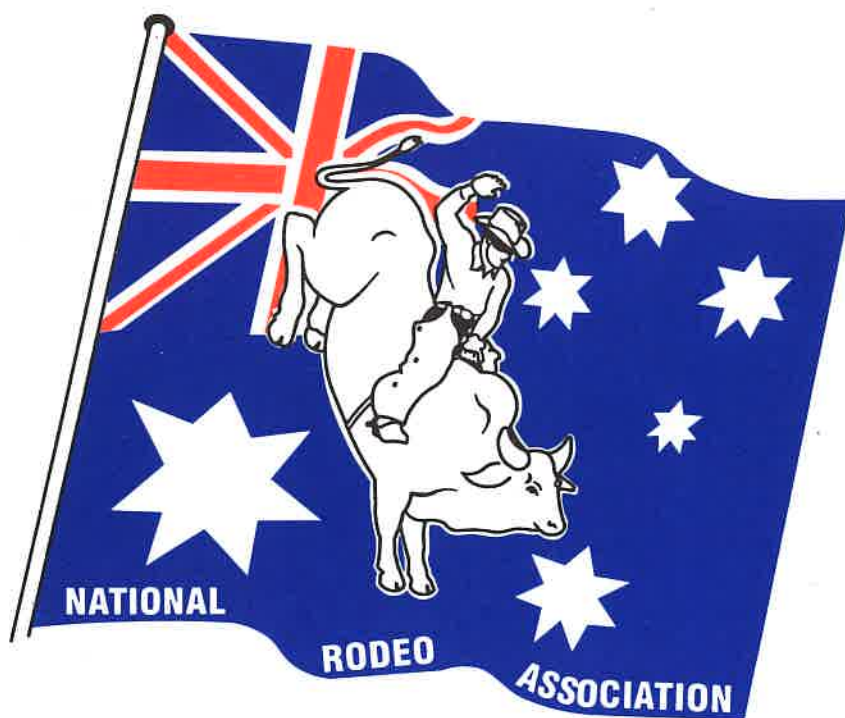

Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



COMMITTEES:

--- >>> BACK YARD AREAS:

Rough Stock and Timed event back yard areas are restricted to competitors and rodeo personnel only. Signage to be made available and roped off areas to be the responsibility of the directors in consultation with the committee.

Too many unnecessary people and members of the public are in these areas and it is a matter of safety and insurance that this must be policed.

--- >>> NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

--- >>> ROUGH STOCK NUMBERING:

Stock numbers must be clearly visible. The Chute Boss has the right to ask the contractors to show the numbers of the stock. Contractors must be prepared to prove the number on a horse if challenged. All numbers must be identifiable. They can be branded or numbered. The cowboys as well as the chute boss should check the number as it goes into the chute. A fine of \$100.00 per head of stock not visibly numbered, will be imposed if this is not adhered to.



NRA Officials:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News. *All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.*

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with the names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

It will be an offence for a committee or promotor not having financial N.R.A members acting in official capacities. (Announcer, Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeeper, Pick-up Team, Bull Fighting Clowns etc). Fines will be applied if this is not adhered to.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE – Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, e.g. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at **\$15.00** per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

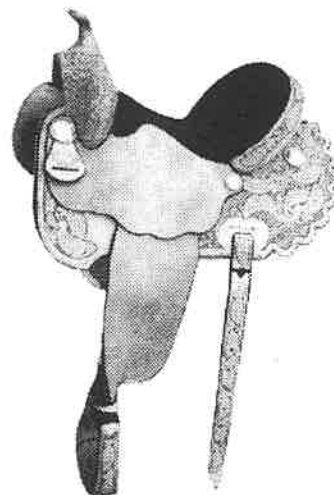

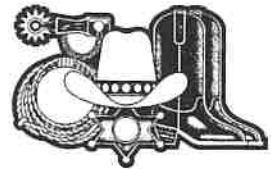

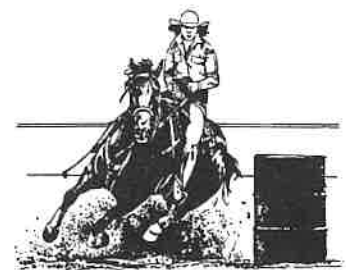

BRYAN and MARLENE KOFOED

An era in Rodeo came to an end in June 2005 when Bryan & Marlene Kofoed retired from the rodeo scene. The thirty plus year journey began when Bryan's interest in rodeo surfaced in 1970, as a committee man on the Oakey Rodeo Committee. As his knowledge and enthusiasm grew, his services and expertise has been sought by numerous committees. The most notable being St Vincent's, a committee that Bryan served 30 years plus with the last 30 years as president. With Marlene by his side and a dedicated team of helpers, an enormous amount of funds have been passed onto the hospital.

