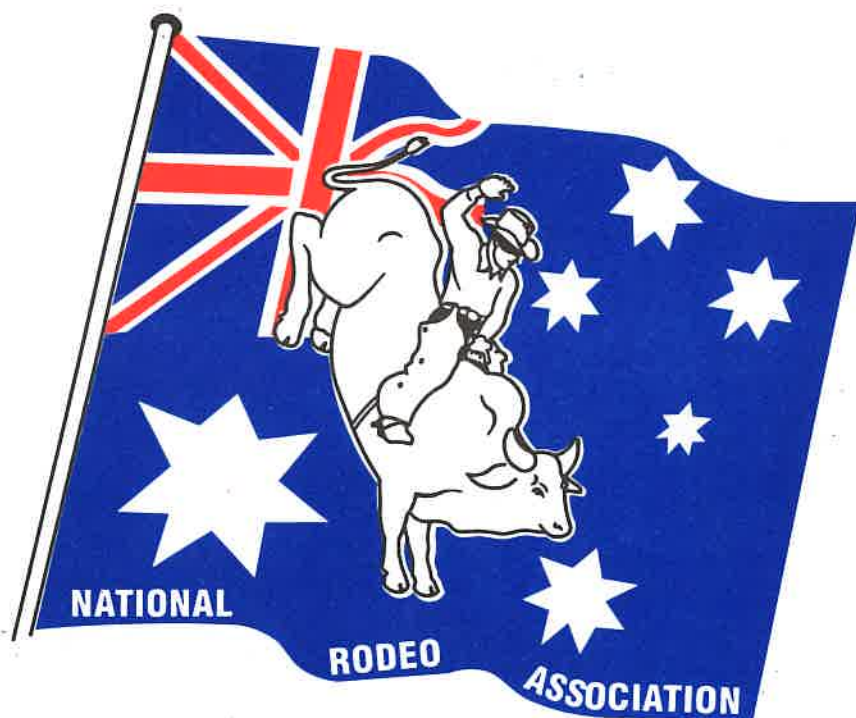

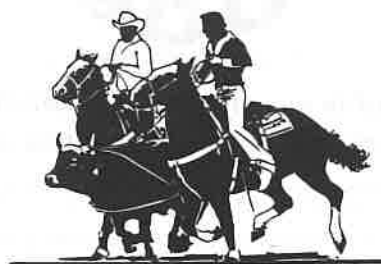

JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a Junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

It is compulsory for ALL Competitors who compete in Junior Events to wear a Protective Helmet whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo Event.

Members must have current membership to compete. To maintain membership fees are to be paid by 1st January each year. All owings must be included with memberships to become financial. Payments after 1st January will incur a late renewal fine set by the board.

Please read carefully!*



--- >>> MEMBERSHIP:

Memberships received after 1st February 2003 will incur a \$10 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A. members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

--- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

--- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

--- >>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

--- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

--- >>> COMMITTEES:

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION. If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2002 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.

--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries – **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.**

Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

--->>> OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

--->>> RULES OF THE MONTH:

TEAM ROPING:

11. In a Team Roping contest when the header fails to attach his rope to the beast, the heeler is not to contest the competition any further. Failure to comply with this rule will result in an instant fine.

GENERAL RULES:

16. No competitor is allowed on horseback in the arena (1) hour prior to the commencement of the rodeo.
CLARIFICATIONS -
 (This includes the slack.)
 The time box is part of the arena.
 No competitor to be in the arena or time box during the break.

NRA Officials:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have:-

**two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one
 (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

Unless you are a very good actress a judge like any other person can spot a fake personality. During competition an entrant must use her strengths and put aside her weaknesses to succeed in pageants.

Around the Rodeo Scene

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

HOTLINE NUMBER: 0412725319

Available on the day of the rodeo for emergencies only.

The HOTLINE NUMBER is not to be used for entries or any other inquiries as it is in operation only on days rodeos are scheduled and is answered by the Central Entries person for that day NOT THE OFFICE.

MARY VALLEY RODEO

1. Competitors – All rodeo competitors are requested to enter the grounds by Diggings Road – arrows will direct.
2. All time event competitors are to enter the yards via the corner of the back paddock.
3. The committee has requested that competitors are to contact the NRA Hotline on the day of the rodeo NOT THE COMMITTEE if they have any queries regarding the rodeo. The Show Society secretary is not always able to get messages across to the rodeo arena.

