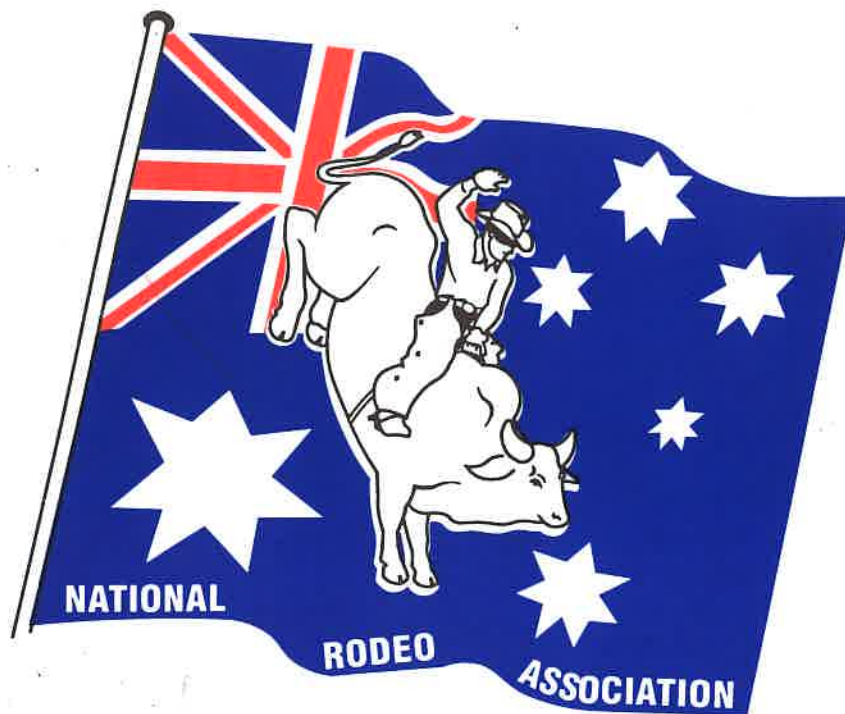

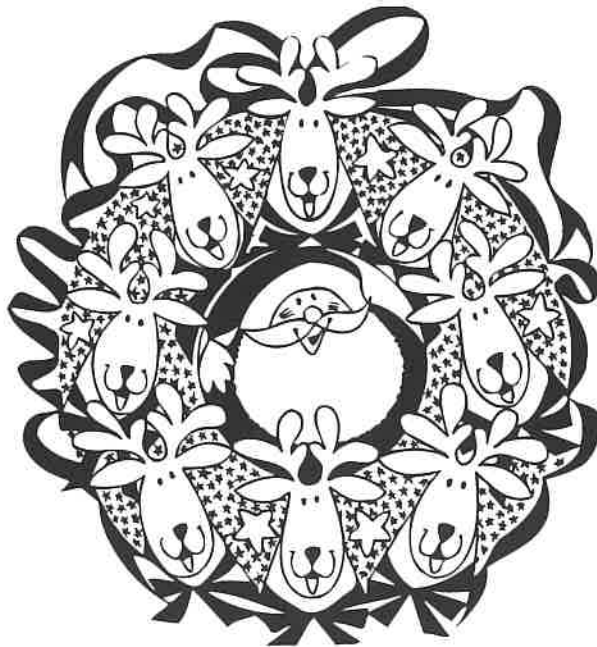

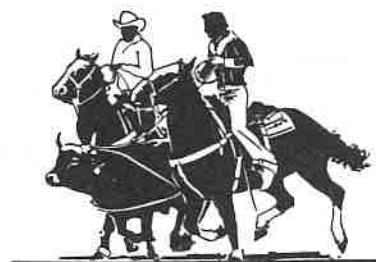

## JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

**JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.**

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

*If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.*

## MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE

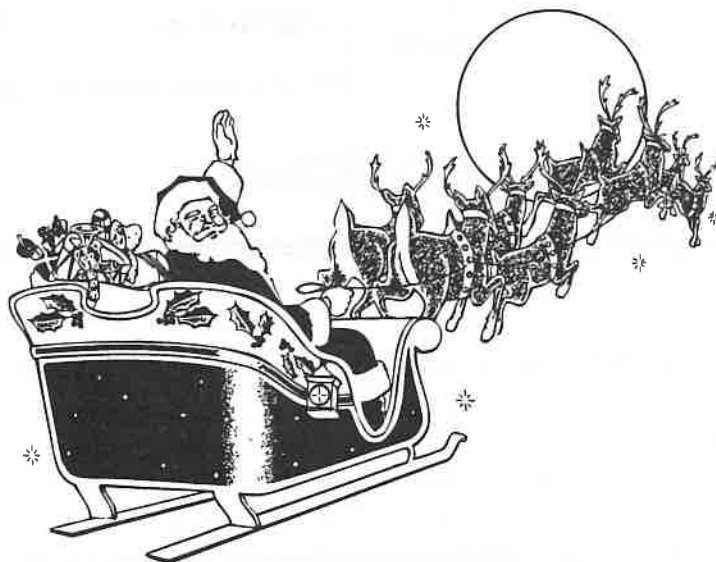
Dear Member,

The board of directors of the NRA wish to advise you of the changes to the Team Roping Event for the 2003 season. Initially the board resolved to include Team Roping as a Standard or Compulsory event in 2003. However, at the Special General Meeting on 2/11/02 at Caboolture, a number of issues were raised by members in relation to this decision. Although the issues raised were ineligible to be voted on at this meeting, the board concluded that the points of concern were valid and the decision to include Team Roping as a Standard or Compulsory event in 2003 be reconsidered. After a lengthy discussion at a recent executive meeting held on the 23rd November 2002.

*The board resolved that:*

- (a) Team Roping would remain as an optional event in 2003.*
- (b) A Trophy Saddle would be awarded to the Champion Header and Champion Heeler in 2003.*
- (c) The points system reviewed giving the highest points from Team Roping Maximum points to the All Round Standings – i.e. if a Team Roper gets 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Team Roping 160 points go to the All round standings.*
- (d) Undertake a review of the impact of option (b) in relation the potential increase/decrease in competitor numbers.*
- (e) Undertake a survey of our existing committees on the financial benefits of conducting the team-roping event.*
- (f) Undertake a review of the existing categories of NRA rodeos. Ie: The allocation of points/number of events conducted Vis prizemoney structures.*
- (g) Present results of options d, e and f to members at a Special General Meeting to be held in late 2003.*

## ***MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE***

Dear Member,

*I wish to advise you of the resolution passed by members at the Special General Meeting held at Caboolture on Saturday 02/11/02. The members present resolved to accept the motion to restructure the NRA Board.*

The new board will be structured in the following manner:

1. **Executive Board** will be reduced from a president and seven directors to a president or CEO and four directors. Up to three directors will be elected by the members. At least two directors shall be appointed to the board. These appointed positions may be filled with persons who are not members of the association. The executive board will elect the president/CEO. The term of office will be three years. One of the three elected positions will be up for election each year.
