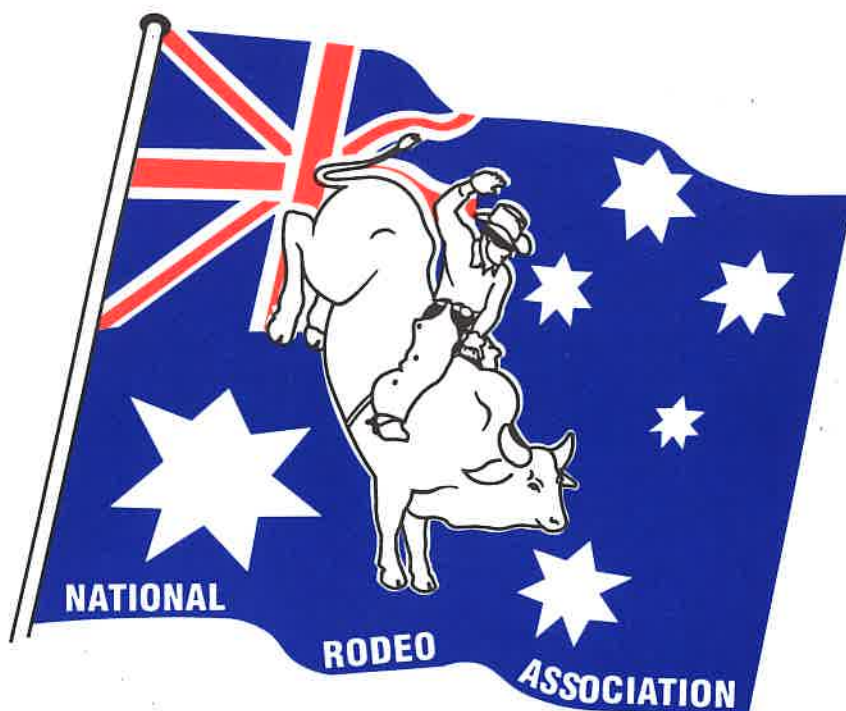

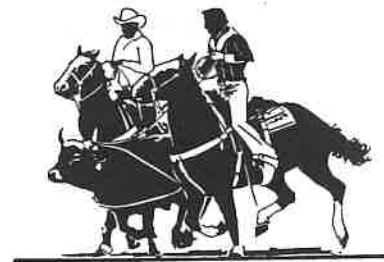

### JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

**JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.**

Junior Membership entitles you to compete **ONLY** in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). *The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.*

## *Notes from the Office.*

### *Please read carefully!*



#### --- >>> **MEMBERSHIP:**

Memberships received after 1<sup>st</sup> February 2003 will incur a \$10 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1<sup>st</sup> March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

#### --- >>> **TIMEKEEPERS:**

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

#### --- >>> **RODEO CALL BACK:**

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

#### --- >>> **CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:**

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

#### --- >>> **GATE ENTRY:**

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

#### --- >>> **COMMITTEES:**

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION. If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2002 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

#### --- >>> **INSURANCE PROCEDURES:**

If you are injured at a rodeo –

**ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

**COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE**

**--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:**

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

**Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.**

**--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:**

Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries – **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.**

Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

Dear Members,

### JUDGES:

This is sometimes a thankless task and one where a judge has to make split second decisions and try to be fair to everyone. Some contestants should engage their brain a bit more before abusing judges who are doing their best. There is not a rodeo contestant in the world that probably doesn't reckon they've been hard done by at some stage. To those experts who can judge from the stands, don't hang back, do your cards and get on the Judges panel.

### CONTRACTORS:

I think the standard of bucking stock in the NRA Rodeos is very high and there is a very low percentage of re rides. If a judge sees fit to award a re ride, as even the best bucking stock in the world will have the odd off day, I don't see the need for the Contractor to interfere with that decision. Some contractors could spend a bit more time perhaps showing their bulls the arena and where the return gate is before the rodeo. The standard of time event cattle over the past few years and at present is very good and most are good to work with.

### JUNIORS:

The NRA has a very good Junior format and it is good to see this getting better and stronger all the time.

