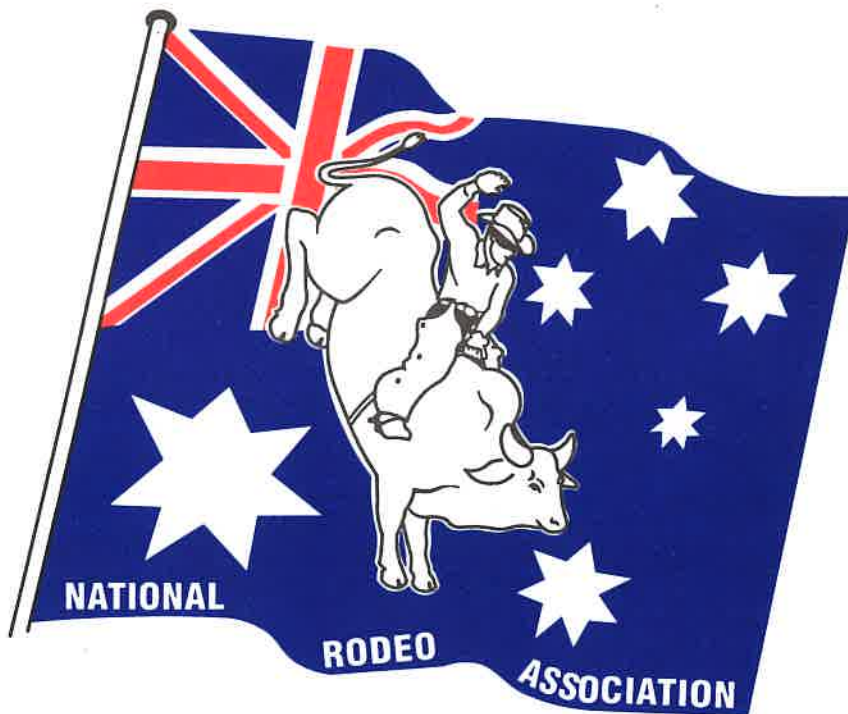

Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



-- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

-- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

-- >>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

-- >>> OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

-- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

-- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

All competitors please read Central Entry Rules and Regulations and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.** Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

-- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated. **Automatic Entry forms are available from the Office and Central Entry Office at all Rodeos. Please take advantage of this service.**

-- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.



Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



--- >>> **MEMBERSHIP:**

A reminder that membership was due 1st January. Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2004 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial).

Memberships received after 1st February 2004 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$76.50 (from \$50.00 to \$126.50) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$76.50 (from \$50.00 to \$126.50) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00).

VALE - HALLS ANGEL

In August 2004, sixteen year old Halls Angel passed away peacefully on the Hall Rodeo property at Willowbank. He was without doubt one of the greatest and most consistent bucking bulls ever seen in this country. Testament to his ability is the fact that only twelve men ever rode him for the required eight seconds over his incredible nine year career!

Halls Angel was a black, Brahman cross bull that was bred by the infamous Pat Speedy on his Aratula property in South East Queensland. Like many of the other great bucking bulls that have left the property before him, he was as mean as they come both in and out of the rodeo arena.

Halls Angel, as he was initially known, joined the Hall Rodeo bucking string in 1996 and by the end of the following year he had been voted by the top 12 bull riders in the NRA as the 1997 Bucking Bull of the Year. Shortly after this time, Hall Rodeo was contacted by a well known motorcycle gang who requested that his name be changed despite the fact that they had seen him buck and were quite impressed. Hall Rodeo respected the unusual request and as such he became known as Halls Angel.

In 1998 Halls Angel continued to thrill the rodeo crowd with his spectacular feats.

His reputation grew so large during that year that a special match up was promoted at the 1998 Warw Rodeo. The match up saw the 1997 Australian Bull Riding Champion, Gavin Woodall, up against the Hall Rodeo superstar. The winner of the match was guaranteed a \$5000 bonus and despite a great effort from the Australian Champion, Halls Angel racked up another victory. Needless to say he was again crowned the NRA Bucking Bull of the Year for 1998.

Halls Angel's spectacular form continued in 1999 when he claimed a record third straight Bucking Bull of the Year title. That feat had never been achieved before and Halls Angel showed no signs of slowing down as he entered the new millennium.

In both the 2000 and 2001 rodeo seasons Halls Angel again stood out from the pack as the best bucking bull and was crowned the Bucking Bull of the Year in both seasons.

Throughout his career Halls Angel broke a number of records and the formidable record of five consecutive Bucking Bull of the Year titles is one that is unlikely ever be broken. He also holds the record of the highest scoring bull ride in the NRA with both Simon Burke and Clint Lee conquering him for 90 point rides.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING**, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$15.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$22 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5.50 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5.50 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$27.50 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
