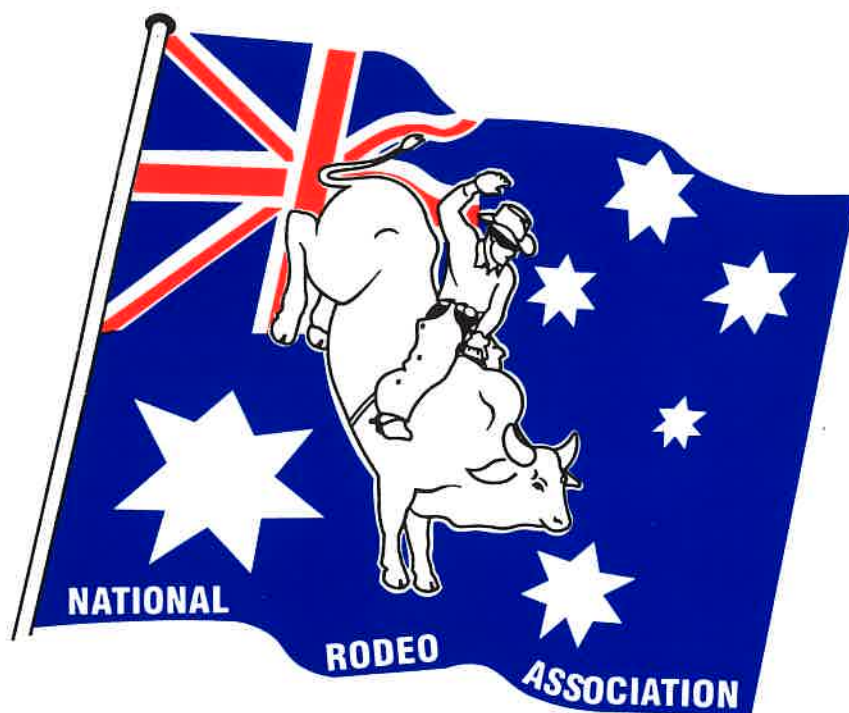

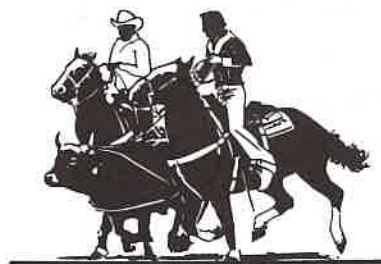

**JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE**

**JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.**

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

### Central Entries

#### NOMINATION TIMES

*Please check if rodeos have any special entry dates and times - marked on entry page \*\*\*\**

*(You may find that by trying Central Entries on Wednesday it is easier to get through).*

**HOTLINE NUMBER: 0412725319**

*This is only available on the day of the rodeo for the competitors in case of emergencies only. This is not to be used for entries or any other inquiries as it is in operation only on days rodeos are scheduled and is answered by the Central Entries person for that day NOT THE OFFICE.*

### Automatic Entry

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

**Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.**

### Gate Entry

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone elses name.

### NRA Membership

A reminder that membership were due 1<sup>st</sup> January. Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2002 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial).

Memberships received after 1<sup>st</sup> February 2002 will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. Contractors and Arena officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial.

### Resignation of Membership

**RESIGNATION OF MEMBERSHIP MUST BE IN WRITING. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1<sup>st</sup> March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.**



## *Notes from the Office.*

### *Please read carefully!*



#### --- >>> **PLEASE NOTE:**

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

#### --- >>> **TIMEKEEPERS:**

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

#### --- >>> **RODEO CALL BACK:**

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

#### --- >>> **CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:**

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

### **NOTICE RE SPRAYING AT BORDER:**

The New South Wales Department of Agriculture have advised that it is compulsory for all livestock entering New South Wales to be sprayed at the border.

#### **PLEASE COMPLY WITH THESE REGULATIONS.**

During the Cabarita and Alstonville weekends stock vehicles were filmed crossing the Qld/NSW Border without reporting to the border to be sprayed (that is crossing out of the hours of the spray stations). Some of these vehicles stopped over at Cabarita. As a result Cabarita have been advised by the N.S.W. Department of Agriculture that they may be quarantined.

### **INSURANCE PROCEDURES:**

If you are injured at a rodeo –

**ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

## **RULE ADDITIONS**

### **TEAM ROPING**

4. The team cannot compete in the same event twice except multiple head contests.
11. In a team roping contest when the header fails to attach his rope to the beast the heeler is not to contest the competition any further.