### CONTESTANTS:

Being a rodeo Cowboy or Cowgirl is a great way to be involved in a sport that I think is the best in the world. Try to conduct yourselves in an upstanding manner at all times and don't be afraid to lend a hand or help someone starting out. Try to remember at all times that we are in the public eye and the person next to you at the bar or in the stands could be a rodeo sponsor.

Well, I have had my say and I wish you good trucking and safe travelling, and if I can be of any assistance to you, I am quite approachable.

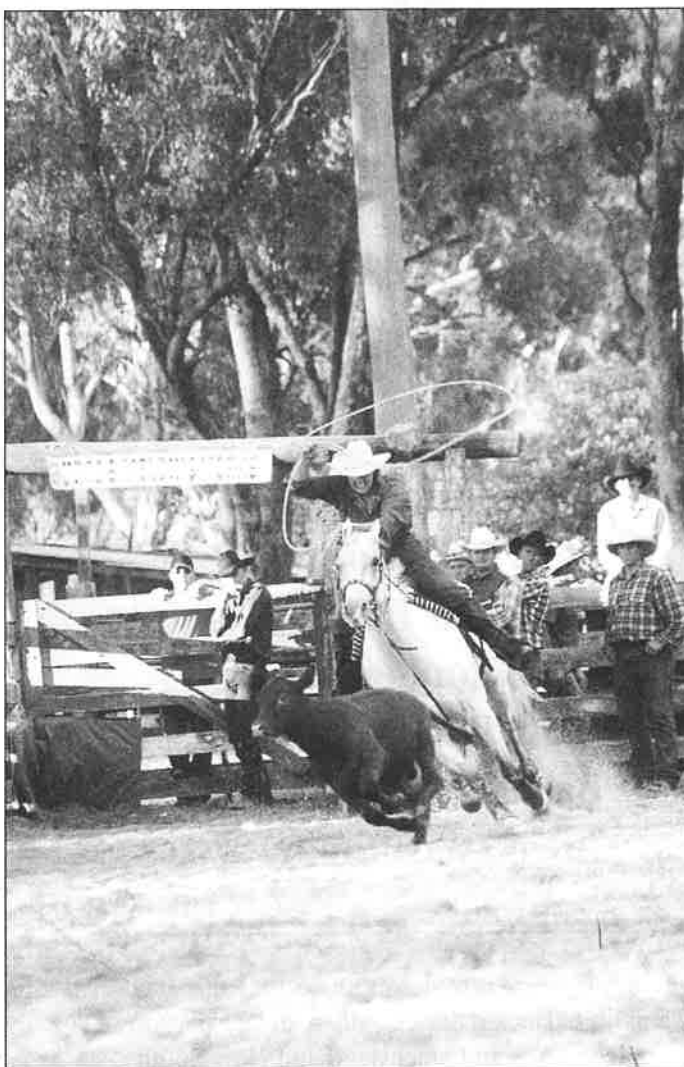

## *Friendly Reminders*

### REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

### NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

### SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

### GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo.

This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

Rookie points will be recorded in the open standings - 'R' beside the competitor's name. Members wishing to be classified as a Rookie must do so in writing to the NRA Office.

Novice points will no longer appear in the standings in the newsletter. They will be tabulated in the office and be available to competitors through Central Entries and the Secretary on the day at Rodeos. As a competitor 'Breaks Open' he or she will be notified in writing from the office and recorded in the 'Break Open' Register. These competitors' names will be published in the monthly newsletter in a Break Open section.

## Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

- Entry Times** Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.
- When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.
- Members** When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.
- Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.
- Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.
- Day Members** Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.
- Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.
- All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.
- Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.
- Reference Number** Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.
- Late Entries** Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.
- Cancellations** Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.
- Hotline** The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

## Rules and Guidelines Contd.

### **Medical Out**

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

### **Insurance Form**

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

### **Fines**

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

### **Contractors**

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

**ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.**

### ***Rookie Competition:***

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.  
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.  
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

### **Rookie Breaks Open**

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

**ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.**

### ***Novice Competition:***

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
