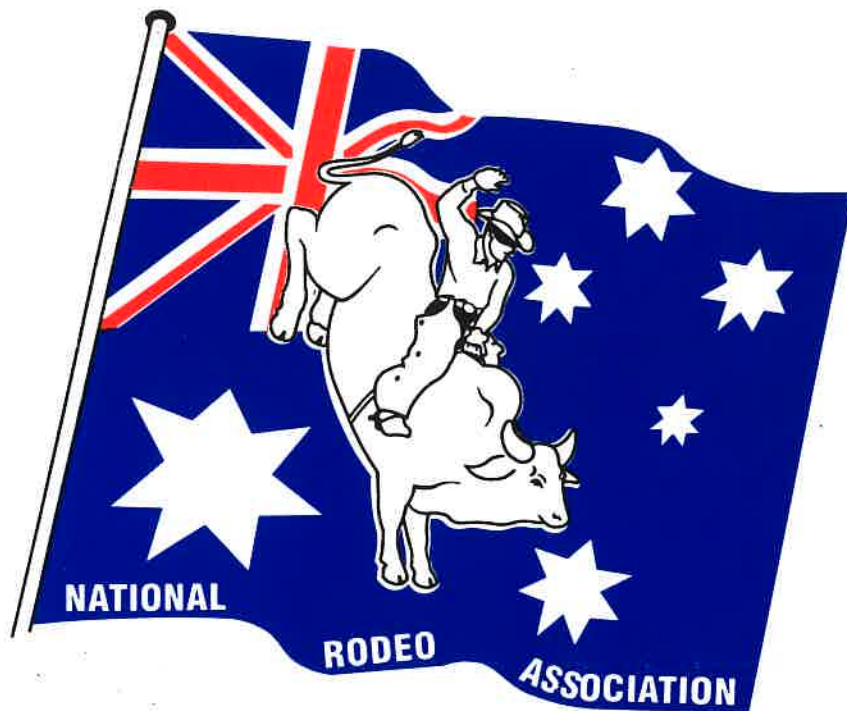

Changes to DPI Tick Inspection Services

What are the changes?

The Department will introduce charges for tick inspection services from 1 August 2002 in Queensland and will allow the progressive introduction of commercial operators - trained and accredited by DPI - to deliver these services.

When will this happen?

A user-pays system will be phased in between July 2002 to July 2004. Weekend services will be provided as soon as available trained operators are in place. Off-line clearance centres will be able to have commercial operators from 1 October 2002. Additional service providers will be trained and operational from 1 January 2003 to undertake on-property inspections, with the progressive phasing in of commercial providers for weekday services. The plan is to have a full 'user pays' system with accredited commercial operators from 1 July 2004.

How will it benefit primary producers?

The use of commercial operators will mean competitive pricing and an increase in services to clients, including more flexible services and delivery options such as on-property services and weekend clearances. Livestock owners who transfer cattle from one property to another will gain advantage out of the development of 'on-property' inspection services which will remove the necessity for handling and holding cattle at the tick line. This service will also enhance the welfare of the livestock being moved.

Why change the system?

The Government has decided to transfer this subsidy from the tick services to the priority area of pest and disease protection over the next three years. The changes will allow DPI to provide more resources for preparing for, detecting and containing any introduced exotic pest and disease. Both government and industry recognise that the protection of Queensland's primary production environment is of the highest priority. Enhanced disease and protection and market assurance programs will help meet the increasing demands of markets. For example, it is estimated that a moderate outbreak of foot and mouth disease (FMD), which would lock out Australia from FMD-free markets for six years, would cost the Queensland economy \$9.5 billion.

DPI will:

- focus research on emerging diseases to enhance the capacity for timely and expert responses;
- train departmental staff for effective responses to all disease emergencies;
- employ additional pathologists to ensure DPI has the capacity in the short and long term to adequately diagnose significant disease events;
- employ additional vets and stock inspectors to improve DPI's capacity to investigate suspect cases, improve the early detection system and response to incidents;
- employ specialist compliance officers allowing implementation of a best practice compliance system for disease and pest protection. This will ensure industry and the community comply with regulatory risk reduction measures;
- invest in state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment and facilities to boost the speed and scale of testing;
- improve laboratory and field-based information systems to better handle surveillance and response strategies; and
- undertake public education and awareness campaigns to inform of the risk reduction strategies aimed at preventing an FMD outbreak in Queensland.



Who will oversee the changes?

DPI will support the changes through the establishment of a Transition Committee that will talk with stakeholders such as industry groups to ensure an efficient system is established. The committee will be chaired by the DPI Deputy Director-General with support from the Executive Director, DPI Animal and Plant Health Service.

How will it work?

Commercial operators will be audited by the DPI. The training, accreditation and auditing of the operators will be an expanded role for the department's inspectors. DPI will maintain a monitoring role over the whole service to ensure the goal of maintaining the cattle tick-free area is achieved.

How will commercial operators be chosen?

The actual procedures will be worked through by the Transition Committee. A likely process is that expressions of interest will be sent out requesting submissions from interested companies and individuals.

What about my local stock inspector?

Your local stock inspector will continue to operate in the same area. However, they will focus more on investigating suspect cases, improving the early detection system for exotic pests and disease and responding to incidents.

Are there other effects on my area?

The introduction of commercial operator arrangements will create additional job opportunities for people in regional centres.

