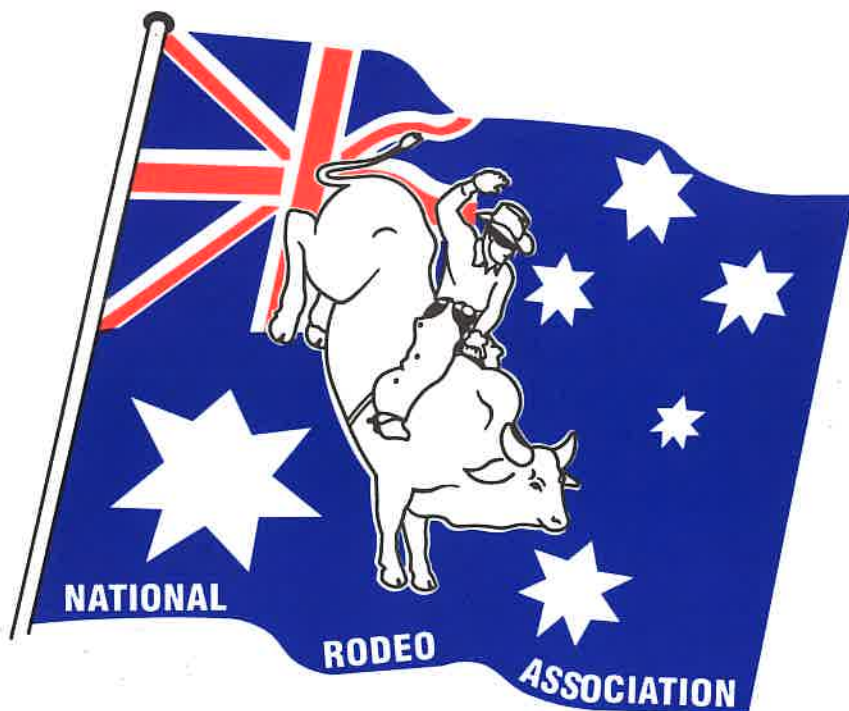

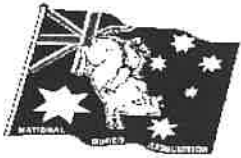

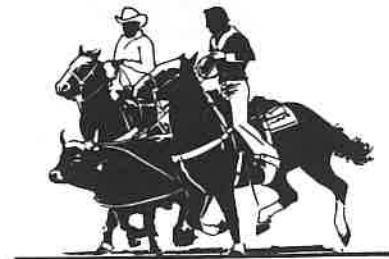

JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$60.00 (from \$45.00 to \$105.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

Juniors in Rodeo

It is compulsory for ALL Competitors who compete in Junior Events to wear a Protective Helmet whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo Event.



If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

Members must have current membership to compete. To maintain membership fees are to be paid by 1st January each year. All owings must be included with memberships to become financial. Payments after 1st January will incur a late renewal fine set by the board.

***Notes from the Office.
Please read carefully!***



--- >>> MEMBERSHIP:

Memberships received after 1st February 2003 will incur a \$10 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A. members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

--- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

--- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

--- >>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

--- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.

--- >>> COMMITTEES:

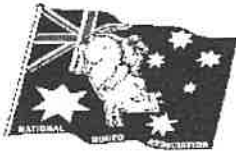

--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE

--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete.

With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated.

Automatic Entry forms are available from the Central Entry Office at all Rodeos.

--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries – **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.**

Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

NRA Officials:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have:- two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc).

Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

RODEO QUEEN REPORT

Rodeo queen, princess, and junior princess pageants for 2003 are about to get into full swing. As reigning queen and as an entrant, I researched widely regarding what it takes to be rodeo royalty, including what I need to know and what I can do to set me apart from others. There are four areas that an entrant will get judged upon. These are knowledge, personality, appearance and horsemanship. Below are some tips to help entrants set new standards for rodeo royalty.

Knowledge

To set a queen or princess apart from other cowgirls she must be aware of all aspects of rodeo including her association, the rodeo she represents, her association's history, past and current event champions, current standings, all event rules, and animal welfare issues. Basically you will need to know the answer to or know where to find the answers to anything that the public may ask or be interested in.

Personality

When choosing an ambassador to represent a rodeo her personality plays an important role in the decision. A member of rodeo royalty by her very appearance is constantly being observed and judged. This could be by a member of the public especially children, the committee who you may be representing or fellow competitors. This is not restricted to only the rodeo arena but includes any public area such as the parking area, even travelling to the rodeo. These people are watching your every move, how you handle every situation and present yourself, similar to any high profile personality.

Human communication is only 10% verbal and 90% nonverbal communication so not only what you say but also how you speak will be taken into consideration. This is a job you are going for and you should treat it as such.

After the rodeo judging is complete you have a choice to either prove the judges made the right or wrong decision. Bad sportsmanship will only reinforce that the judges made the correct one.

Appearance

A queen, other royalty and entrants are the most public figures at a rodeo and the best way to describe what she should wear is for me to take a quote from Maryanne Powell. "Without her crown or sash on you should be able to point out who the queen is and, a rodeo queen should also look like she belongs in a rodeo arena not in Kings Cross." I also believe that when choosing what you wear you need to ask yourself, is your outfit up to date and does it suit my personality? How you feel about what you are wearing will come through, if you are uncomfortable it will show versus if you look and feel great.