2. **Ordinary Board** of ten directors will be established. A ballot shall be conducted for the election of ordinary directors. The ordinary directors will elect the chairman of board. (The chairman may be elected from either the directors of the executive or the ordinary boards). The term of office will be for two years. One half of the board will be up for election each year. In the first year one half of the board will be elected for one year only.

### ***Responsibilities of the Board***

#### **Executive Board**

*The executive board will be responsible for the strategic direction of the NRA. It will manage the:*

- Financial affairs of the company
- Marketing Strategies
- Office operations and administration
- Memberships and Committees
- Animal Welfare at the strategic level

The executive board will meet at least monthly.

#### **Ordinary Board**

*The ordinary directors will be responsible for the operational issues related to the conduct of rodeos. It will manage the day to day issues relating to:*

- The conduct of rodeos in accordance with association's Memorandum & Articles, Rules and Regulations and the Animal Welfare Code of Conduct
- Appointment and removal of NRA Officials. Ie: Judges, Contractors, Chute Bosses, Bullfighters etc, in accordance with the NRA rules & regulations
- Issue fines for misdemeanour offences in accordance with the NRA rules & regulations. Serious breaches will be forwarded to the Chairman of Judiciary for action in accordance with the NRA's Judicial Procedures.

The ordinary board will meet at least quarterly or as often as the chairman deems necessary. The chairman will after each meeting of the ordinary directors submit a report to the executive board of the issues or decisions discussed.

*Contd.*

It would be prudent at this point to explain the reasons behind the decision to implement this new structure.

1. To gain a better representation of members on the board of your association
2. To enable the executive to focus on the strategic issues relating to the company
3. To enable the people at the coalface to have a say in day to day running of the association

## ELECTION OF NEW DIRECTORS

Under the Memorandum of Articles the current board will remain until the next Annual General Meeting, which will be held in February 2003. All nominations received for election to the current executive have been declared null and void.

In this month's newsletter there is a notice of the vacant positions on both boards. All full and life members are eligible to nominate for any of these positions. Nominations will close at 4:00PM 31 December 2002.

I should point out that any current executive that has not completed their term is automatically appointed to the executive for the remainder to their term.

