


MEMBERSHIP




NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

GREAT OLD HORSE RETIRES

The great steer wrestling horse "Boom" owned by Brad and Brooke Cavanagh has been retired from the rodeo arena. Arthritis has caught up with him and he went out as a champion by carrying Brad to his fourth NRA steer wrestling title last year. He is 21 years old this year.

"Boom" was born in 1985 and was bred by Garry McPhee in Victoria. He was purchased by Steve Bland at Warwick. Brad Cavanagh bought him from Steve in 1994. Trevor Ross delivered "Boom" to the Cavanagh property on that day in 1994 and to this day he still says the worst mistake he made was to unload him there and not take him home himself. The day Trevor dropped him off, Brad and his father Doc hazed a few steers off him and they both said we better pay for this horse quickly before someone else gets him. He was purchased as a horse who you could steer wrestle and head steers off. The first 12 months Brad had him, he was almost impossible to steer wrestle off, by bowing his whole body away from the steer making it very hard to get a clean catch. So for the first 12 months he had him, they just headed steers and hazed off him.

At the end of the 1994 rodeo season, Doc and Brad were travelling and using a borrowed steer wrestling horse and the owner required this horse back, thus leaving them without a steer wrestling horse. One night late in that year in the Caboolture Indoor Arena, Doc and Brad were working some cattle and Doc said to Brad, "You better get on Boom and run some steers, we need a horse for next year." On that night "Boom" seemed to lose most of his bowing away from steers and rest is history. For the next 12 months Doc, Brad and Shane Hart rode "Boom" steer wrestling. Most people thought they were mad riding him because of his bowing action. Come two years down the track these people were lining up wanting to ride him. Brad continued to head steers on him for the next 18 months and "Boom" then decided he did not want to tow steers anymore. This problem could have been worked out of him but Brad knew that steer wrestling was going to be this horse's event so he decided to stop roping on him.

Brads' first steer wrestling win was on "Boom" at the 1995 Casino Beef Week Rodeo. "Boom" carried Brad to his first steer wrestling average title at the 1995 NRA Finals. However at Australia's Most Famous Rodeo at Warwick that year was a weekend where "Boom" shone. He carried Ian Allen to the win and Brad to second place.

The 1997 season was a big year for event wins and titles for "Boom". He carried Darren Milburn to a win at Australia's largest rodeo at Mt Isa. And throughout the year he carried Brad to his first NRA steer wrestling title. Ann Maree Hasselbach won her 1997 Steer Undecorating title on him as well. "Boom" continued his form into the 1998 season by carrying Mark Kasper in the 2nd half of the year to the NRA Steer Wrestling title. In the 1999 season he carried Brooke to her first NRA Steer Undecorating title.


The 2000 season "Boom" was back on the trail again. He carried Len Kimber to the win at the Cloncurry Merry Muster Rodeo and carried Brad to his second NRA steer wrestling title and Brooke to her second NRA Steer Undecorating title. "Boom" backed up the NRA Steer Wrestling title up the next year but this time it was with Darren Milburn.

In the 2003 season "Boom" carried Brooke to her third NRA Steer Undecorating title. The pair backed this feat up in the 2004 season. This same year Brad rode "Boom" to his third NRA Steer Wrestling title. The pair then backed up this title in the 2005 season. "Boom" went out as a true champion by winning this title in his last season.

Along the way "Boom" has been instrumental in helping Brooke win 10 of her 11 NRA All Round Cowgirl Titles and Brad win two NRA All Round Cowboy titles. "Boom" has carried many other top cowboys of this nation to wins and places in the steer wrestling including Heath Kimber, Shane Kenny, Glen Perkins and Shane Iker to name a few.

"Boom" will now enjoy his retirement on the Frahm property at Toorbul next to one of his old travelling partners in Troy Cavanagh's rope horse "Gray". He will be looking over his shoulder for his best mate to join him one day in the form of Brooke's great barrel racing horse "Dusty".

"Boom" will be sadly missed on the circuit by a number of cowboys and cowgirls but no more than his owners in Brad and Brooke. There will never be another horse like "Boom". Long live the legend of "Boom".