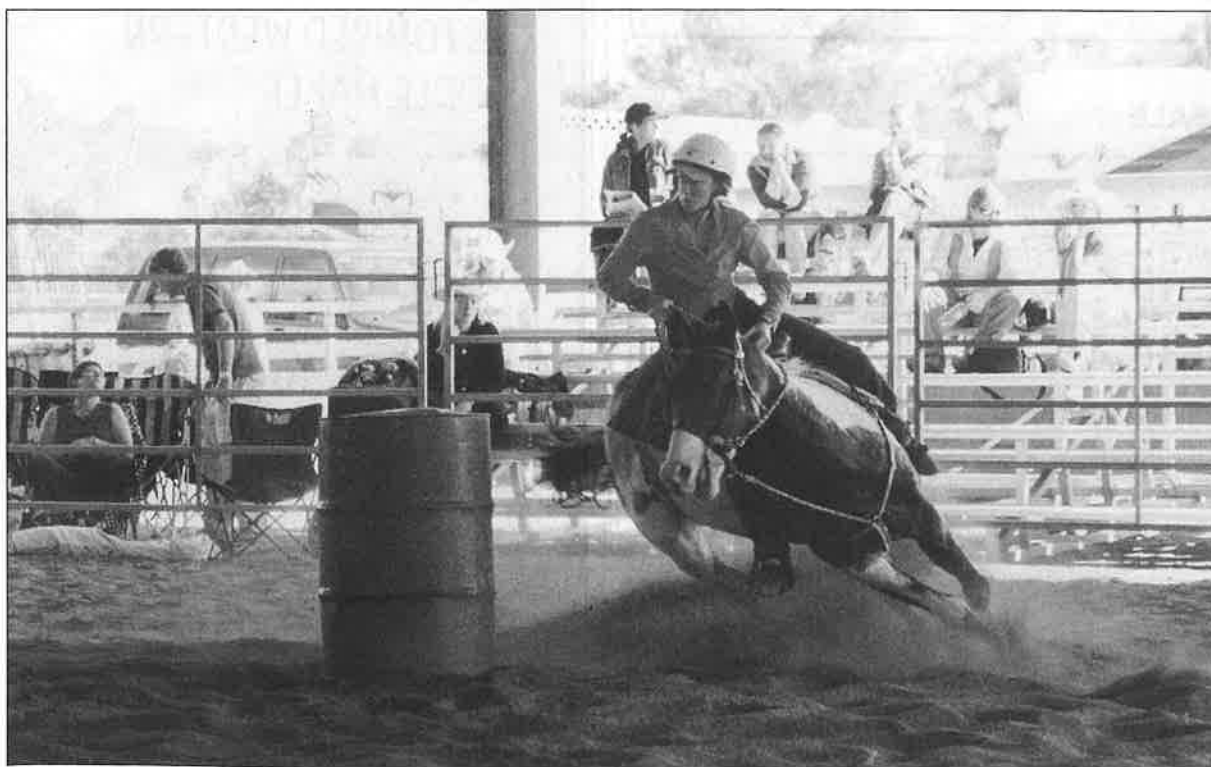

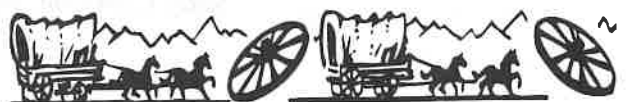

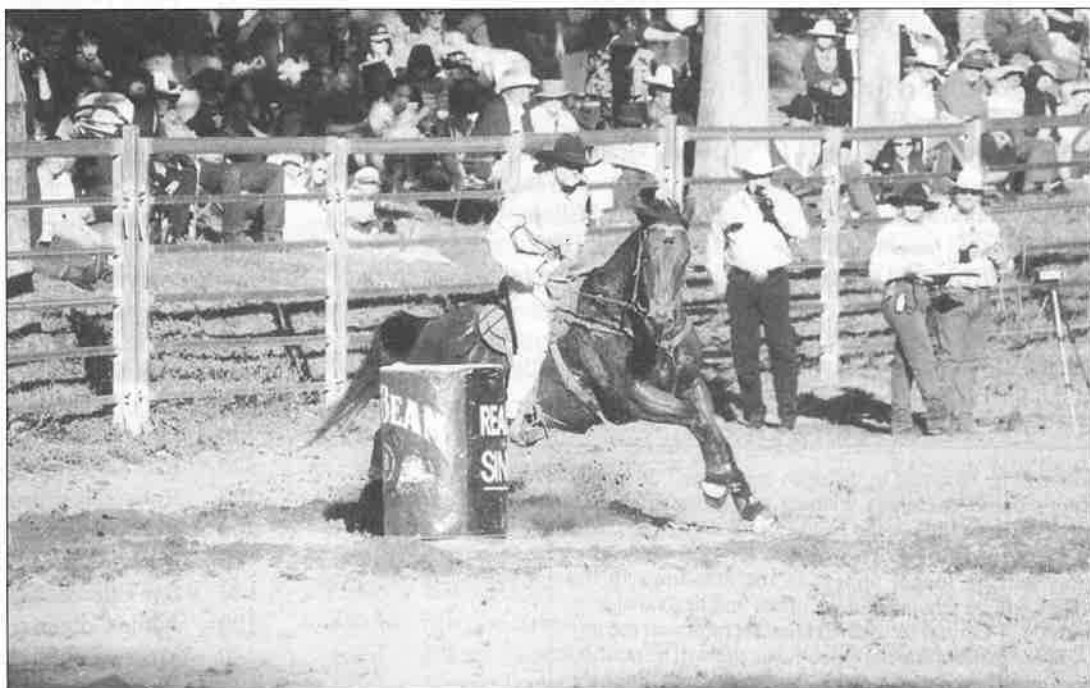

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
