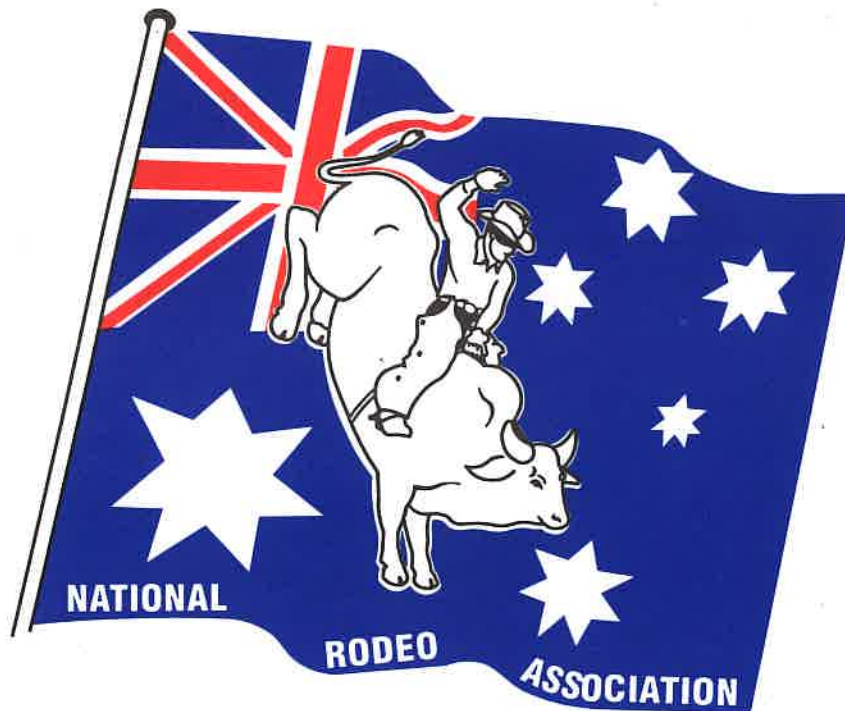

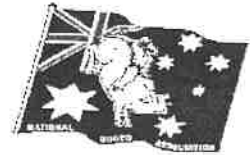

Please read carefully!*



--- >>> **MEMBERSHIP:**

A reminder that membership were due 1st January. Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2005 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial).

Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st February 2005 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited. It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines for the first offence of no less than \$100.00 will be applied if this is not adhered to.

--- >>> TIMEKEEPERS:

Committees, Promotors are required to have a minimum of one (1) official time keeper at a rodeo where Timed Events (other than Barrel Race) are conducted.

--- >>> RODEO CALL BACK:

Call back for rodeos will be available during Central Entries 54991700 on Thursday from 2.00pm to 6.00pm (if entries are being taken) or office hours on Friday - 54958668. If a rodeo advertises a slack, a message will be left on the Central Entries Answering Machine after 12.00 noon Thursday.

--- >>> CANCEL OUT REQUIREMENTS:

All competitors please read Central Entries Rules and Guidelines and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. All competitors please note the rules regarding membership.

--->>> OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

--- >>> INSURANCE PROCEDURES:

If you are injured at a rodeo –

ALL INJURIES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE N.R.A. OFFICE OR THROUGH CENTRAL ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

1. Complete an injury occurrence form available from central entries on the day or have it faxed to the N.R.A. office within 7 days of the rodeo.
2. Please advise the N.R.A. office as soon as possible if you wish to claim from the Insurance Company with this injury.
3. The N.R.A. Office will issue the Insurance Forms once your Injury Occurrence Form has been received and we are informed you wish to claim.
4. All inquiries re Insurance claims are to be directed to the N.R.A. Office on 0754958668.

--- >>> PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES:

All competitors please read Central Entry Rules and Regulations and be particularly aware of cancel out requirements. Because of the growing number of competitors who do not pay their entries or who are late paying their entries **ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU COMPETE.** Central Entries persons will be sending a list of unfinancial competitors to the CHUTE BOSS before each event.

--- >>> AUTOMATIC ENTRY:

Competitors who are automatically entered have the responsibility of cancelling out Monday 12 noon before the rodeo if they do not wish to compete. With the new Central Entries program it is imperative you quote your correct membership number when entering. An incorrect membership number will bring you up as an unfinancial member and therefore can not be nominated. **Automatic Entry forms are available from the Office and Central Entry Office at all Rodeos. Please take advantage of this service.**

--- >>> GATE ENTRY:

Please note all committees have the right to ask competitors for their membership cards so please carry these with you. Committees are very important to us so please do not abuse the privilege of gate entry by using someone else's name.



Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



--- >>> **COMMITTEES:**

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo. The NRA office staff are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive **Public Liability Insurance** Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2004 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

ADDITIONAL EVENTS:

If committees are approached by other organisations or individuals on their behalf with reference to conducting additional events at your rodeo, the NRA Board wishes to advise that prior to making any commitment for the conduct of such events please contact the NRA Head Office for clarification.

ROUGH STOCK NUMBERING:

Stock numbers must be clearly visible. The Chute Boss has the right to ask the contractors to show the numbers of the stock. Contractors must be prepared to prove the number on a horse if challenged. All numbers must be identifiable. They can be branded or numbered. The cowboys as well as the chute boss should check the number as it goes into the chute. A fine of \$100.00 per head of stock not visibly numbered, will be imposed if this is not adhered to.

NRA Officials:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News. *All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.*

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE – Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$15.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

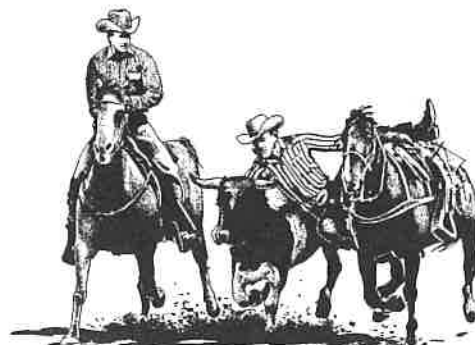

ABOUT CRAIG HAMILTON:

My roping history must begin with an explanation of my family's history with cattle and horses. My grandfather 'Choc' Hamilton was a member of the first professional cowboy association which was called the 'Turtles' - their motto was you don't get anywhere without sticking your neck out. He then qualified for the first ever team roping national finals held in Clayton, New Mexico.

My father Bill Hamilton grew up roping and working the range with Choc and then ultimately became the team roping champion of the world in the professional rodeo cowboys association. Along with 15 national finals qualifications, he was the National team roping director for eight years, and was the one responsible for making team roping a standard event in the western states. During his term as director he also changed team roping from tie down to dally which as anyone who ropes knows is the reason the immense popularity the sport enjoys today. My own career in roping began at an early age as well. I started swinging a rope about the same time as I started walking and roped my first steer from a horse at the age of 5. Roping, horses and cattle were all that I knew for many years until I became a professional cowboy at the age of 16. One note of distinction here is that I was 'voted' into the pro ranks without having to first fill a rookie permit, something that was rare then and non-existent today.

I team roped and also roped calves at the pro level and qualified for the national finals team roping in 1986 & 87.

Along the way I won or placed at most of the major roping and rodeos in the Nation. A few of my wins at pro level include - Oakdale, CA team roping; Las Vegas NV team roping; Colorado Springs, CO team roping; Rowell ranch rodeo team roping; and Kingman AZ team roping, Denver Stock Show;

Albuquerque, NM; Odessa, Tx; Salt Lake City, Utah, Tuscon AZ, Pheonix AZ, Cave Creek AZ, Clovis Ca, San Fransisco Ca, Palm Springs Ca, Red Lodge Mt, Globe, AZ Prescott, Az, Payson, Az, Bremerton, Wa. Walla Walla, Wa. Greely Co.

I am the only man to ever win all three of the California series 'open to the world' winner take all match ropins in a single year. I won two while heading for Allen Bach, and one while heading for Clay O'Brien Cooper. I also am the co-producer of the team roping instructional video 'Team Roping Basics' with Allen Bach. In 1987 I began to focus more on my training and horsemanship than on the Pro Rodeo trail. Since that time I have taught roping and horsemanship clinics across the US from East to West, and North to South. I teach in Canada, Hawaii, Alaska and soon to be in Australia as well. I teach all aspects of roping, from basics of swinging a rope, to proper body positions, to the most in-depth mental aspects of mind control and winning.

I do not have a gold buckle to show off, what I have instead are great communciation skills, wonderfully clear techniques, a 'give a damn' attitude and far more quality information than you and ten others like you can absorb in any three day clinic. So if you want to seriously improve your 'roping' 'horsemanship' and 'mental game' and serious enough about it to want more from a clinic than to just rub shoulders with the latest name in lights, then I am the best in the business.

In fact, I am so sure about what I can do and show you that I make this guarantee at all of my clinics.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

- Entry Times** Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.
- When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.
- Members** When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.
- Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.
- Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.
- Day Members** Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.
- Day membership \$15.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.
- All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.
- Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.
- Reference Number** Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.
- Late Entries** Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$22 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.
- Cancellations** Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 12 noon Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5.50 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5.50 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.
- Hotline** The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$27.50 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
