Juniors in Rodeo

It is compulsory for ALL Competitors who compete in Junior Events to wear a Protective Helmet whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo Event.

**** ALL JUNIOR COMPETITORS MUST WEAR A FULL FACE HELMET WHEN COMPETING IN ANY ROUGH STOCK EVENT.



If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

Re MEMBERSHIP:

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$76.50 (from \$50.00 to \$126.50) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$76.50 (from \$50.00 to \$126.50) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00).

The only exception to this is where there is not a Junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.



A Message to all Juniors -

As this is my final year as a junior member in the NRA, there are a number of people I would like to thank. Firstly, my mum and dad for all their support and encouragement. My dad, for taking me to all the rodeos, and my mum for helping me train my horses. As a junior competitor, I have had a great deal of support from a lot of people. To all those people, I say a huge thank you. I would also like to thank all of the people over the years who have been on the junior committee and helped get junior Rodeos running throughout the years for us. It has given me an amazing journey that now takes me into the open ranks of rodeo.

To Bill Urquhart, for his many years of dedication, not only to the open competitors but to the junior program. Bill was a member of the junior program when my brother was a junior competitor. He is now married with two children and Bill is still here today supporting and encouraging each and every junior competitor – Thank You Bill.

Last but not least, I would like to thank Doc Cavanagh - A man for whom I have a lot of respect. This man has been the backbone of junior rodeo. He has given so many people the opportunity to begin their rodeo careers at an early age and many of these competitors are now not only competing in Australia, but also making a name for themselves overseas. Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



--->>> MEMBERSHIP:

Memberships received after 1st February 2004 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

--->>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

--- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

--->>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

--- >>> **GATE ENTRY:**

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

--->>> **COMMITTEES:**

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION. If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2002 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

--->>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo -

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

- 1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
- 2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
- 3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
- 4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

--->>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries – **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.** Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

--->>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated. Automatic Entry forms are available from the Office and Central Entry Office at all Rodeos. Please take advantage of this service.

--- >>> MEMBERSHIP:

A reminder that membership are due 1st January. Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2004 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial). Membership renewals are included in this newsletter.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO COMPETITION MEMBERS - YOU MUST READ THIS CAREFULLY

Rodeo is a dangerous sport and people get injured in the course of their participation. The Association has put in place rules for competition which are designed to protect the competitors and address issues of animal welfare. However, accidents do happen and people do get injured. While the Association has put in place a list of benefits which are set out more particularly below, those benefits are not taken as any form of indemnity and the Association requires that you provide a waiver of your rights in consideration of the matters which are set out below. In requiring that waiver the Association does so in the interest of the sport of rodeo and the continued operations of that sport in the future and the welfare and interests of its competing members.

WAIVER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND INDEMNITY I, (insert name) agree to be bound by the Constitution of the Association and in the event that I intend to be an active competitor in rodeos conducted by the authority or auspices of the Association ACKNOWLEDGE that I am aware that the sport of rodeo does by its nature have inherent risks of personal injury to its participants. IN CONSIDERATION of the benefits which are available to me (or on my behalf) by the Association (through its Accident Fidelity Fund/Personal Accident Insurance ("the fund"), the schedule of benefits I have read, acknowledged and accepted as being reasonable compensation) DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND ASSUME any risk of personal injury or death and in the event of such injury or death waive any claim which may be made by myself for or on behalf of myself, for such personal injuries or death arising out of my competing in the sport of rodeo, which I (or someone on my behalf) may have against the Association or any person or corporation operating under the auspices and authority of the Association. FURTHER, for the considerations set out above I indemnify and agree to keep indemnified in the future, the Association and its associates against all liability arising as a result of my negligence (or the negligence of my servants or agents) in respect of any death, bodily injury, disability, damage (including personal and property damage) occurring as a result of such negligence to the fullest extent permitted by law but only to the extent that the Association and its associates are not already indemnified or insured. I AM AWARE that this is a legal document and that I have had the opportunity of seeking independent

I AM AWARE that this is a legal document and that I have had the opportunity of seeking independent legal advice in relation thereto. In the light of that advice (or a waiver of the same on my behalf) I CONFIRM that I have signed this membership application of my own free will accepting as I do the risks in providing the waiver that I have in the terms mentioned above particularly (having regard to the consideration passing between me and the Association). All-Around Championship Award Points Rodeo:

Standard Events:-

Five (5) men's and two (2) ladies, minimum prize money of \$400 per event. Optional Events may be conducted with minimum prize money of \$300 per event. Competitors receive full points to event titles and all round titles.

Junior and/or novice events can only be held if the equivalent senior event is being conducted.

Points Award Rodeo:

Any rodeo that conducts at least three or more open events with a minimum prize money of \$400.00 per event. Half points allocated to individual titles only.

Junior and/or novice events can only be held if the equivalent Open event is being conducted.