Bryan Kofoed the contractor commenced his career with just three (3) horses namely "Cyclone", "Tracey" and "Whiskey" in 1973. The pen grew to thirty over the years and boasted many top bucking stock. Two of these won NRA Bucking Horse titles – the first "Masta Plasta" in 1984, followed by "Jedda" in 1998. However "Cyclone" remained the family favourite, a horse that commenced bucking at aged 4 at the Oakey Rodeo and retired 26 years later at the same rodeo.

The contracting days concluded in 1997 when the rodeo stock was sold. Some ten years ago B&B rodeo was formed by the Kofoeds to enable the couple to use the many years of knowledge of the sport, to assist charities in their fund raising endeavours. A very successful operation, which benefited the community and enables, Bryan to retain some part of his passion for rodeo.

Outside of contracting, promoting and running the family property, Bryan found time to accept the position as stock contractors representative on the NRA Board, a job he excelled at in trying times. The NRA bestowed Life Membership to Bryan in 1998 in honour of many years as a contractor, promoter and major supporter of the industry.

With the retirement of Bryan and Marlene, rodeo has lost a valued combination. We thank them for their many years of dedicated support, friendship and trust they will have many fond memories of their achievements.

Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$50.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$50.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

Rookie points will be recorded in the open standings - 'R' beside the competitor's name. Members wishing to be classified as a Rookie must do so in writing to the NRA Office.

Novice points will no longer appear in the standings in the newsletter. They will be tabulated in the office and be available to competitors through Central Entries and the Secretary on the day at Rodeos. As a competitor 'Breaks Open' he or she will be notified in writing from the office and recorded in the 'Break Open' Register. These competitors' names will be published in the monthly newsletter in a Break Open section.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times Wednesday 10am - 2pm and Thursday 2pm - 6pm. If there are more than two rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries if not already printed in the newsletter.

When NOMINATING you must have your membership number as no entries will be accepted without it. When CANCELLING, you must give your reference number and membership number, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait for your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day Members

Day Members must enter as above to obtain a reference number.

Day membership \$15.00 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for Maximum and Full Point Rodeos. Day membership \$5.50 for Senior Competitors and \$2.20 for Junior Competitors for all other classification of Rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association.

All day members are required to register at the rodeo with the Central Entries Office and sign the day membership book which binds them to N.R.A. Rules and the Animal Welfare Code of Practice. Junior Competitors are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian before they are eligible to compete.

Day members must have their nomination fees and day membership fees received by the office by the Monday preceding the rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in their entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo. All members late entries will automatically be accompanied by a \$22 late fine and Juniors \$2 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not. Day members will not incur a late entry fee. Entry fee plus day membership must be received as per day membership.

Cancellations

Any cancellations before 12noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 12 noon Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5.50 administration fine (with or without a Vet's / Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's / Doctor's certificate, then only the Committee Levy and \$5.50 Administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by N.R.A. office.

Hotline

The N.R.A. Central Entries phone will be on two (2) hours prior to the commencement of the rodeo. The Central Entries phone is available on the day for notification of any unforeseen circumstances. This notification must be received before the draws are commenced. It is the individual's responsibility to personally advise any changes necessary. No responsibility will be accepted by the office if you fail to comply with this request.

Rules and Guidelines Contd.

Medical Out

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above, the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

Insurance Form

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the central entries office on the day and submit a copy to N.R.A. Head Office 12 noon Monday. It is the competitor's responsibility to complete the claim forms and get them to N.R.A. Office by 12 noon Monday.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$27.50 turn out fine. Any entries not paid will incur a late payment fine.

Contractors

The stock numbers for the following rodeo will be available from 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE TUESDAY 12 NOON PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY NOT BEING ACCEPTED.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
Points are accrued from **Open Competition Only**.
(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

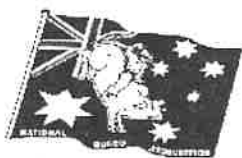
In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office. As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
