page of the NRA news.

The 2001 NRA Princess winner will be announced at the Caboolture Finals on December 2nd. Entries close this year August 27th, and entry is FREE. These girls have a great time, and is also a great opportunity for girls to get to know the others better. Should you be interested or know of someone who is, please see Rebecca Eldridge (NRA Princess) for an entry form. If you miss her at a Rodeo she can be contacted by looking inside the front cover of the NRA news.

Judges are still being approached by members who want to argue the point on the judge's decision. Let me remind everyone that you do not have a right to approach a judge. Should you have a problem the correct procedure is to approach your Administrator. This is why we have Administrators. If the situation cannot be solved at that level, then the Administrator will take it to the respective Director. If it still cannot be solved on that level, then it is taken to the Board. However when it is a situation that requires speaking to a judge, then have your Administrator do so. Judges do have the power to fine you. Approaching the Judges without consent applies in all sports.

If you are having a problem or if you believe that you have a good idea, then do not hesitate to contact me. I would be only too happy to take it to the Board for you.

In closing let me say I am personally very proud of our Association. No other Association offers as much as the NRA do by way of Trophy Saddles and Trophy Buckles. We are also an Association that thinks of our future, and has moved into the new millennium with a positive structure.

Each year competition seems to get better, and never before has it been so evident as it is this year. Well done everyone – keep up the great work. With competitive attitudes like you have, our sport will only get bigger, better and more prestigious. Your strive to be better makes our Association the *great* one that it is!

Rulebook

The New N.R.A. Rulebook is effective as at 1st May 1999.

Any additional or replacement Rule Books are available by contacting the N.R.A. Office – Price \$5.00.

Re resignation of membership:

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.



Memberships

Memberships received after 1st February will incur a \$10.00 late fee. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. Contractors and Arena officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial.

JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$55.00 (from \$40.00 to \$95.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$50.00 (from \$40.00 to \$90.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE!

--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors please note – this came into effect as at 1st May. Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

--- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

--- >>> NOMINATION FEE INCREASE:

At the last Executive Board Meeting it was decided that nominations for all open events be increased by .50cents. This increase will cover the costs of Rookie Buckles for the End of Year Titles. (Administrators and competitors will no longer have to cover the costs of these buckles).

On advice from the National Rodeo Council of Australia Competitor Insurance for Bull Ride Events (the highest risk category) has been increased by an extra \$2.00 for Senior Competitors.

This extra insurance will provide an extra \$50.00 per week for loss of income with only a two (2) week waiting period. These increases will come into effect on 30th April 2000.

--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURE:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will advise the Insurance company and you will receive your claim forms from them.
4. The N.R.A. Office will send you Section B declaration which is to accompany your claim form when you return it to the Insurance Co.
5. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to Janelle at the National Rodeo Council on 0755963386.

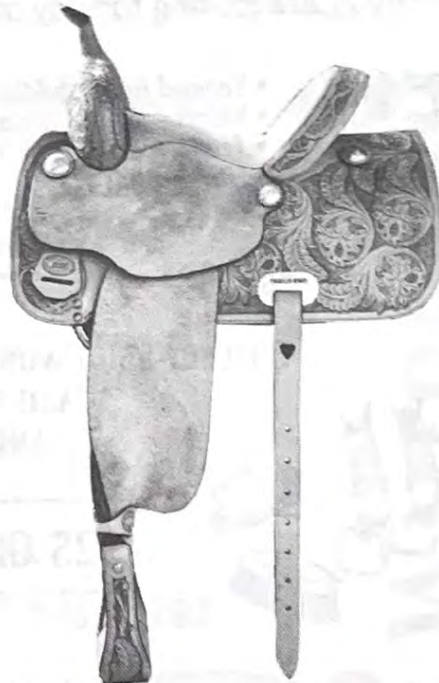

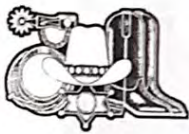

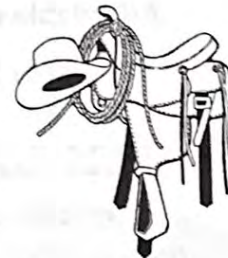

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event administrator.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. **PLEASE check cancel out penalties in Central Entry Guidelines.**

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo. This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed - (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.