NRA Bull Ride Series:

To consist of Open, Novice and Junior Bulls Points to Series only No points to End of Year or All Round Titles Prize money Structure

Open Bull Ride \$1500.00 Minimum
Novice Bull Ride \$350.00 Minimum
Junior Bull Ride \$200.00 Minimum



• Finals may only be conducted on the Open Bull Ride Events with Minimum posted Prize money of \$2000.00.

Prize-money structure for the conduct of any final shall be 50% of the posted prize-money to be paid on the Average, the other 50% to be split equally over the rounds. The minimum-posted prize money offered for any round shall be \$500.00.

Non Point Rodeo:

Any rodeo promotion as determined by the board or a promotion that does not meet any of the other rodeo criteria.






Kilkivan Bull Ride

Special 2003 National Rodeo Association Queen Report

The West Coast Rodeo Circuit recently held two of their largest rodeos of their 2003 season. Fortunately I was able to attend both of these, as a special guest of the West Coast Rodeo Circuit.

The first rodeo was held 220 kms south of Perth in the country music capital of WA, Boyup Brook. The main difference I found between rodeos in the east and west is rodeos there are not just an event for the day or afternoon, they are worth celebrating the entire weekend. Competitors are also encouraged to participate in the whole weekend's activities. People from all over the southwest flock to Boyup Brook for the weekend of festivities including music shows on Friday and Saturday night, the rodeo and the Sunday bush poets' breakfast.

The Boyup Brook rodeo began as a dream for the owner and namesake Harvey Dickson. Harvey is a mega Elvis and country music fan. He begins his rodeo weekend on Friday night with a country music night held in a converted farm shed which now houses a stage made from giant karri logs, a sawdust floor, a waterfall, walls and a roof that is covered with anything you could or couldn't imagine – horse carts, oil drums, brooms, tools, a kayak, the challenge is to find something that isn't there. But overlooking each of the music acts are life size sand sculptures of legends Elvis and Johnny Cash. It's an amazing and unbelievable complex which has to be seen to be believed.

The following day was the rodeo, and the arena is no less extravagant than the rest of the complex. The first log to make this arena was put into the ground 18 years ago and this was only the second rodeo held here. The grounds could be described as extroverted. The arena is huge twice the size of any arena here, making for a huge barrel course. The arena fence is made only from posts and a cap rail each approximately 40cm in diameter, along the bottom are fallen trees each being approximately 1m across. Overlooking the arena are three giant timber musicians each 45m tall, each carrying a steel guitar or banjo 20m across. The bar rivals the Sunshine Coast's Ettamooga Pub complete with FJ Holden on the roof, and if you look up on the hill there is a tree holding up a billy can which I'm told is actually a 44gallon drum. If you got bored with the rodeo there is always something to look at and keep you amused at Harvey Dickson's.

In the west it is hard to find a male or female competitor that only competes in one event. Most cowgirls compete in all four female events and cowboys competing in both rough and timed events. Their current all round cowboy Paul Casey competes in all Saddle Bronc, Bares, Bull Ride, Steer Wrestling, and Rope and Tie. The current all round cowgirl Sharon McCarthy successfully competes in Barrels, Breakaway, Steer Undecorating and Team Roping.

The following weekend the WCRC headed 1.5 hours southwest of Perth to the gold and bauxite mining town of Boddington. This rodeo has been running since 1977 and has grown to be one of the largest in the state. The prize money attracted a lot of competitors to this rodeo, the bull ride had \$1200 up, 6 open events \$1000, except steer undecorating and breakaway was \$800, then the junior and local events. They also had a bikes vs. horses barrel race. Three motorbikes (2 and 4 wheelers) competed against three barrel racing competitors. The final score was horses 2 bikes 1. The spectators and competitors loved it.

Arriving at the grounds the first thing I noticed was the large bar and canteen facility. This two-story structure has an open top level to allow spectators a clean and comfortable viewing platform to see the rodeo. The canteen bar area below has a nice family atmosphere with the local school choir performing throughout the day but when the rodeo finishes it gets transformed to an electric jam-packed venue of socializing, dancing, music and heaps of fun. The following day the excitement of the rodeo didn't end, the town congregated to the river for raft races and a town BBQ.

The running of the rodeo is similar to the way NRA rodeos are run but the atmosphere around the rodeo beginning with Friday night is what set these rodeos apart. I had a great two weeks in Western Australia and I recommend to anyone to see that Western Australia has to offer both in rodeo and the scenery. These two rodeos especially, Harvey Dickson's Boyup Brook Rodeo for the 'seen to be believed' music and rodeo complex, and Boddington Rodeo for its atmosphere. I need to thank WCRC President Stan Baker, Rodeo Producers Kevin and Jenny Treloar for their assistance in our trip and all they members of the West Coast Rodeo Circuit. Your hospitality will not be forgotten.

Friendly Reminders

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event administrator.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. **PLEASE** check cancel out penalties in Central Entry Guidelines.

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to the call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo.

This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed – (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$15.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.




Jordan and Marty Update

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$15.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$22 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5.50 administration fine (with or withour a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5.50 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$27.50 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
 Points are accrued from Open Competition Only.
 (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