Failure to comply with this rule will result in an instant fine.

12. Members fifty years of age and over are permitted to tie their ropes (Hard and Fast) on the saddle horn.

### **AMENDMENT TO TEAM ROPING RULE:**

"If a partner is unavailable (In case of accident or breakdown) instead of turning out may select a competitor who is nominated for that rodeo in any other event to compete with on the day."

### **ROPE & TIE**

When competing at ALL rodeos in New South Wales (as per their Animal Welfare Code of Conduct) it is compulsory that an approved roping device be used for a Rope and Tie event.

### **BARREL RACE: Amendments**

Excessive whipping will be classed as no more than two (2) strikes going to each drum and four on the way home. This will be the decision of the judge officiating.

### **NO SETTING UP OF THE DRUMS IN THE ARENA ON THE DAY OF THE RODEO.**

### **STEER UNDECORATING:**

7. Time is completed when the competitor's hand is raised with the ribbon above the shoulder after the ribbon is taken from the steers back. Ribbon must be kept in hand and returned to the time keeper for a valid time.

## NRA EXECUTIVE REPORT

### Maryanne Powell – *Executive Girls Director*

2002 saw the introduction of a new style of rodeo princess quest with scores from each rodeo princess quest going to the year end title. In addition to these scores each girl is given a logbook in which they are encouraged to do promotions for rodeo and receive points. The end result should end with the winner being awarded to the hardest worker. The new concept was accepted extremely well by the girls with a definite rise in entries from youngsters who genuinely have the junior movement at heart.

2002 has also seen the NRA taking back control of the Rodeo Queen quest. With a fantastic trophy saddle up for grabs to the winner as well as a magnificent trophy buckle, we have seen a new type of entrant wishing to run for the title of NRA Queen. With real cowgirl prizes up for grabs, the quest is enticing competing rodeo cowgirls to try their hand at promoting their favorite sport. Judging for the 2003 rodeo queen begins at Caboolture Rodeo which is the first of 6 rodeo queen quests from now until December. Each girl's top 3 scores from these 6 rodeos will go towards their year end results. A final judging weekend is to be staged closer to the NRA finals with the winner being announced at the Caboolture finals. Once again the NRA is very honored to have the support of Spike and Judy Johnston for their continuing sponsorship of the rodeo queen buckle. 2002 makes a total of 22 years that Spike (a SEQRRA cowboy) has lent his support. Our sincere thanks and appreciation go to you Spike and Judy.

With entries closing June 1<sup>st</sup> for the 2003 rodeo queen quest, I am pleased to announce this year contestants:- Caboolture cowgirl, Denae Turnbull (Denae is the Barrel Racing Administrator and competes in barrel racing and steer undecorating); Narangba cowgirl, Katie Flynn (Katie made her debut in rodeo last year in barrel racing, and is now a familiar face in this event); and Gympie cowgirl Rebecca Murray (Rebecca is part of the Murray rodeo family, graduated from the junior ranks this year where she competed as a barrel racer, and is now engaged in bull rider Macolm Wieland). Welcome girls to this years quest - good luck with your fund raising, and remember have fun.

Enthusiasm to the quest has caught on rather rapidly with entries already being received for next year. 2004 rodeo queen entrants are:- Christine Balatinacz (Christine is a competitive barrel racer and breakaway roper from Rosewood), and from Jimboomba a brand new face Sherie Cooper. (Sherie decided to make rodeo a family affair with her two young sons making their debut at Caboolture Junior rodeo, husband Cameron setting his sights on Team Roping, and Sherie planning to make her first appearance soon in barrel racing has made her debut in the Caboolture rodeo queen quest).

I would like to take this opportunity to thank my last year's Administrators – Graham Browne (barrel racing), Kerriane Young (breakaway roping), and Nikki Johnson (Steer Undecorating). The effort that they put in was extremely appreciated - the job of an Administrator is a tireless job of voluntary help. Welcome also to this year Administrators – barrel racing, Denae Turnbull – breakaway roping, Christine Pennell – Steer undecorating, Melissa Howard. While Denae and Christine have been busy at their jobs all year, Melissa is new to her role and has some wonderful sponsorship prospects for Steer Undecorating. It is Melissa's goal to offer support to committees to support Steer Undecorating. This was a venture

that Nikki started last year with fund raising and Melissa is taking one step further with corporate sponsorship. Of course I must also mention our rodeo queen Erin Healey who has done a wonderful job this past 12 months and will continue to do so until December. Erin has managed to introduce some very showy grand entries, and her smiling face is one that appears at every rodeo no matter what the rodeo's status. Of course a queen's grand entry can be only as good as her grand entry team, and Erin's grand entry drill team can certainly take a bow.