Horsemanship

In the horsemanship section only the rider is being judged, so you do not have to ride your own horse. Each entrant will be judged to see if she knows the correct buttons to press to make the horse go, stop, correct leads, diagonals etc. and if the horse plays up did she give up or did she cowgirl up. It is better to stop and correct a horse than allow it to continue to misbehave. As a tip for all entrants make full use of the available rodeo arena and smile. Remember why you are here.

Multiple judges are used at each rodeo competition because what one judge may like is different to what another judge may like. Under no circumstance are judges able to compare notes. A judge's decision and the score they give are their own and should never be questioned by an entrant or their family.

I hope this helps all interested females wanting to participate in future queen quests, not forgetting that entry closes for the 2004 National Rodeo Association Queen Quest mid year. If you would like any assistance I am available, and I found the following web sites very helpful.

You must enter a pageant, I guarantee that you will not be worse off than before you started.

Friendly Reminders

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

SLACK:

All members please note. Programs are set by individual committees and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the slack or performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to the call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a slack is advertised. Wherever possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo. This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

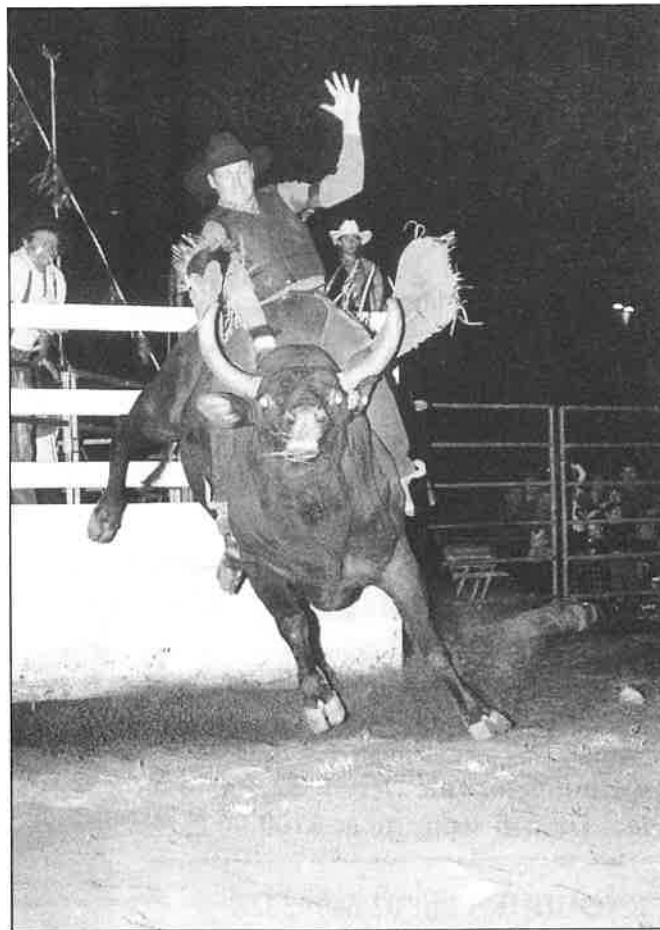

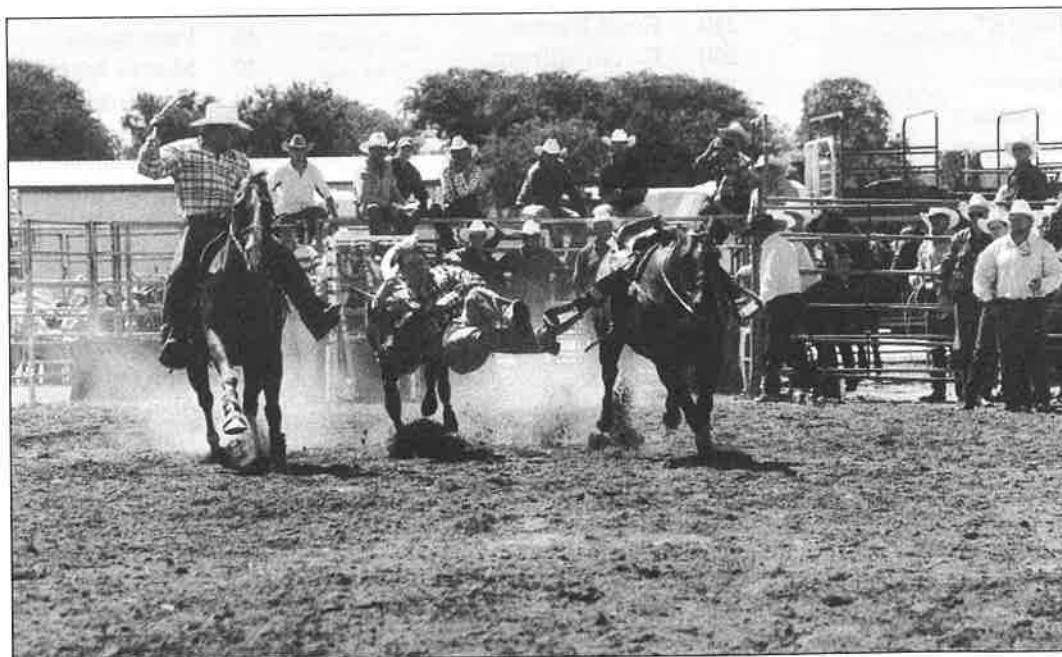

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$11.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
