This is only available on the day of the rodeo for the competitors in case of emergencies only. This is not to be used for entries or any other inquiries as it is in operation only on days rodeos are scheduled and is answered by the Central Entries person for that day NOT THE OFFICE.

Automatic Entry

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.

Gate Entry

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone elses name.

RULE ADDITION: Team Roping

- 4. The team cannot compete in the same event twice except multiple head contests.
- 11. In a team roping contest when the header fails to attach his rope to the beast the heeler is not to contest the competition any further.

Failure to comply with this rule will result in an instant fine.

12. Members fifty years of age and over are permitted to tie their ropes (Hard and Fast) on the saddle horn.



BARREL RACE: Amendments

Excessive whipping will be classed as no more than two (2) strikes going to each drum and four on the way home. This will be the decision of the judge officiating. NO SETTING UP OF THE DRUMS IN THE ARENA ON THE DAY OF THE RODEO.

STEER UNDECORATING:

7. Time is completed when the competitor's hand is raised with the ribbon above the shoulder after the ribbon is taken from the steers back. Ribbon must be kept in hand and returned to the time keeper for a valid time.

PLEASE NOTE:

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc).

Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00noon Thursday.

CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership (pages 4, 5 and 6).

Insurance Procedures

If you are injured at a rodeo -

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

- 1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
- 2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this
- 3. The N.R.A. Office will advise the Insurance company and you will receive your claim forms from them.
- 4. The N.R.A. Office will send you Section B declaration which is to accompany your claim form when you return it to the Insurance Co.
- 5. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to Janelle at the National Rodeo Council on 0755963386.



JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00)to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.



Director's Report

N.R.A. Executive Director Committees Management – *Steve Browne*

G'day and welcome to what is shaping up to be another big year.

It's good to see new committees coming aboard this year. With some big prizemoney on offer this year, we are bound to see it bring out the best in everybody. So, in saying this it's up to the competitors to show their support to these new committees and help them to make it a better rodeo.

To all the committees, it's great to see all the committees hat have run with us for so many years and the ones that are new to N.R.A. It's excellent to see your continuing support, not just the N.R.A. but to the cowboys and cowgirls as well, because without you committees there would be no rodeos and wouldn't it just be a boring world to live in!

I wish to make a special mention to committees of arena conditions. These must be safe for the competitors and stock as well.

Arenas:-

All arenas used for rodeos are to be stock proof, including suitable fencing to prevent the escape of any animal from the arena or yarding facilities.

- (a) The arena must be completely top dressed or ripped to a minimum of 75mm and a maximum of 100mm.
- (b) Portable arena sizes to comply with recommendations of N.R.A.
- (c) (i) Suitable transport is to be available in the case of injury of stock.
- (ii) Suitable gate entrances are to be available for the moving of injured competitors.

If Arena conditions do not meet the above requirements your rodeo may not be allowed to proceed. In closing, I would like this opportunity to pledge everyone's support behind the Juniors in Rodeo, not just at rodeos but in helping them to get more Junior Rodeos for the kids.

So if you know of any committees or individuals who would be interested in running a Junior Rodeo, please do not hesitate to get them to contact our office. We have directors who would be more than willing to arrange a meeting to discuss Junior Rodeos with you. Without the Juniors there will be no rodeos in the future!

So until the chute gates fly open!

Re Pro Masters Rodeo

The Board of the National Rodeo Association Ltd, has after due consideration made a decision not to submit a team for this event.

Our reason for not participating was based on a number of concerns, some of which are outlined in this report.

Some of you have been advised by the N.R.C.A. that the N.R.A. received \$1.00 per entry from our members to assist in the funding of the Promasters. The N.R.A. at no time applied such levy and advised the N.R.C.A. it would not be doing so. Our reason for not charging such a levy was, we believe, members pay enough now and such an event should not rely on Rodeo Competitors to fund their own prizemoney.

We voiced our dissatisfaction with the venue chosen, prior to the final decision being made, of which the N.R.A. were not asked for any input only money to help finance

this promotion.

As a Board we are not prepared to put members funds at risk and the possible future of N.R.A. If this promotion, not be successful, this could well be the case.

A major concern is the promoting of this Event as a National Final with not all Associations competing. We believe this falls short of such claims, and if this type of promoting continues, it may result in legal action, of which we want no part. A lack of communication in the early days of planning this event is also another reason for our withdrawal.

This letter is to advise you that the National Rodeo Association Ltd does not in any way wish to be associated with the Pro Masters Rodeo Event to be held at Carrara.

Our Association does not intend to take any part in this event.

We have not and do not intend to officially endorse any of our members to take part in this event and any such person does so in his/her private capacity and not as a representative nor with the sponsorship or support of this Association.

You do not have permission to use the name of our Association in any way to promote this event. We would consider any propertied use of the N.R.A. endorsement of the event as detrimental to our interests and if any such action were to occur, the appropriate proceedings would be taken to obtain redress.

On behalf of the Board, I hope this report will give members an insight to our actions and whilst the N.R.A. cannot stop individuals from competing at the Promasters, we strongly recommend for your protection, you would be wise not to compete.

Any person or persons that represent the N.R.A. may result in legal action being taken.

To close this report I would like you to read this letter forwarded to the Secretary of N.R.C.A.

Our reason for the decision, is in the Board's opinion the National Rodeo Council of Australia is not a true representation of Rodeo in this country.

It is the Board's opinion we as an Association would be better served to continue our discussions with the APRA, ABCRA AND CRCA, with the view to forming a closer relationship with the top end of Rodeo.







Friendly Reminders

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event administrator.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. *PLEASE* check cancel out penalties in Central Entry Guidelines.

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to the call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo.

This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed - (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or withour a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday. Claim forms will be sent directly from the insurer Jardine Sport - 1800 814

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

• A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.

A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
 Points are accrued from Open Competition Only.
 (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).

A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

(1) Wins a title

(2) Accrues 1000 points in an event

(3) Completes second year of membership