Fees and Charges Schedule for Cattle Tick Inspection Services for implementation from 1 August 2002

The new schedule of charges for Cattle Tick Inspection services as at 1 August 2002 (NB: Information is correct as of July 12, but may be subject to change) is as follows:

General

Fees

Standard hourly inspection fee of \$84 per hour to apply.

Stock

Fees and charges will apply to inspections of cattle, sheep, goats, horses, donkeys, buffalo, deer and the camelids (including camels, alpaca, llama, vicuna).

Weekday cattle tick inspection

(for livestock in the cattle tick infected area inspected at existing on-line clearance centres)

Hourly rate applied with 15 min intervals:

1 July 2002 — \$28/hour (\$7 per 15 minutes).

1 July 2003 — \$56/hour (\$14 per 15 minutes).

1 July 2004 — \$84/hour (\$21 per 15 minutes).

Subject to CPI increases.

Note: Special rate of 1.5 times the standard hourly rate to apply to inspections of large mobs, when two inspectors are required.

On-property cattle tick inspection

(from properties in the infected area during normal business hours Monday to Friday)

- 1 January 2003 — \$84/hour with a minimum 1hour charge and 15 minute increments thereafter. Includes travel time, which may be shared between multiple jobs.
- Third party providers to be trained and accredited by DPI.

Off line Clearance Centres - Charters Towers and Gracemere

- 1 October 2002 — \$84/hour with 15-minute increments thereafter and a minimum charge of half an hour. Capacity to share costs of the call out between clients.
- Third party providers to be trained and accredited by DPI.

All out of hours cattle tick inspections

- 1 August 2002 — \$168/hour with a minimum 1 hour charge and 15 minute increments thereafter including travel time, plus \$60 call-out fee where done on property. The travel and callout costs may be shared between clients.

Note: These charges will be introduced over the period 1 October to 31 December 2002 for existing approved out-of-hours services involving cattle requiring inspection prior to sale, stud cattle destined for shows, and horses crossing the tick line at designated points.

New voluntary cattle tick eradication schemes

1 August 2002 — full costs of cattle tick inspections in any new voluntary cattle tick eradication schemes to be paid for by the participating parties. Fees for existing schemes to remain unchanged.

Associated cattle tick service fees

- Yard fees for DPI-owned facilities — \$1 per head.
- Existing scheduled fees for livestock treatments such as dipping and spraying will remain in place but will be reviewed between 1 August and 31 December 2002.

Director's Report

Dear Member,

Over the last few weeks the NRA office has received a number of enquiries regarding this RNA rodeo. On behalf of the board of directors of the NRA I would like to advise that the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Society (RNA) is conducting a rodeo in 2002. The NRA has affiliated this event for the past five (5) years. However, this year the RNA has decided to move the event back to the main show ring and, in addition change the event's format. The NRA was invited to submit a proposal for the running of this year's rodeo.

I have included in this advice the letter from the RNA in response to the NRA's proposal. I draw your attention to the statement in the letter that the event will be conducted on "the grassed surface without modification". I have also included for your information the NRA's response to the RNA's request.

Copy of letter from the RNA:

The Horse & Arena Committee of the RNA is considering conducting a rodeo in the main show ring at the Royal Queensland Show this year. The rodeo would run from Saturday 10 August to Saturday 17 August inclusive. The event will, if it goes ahead, be run on the grassed surface without modification.

We are seeking quotations for the provision of the necessary chutes and adjacent yards (but no arena – (similar to the Sydney Royal Easter Show), 5 bulls, 5 saddle horses and 5 bareback horses each night. An estimate of the set up and pull down time should be included. A price per day is also requested, in case a decision to run less days is taken. Please take into account that stock may have to be held off site until at least Wednesday 14th August.

In a separate quotation we would ask that you include the cost of riders fees, prizemoney and related costs, should you be in a position to arrange the whole event. Quotations are required by 30 April so an early decision can be made on the total ring program

Copy of NRA reply:

Dear Mr. Sturgess

Re: 2002 Ekka Rodeo

I refer to your letter dated the 19 April 2002, in relation to the proposed 2002 Ekka Rodeo. Firstly, I would like to clarify the National Rodeo Association's (NRA) position concerning rodeo promotions.

The NRA is a recognised body that oversees the running of rodeo promotions. The NRA does not submit quotes to run rodeo promotions as requested in your letter. It does however, provide affiliated committees with access to rodeo promoters who provide this service. Secondly, the NRA cannot become involved in a promotion, which does not comply with our rules and regulations and is in breach of the Animal Welfare Code of Conduct for the Care and Treatment of Rodeo Livestock. Namely, running a rodeo on solid ground.

In closing, on behalf of the Board of Directors I wish you every success with the 2002 Ekka, and hope that we may be able to be of assistance in the future.

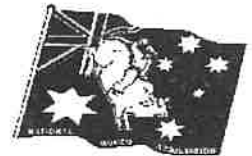

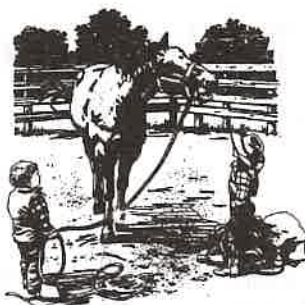

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

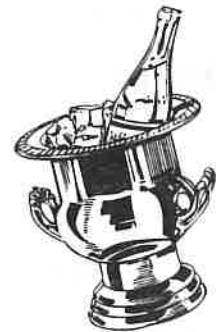
