--- >>> MEMBERSHIP:

A reminder that membership are due <u>1st January</u>. Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2006 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial).

Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st February 2006' will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited. It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

--- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

--->>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 5499 1700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 5495 8668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

--->>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

--->>> OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

--->>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo -

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

- 1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
- 2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
- The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
- 4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 07 5495 8668.

--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

All competitors please read Central Entry Rules and Regulations and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE. Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

--->>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated. Automatic Entry forms are available from the Office and Central Entry Office at all Rodeos. Please take advantage of this service.

--- >>> **GATE ENTRY:**

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.





COMMITTEES:

--- >>> BACK YARD AREAS:

Rough Stock and Timed event back yard areas are restricted to competitors and rodeo personnel only. Signage to be made available and roped off areas to be the responsibility of the directors in consultation with the committee.

Too many unnecessary people and members of the public are in these areas and it is a matter of safety and insurance that this must be policed.

--->>> NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

--->>> ROUGH STOCK NUMBERING:

Stock numbers must be clearly visible. The Chute Boss has the right to ask the contractors to show the numbers of the stock. Contractors must be prepared to prove the number on a horse if challenged. All numbers must be identifiable. They can be branded or numbered. The cowboys as well as the chute boss should check the number as it goes into the chute. A fine of \$100.00 per head of stock not visibly numbered, will be imposed if this is not adhered to.



NRA Officials:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News. All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$15.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

NRA Board Structure

The current Board of the NRA is made up of:

EXECUTIVE BOARD – 6 Directors OPERATIONAL BOARD – 10 Directors

- 1. Executive Board consists of 3 elected Board members and a maximum of 3 appointed Board members.
- 2. The 3 elected have a term of 3 years each, with one elected each year.
- 3. The 3 appointed are for a one year term and have to be reappointed to serve a further term.
- 4. The operational Board directors are appointed for a 2 year term.
- 5. Any Board appointment to fill a vacancy, will hold that position until the next election of officers.

EXECUTIVE BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Strategic Direction of the Association.
- 2. Finance & Financial Strategies.
- 3. Marketing and Promotional Strategies.
- 4. NRA Administration Memberships, Committees, Head Office Operations.
- 5. Legal, Judicial and Legislative Issues.
- 6. Ratification of all decisions made by the Operational Board of Directors.

OPERATIONAL DIRECTORS BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Operational Issues relating to the conduct of rodeo's in accordance with the Memorandum of Articles of the NRA, approved NRA rules and regulations and the animal Welfare Code of Conduct.
- 2. Appointment/Removal of NRA Officials. ie: Judges, Chute Bosses, Bullfighters, Contractors etc. In accordance with NRA rules and regulations.
- 3. Recommendations to the executive pertaining to amendments to rules for the conduct of NRA rodeos.
- 4. Issue of fines to members for misdemeanour offences.

Serious breaches of the rules to be sent to the chairman of Judiciary for action in accordance with the NRA's adopted Judicial procedures.