Competition levels are reaching their highest ever in breakaway roping and barrel racing this year. This is a tremendous step forward for the girls' events. I am a firm believer that one is only as good as your competition, and without a doubt the standard for these two events has been continually on the rise over the past few years. However along with competitiveness inevitably seems to come bad sportsmanship. I wish to remind everyone that, ones needs to win with a grin and lose with a smile if one is to be hailed a good sport. It is very wearing to those of us that compete for the sheer fun of it, to be exposed to some form of bad sportsmanship each weekend. It is embarrassing to watch a minor few bring the sport down with bad attitudes whilst belittling themselves.

On another note, I would like to mention the nameless faces that continually turn up and tirelessly offer their assistance at each rodeo. Quite often what they do is unnoticed until they are not there to do it. Their unrelenting help enables our rodeos to run smoothly and professionally. I know you're out there folks and I would just like to say a very many special thanks for all that you do. It is a pity that there are so many who are willing to sit there and whine that things aren't running right, instead of just getting off their butts and lending a hand. If a lot more of us only just got in there and lent a hand, then these nameless faces would not be diminishing in numbers due to competitor criticism and complaints for a voluntary job done, that nobody asked them to do in the first place.

Each year, the last weekend in May sees the Dayboro Heritage festival with a full on street parade on the Sunday morning. This year the NRA was in attendance in the street parade, and I would like to thank our Runner Up Rodeo Queen Shelli Ellis for organising this for us, while so many of us were busy with the State of Origin Rodeo in Casino. Rodeo horses carrying flapping flags, and utes of cowboys and cowgirls took part in this spectacular, and I would like to thank all who drove there to take part.

Before signing off I would like to mention two very special people. They are two ladies who work hard for rodeo, who sometimes cop abuse but still manage to keep smiling. They are our two office ladies, Jocelyn Frahm and Indria Dias. Ladies you do a tremendous job, above and beyond the call of duty, and your dedication and efforts to our sport cannot be given enough praise. They work overtime without claiming for it, pop in and attend the office even when they are supposed to be on holidays, and I am proud to say, two lovely ladies who just always seem to be there for us – whether it be for information, advice or just a shoulder to lean on.

## *Friendly Reminders*

### REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

### NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

### CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event administrator.

### CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. ***PLEASE check cancel out penalties in Central Entry Guidelines.***

### SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to the call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

### GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo. This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

### PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed - (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

### MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory. Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

### OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE – Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$9.90 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

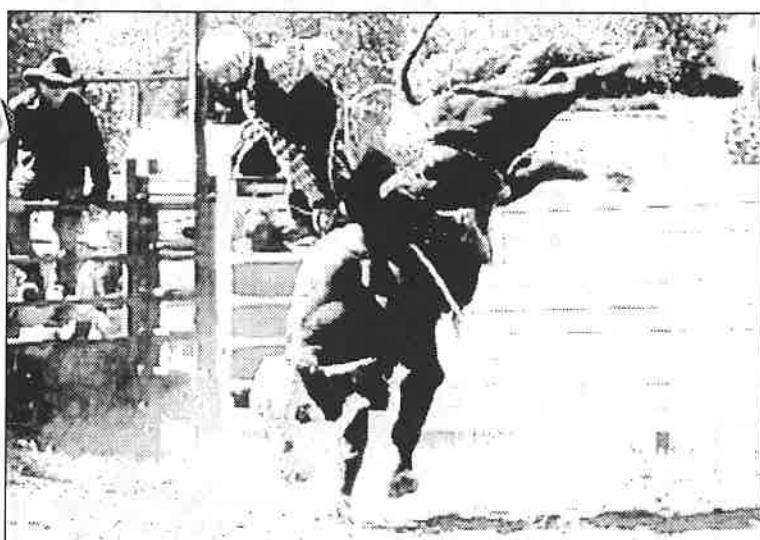

# Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

## Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

## Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

## Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

## Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

## Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

## Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

## Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

## Rules and Guidelines Contd.

### **Medical Out**

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

### **Insurance Form**

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

### **Fines**

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

### **Contractors**

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

**ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.**

## Rookie and Novice

### ***Rookie Competition:***

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.  
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.  
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

### **Rookie Breaks Open**

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

**ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.**

### ***Novice Competition:***

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