Upon receipt of nominations ballot papers will be issued to all full and life members and committees (one vote per committee). The closing date for the elections will be 3:00 PM 31 January 2003. Members should note that only those full members who have paid their 2003 membership will be eligible to vote.

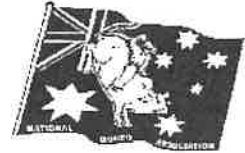

### --- >>> MEMBERSHIP:

**A reminder that membership are due 1<sup>st</sup> January.** Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2003 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial).

Membership renewals are included in this newsletter.

Memberships received after the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2003 will incur a \$10 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1<sup>st</sup> March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

### *Please read carefully!*



#### --- >>> **TIMEKEEPERS:**

Committees, Promoters are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

#### --- >>> **RODEO CALL BACK:**

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

#### --- >>> **CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:**

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

#### --- >>> **AUTOMATIC ENTRY:**

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated. **Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.**

#### --- >>> **GATE ENTRY:**

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

#### --- >>> **COMMITTEES:**

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION. If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2002 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

#### --- >>> **INSURANCE PROCEDURES:**

If you are injured at a rodeo –

**ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

#### --- >>> **CENTRAL ENTRIES HOTLINE: 0412725319**

This is only available on the day of the rodeo for the competitors in case of emergencies only. This is not to be used for entries or any other inquiries as it is in operation only on days rodeos are scheduled and is answered by the Central Entries person for that day NOT THE OFFICE.

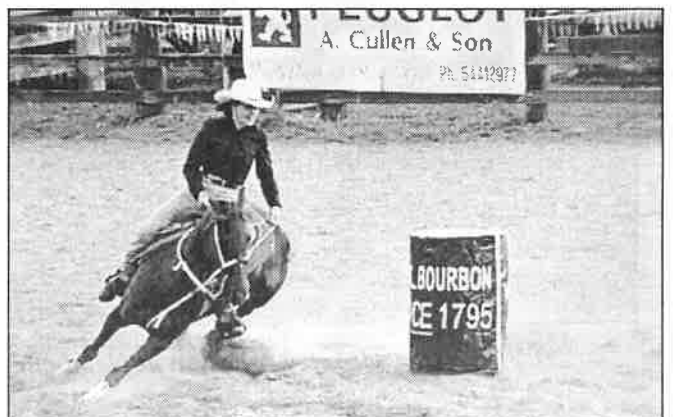
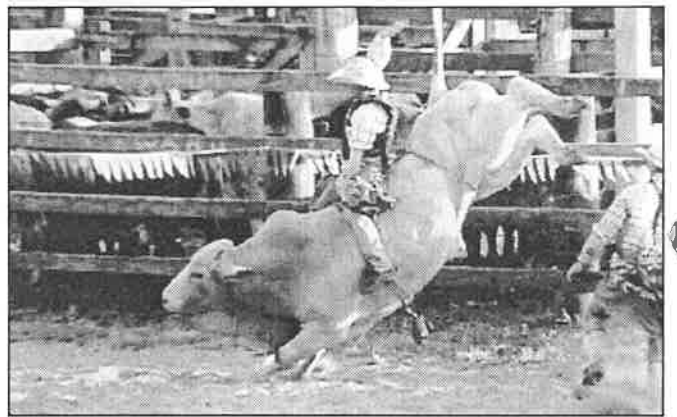
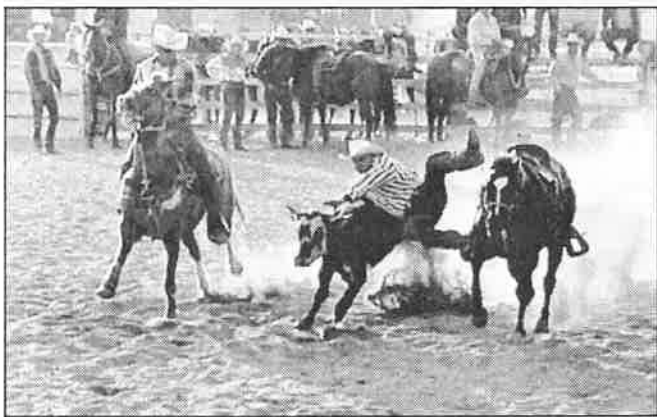

# Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

## Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

## Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

## Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

## Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

## Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

## Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

## Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

## Rules and Guidelines Contd.

- Medical Out** If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.
- Insurance Form** In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.
- Fines** Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.
- Contractors** The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

### Rookie and Novice

#### ***Rookie Competition:***

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.  
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.  
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

#### **Rookie Breaks Open**

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

**ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.**

#### ***Novice Competition:***

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
