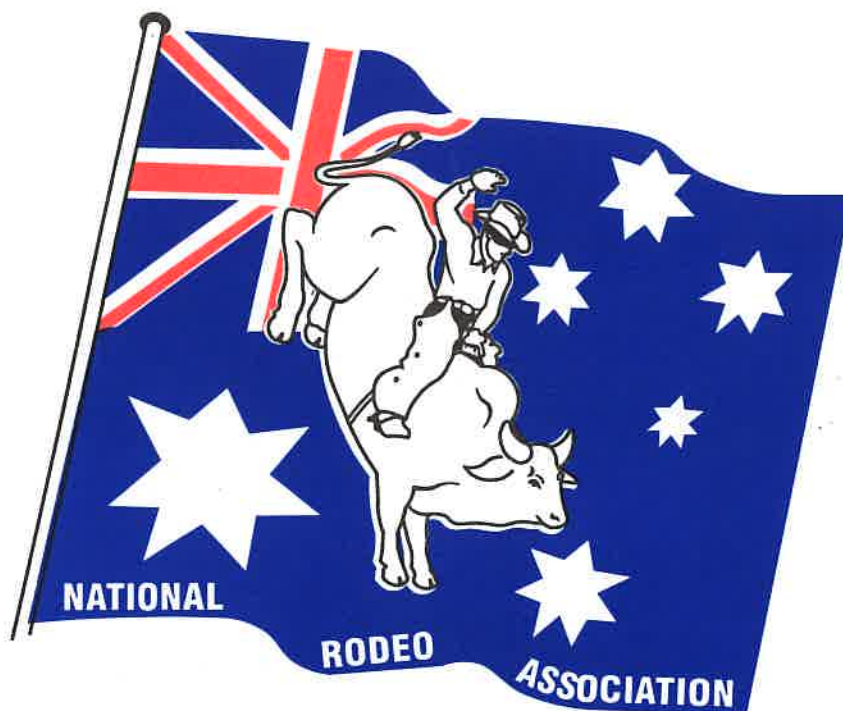

### JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

**JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.**

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a Junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

## Juniors in Rodeo

It is compulsory for ALL Competitors who compete in Junior Events to wear a Protective Helmet whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo Event.



*If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.*

Members must have current membership to compete. To maintain membership fees are to be paid by 1<sup>st</sup> January each year. All owings must be included with memberships to become financial. Payments after 1<sup>st</sup> January will incur a late renewal fine set by the board.

**--- >>> MEMBERSHIP:**

Memberships received after 1<sup>st</sup> February 2003 will incur a \$10 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1<sup>st</sup> March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A. members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

**--- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:**

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

**--- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:**

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

**--- >>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:**

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

**--- >>> GATE ENTRY:**

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

**--- >>> COMMITTEES:**

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION. If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2002 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

**--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:**

If you are injured at a rodeo –

**ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.**

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

**COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE**

**--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:**

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

**Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.**

**--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:**

Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries – **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.**

Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

--->>> **OUTSTANDING FEES:**

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

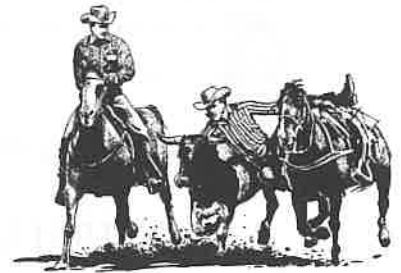
The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

--- >>> **RULE OF THE MONTH:**

**DRESS CODE**

This rule applies to Competitors, Chute Boss, Announcers, Pick-up Teams, Judges, Time Keepers, Central Entries Personel, Stock Contractors and their assistants (back yard workers). The Chute boss has the right to ask anybody who does not comply with this rule to either dress appropriately or ask them to leave the arena.



**NRA Officials:**

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-**                      **two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

**It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc).**

**Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.**

## EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT

Dear Member,

Over recent weeks it has been brought to the board's attention that a number of junior competitors have been competing in Novice or Open events without wearing a helmet.

The board of directors wish to make it quite clear that all junior competitors are to *wear safety helmets whilst competing in any event. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the member (s) being disqualified from their event.*

One aspect of this rule pertaining to juniors that needs clarification is when a junior member turns eighteen years of age, he or she is still required to wear his or her helmet in all events and whilst mounted for the remainder of that season.

*The only time a junior member (who has turned eighteen years of age) can compete without a helmet is if they advise the board of directors in writing that they are no longer competing in any junior events.*

The board wishes to further advise that in order to enforce this rule a qualifier (J) will be listed beside the names of all junior competitors competing in open or novice events.

## AUSTRALIAN HIGH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCIATION INC.

As the new secretary for the Australian High School Rodeo Association Inc. I would like to thank the NRA for their wonderful support and would like to share some background information on the AHSRA with other NRA members.

Formed in 2001 supported by Australia's major Rodeo Associations AHSRA aims to promote high school rodeo on a national basis working with educational institutions and government to bring about High School Rodeo as a sport. AHSRA conducts and administers rodeo competitions and clinics specifically for High School age students. The association promotes and encourages members to continue in school or education establishments while achieving their rodeo goals.

Members may compete as a team for a school, college or region or as an individual. To be eligible for membership High School students must be studying full time and not have turned 18 before January 1<sup>st</sup> 2003. Full time students (15-18 years) of Tertiary Institutions such as TAFE and Agricultural Colleges are eligible, but not apprentices or trainees attending these institutions part-time.

Competition is divided into two age groups: 12-14 years (must not have turned 15 before 1/1/03) and 15-18 years (must not have turned 18 before 1/1/03). Approved events are bull riding, steer riding, saddle and bareback bronc riding, team roping, breakaway roping, barrel racing, rope and tie, and steer wrestling. Professional stock contractors and officials are engaged to produce AHSRA rodeos with safety and animal welfare considerations being paramount.

I have spoken with Paul Range, Terry Sharland and of course Bill Urquhart who represents the NRA on the AHSRA Executive Board. AHSRA will endeavour to enhance the great NRA junior programme not compete with it. We should be able to muster up plenty of high school teams in South East Queensland. I have information packages to send out to schools, so send me some contact details, kids.

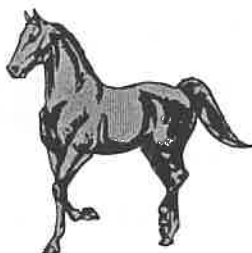

# Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

---

## Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

## Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.



## Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

## Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.



## Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

## Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

## Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

## Rules and Guidelines Contd.

### **Medical Out**

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

### **Insurance Form**

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

### **Fines**

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

### **Contractors**

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

**ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.**

## Rookie and Novice

### ***Rookie Competition:***

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.  
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.  
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

### **Rookie Breaks Open**

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

**ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.**

### ***Novice Competition:***

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
