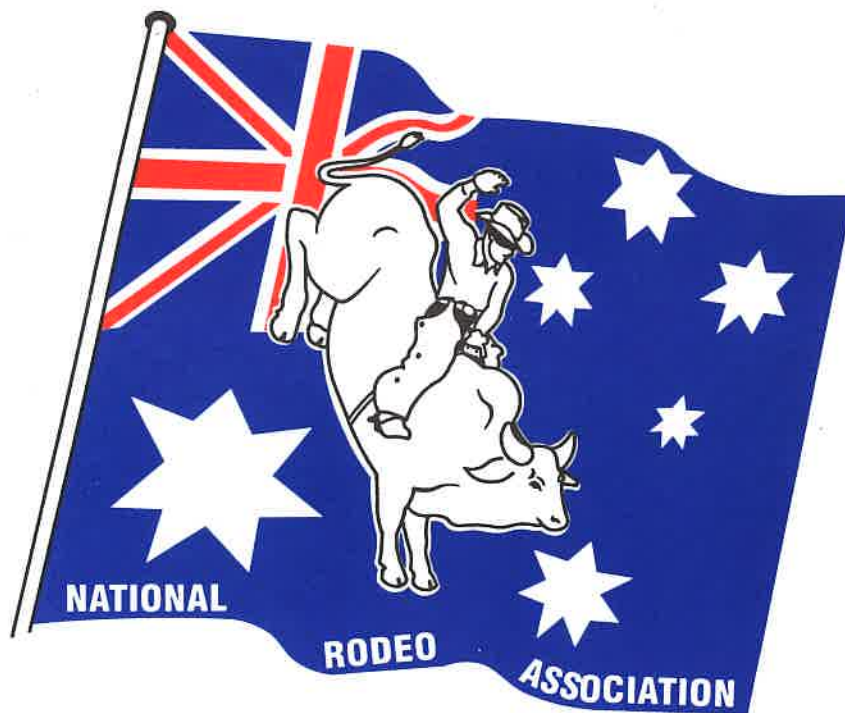

(All owings must be included with memberships to become financial) Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st February 2006 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of members must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

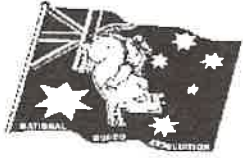

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

COMMITTEES:

--->>> NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

--->>> ASSISTANCE WITH RODEO ORGANISATION

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organization of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

--->>> PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

***two (2) NRA approved Judges, and
one (1) approved timekeeper.***

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

JUNIORS competing in OPEN events MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

JUNIOR COMPETITORS – RE MEMBERSHIP

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY In Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

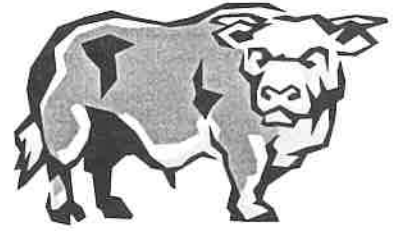

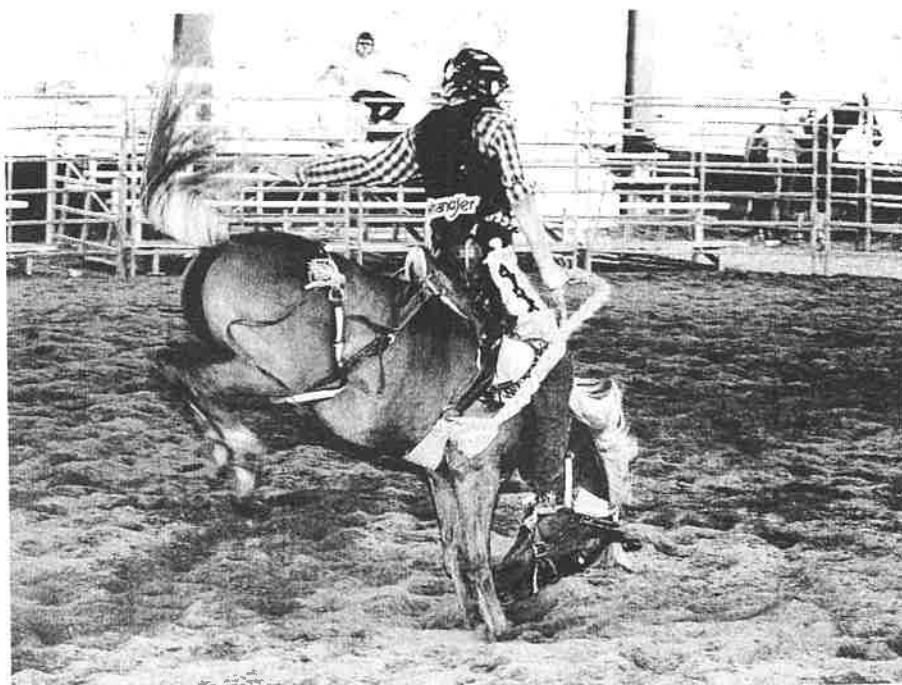

Special Conditions:

1. Entries will not be accepted if there are previous unpaid debts, eg unpaid entries, fines, bounced cheques.
2. **If a rodeo is postponed after entries are taken, you will be notified if entries will remain or all entries cancelled and re taken – depending on the time frame.**
3. **Entry times may be extended when entries are taken for more than two rodeos.**

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, should there be any problems with your entries at a Rodeo. Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

LATE ENTRIES:

All entries outside C/E Times will be deemed a late entry and will be automatically accompanied by a late fine of \$22 for Seniors and \$2.20 for Juniors. Late entries are only accepted until 12 noon on the Monday preceding the rodeo. To submit a late entry please follow the entry procedure and they may be left on the answering machine on the C/E line or by contacting the office. Late entry is not a guarantee your entry will be accepted. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries are accepted.

CALL BACK:

Call back will be available on the Central Entries Line after 2.00pm Thursday (only on days of entries or during office hours).

NOMINATIONS:

It is up to each individual competitor to check the draw sheets prior to the commencement of the Rodeo to make sure that their nomination is correct. Please see your event administrator if you have a problem. After the Rodeo has commenced, no discrepancies will be looked into.

HOTLINE: 0412 725319 (Available on day of Rodeo only)

The NRA Central Entries phone will be available on the day of the rodeo only. It is to be used for notification of any unforeseen circumstances.

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

On the day of the Rodeo, nominations must be paid as promptly as possible – preferably before half time as the Central Entry person is busy doing payouts after this time. Please remember should you have any queries other than those related to central entries on the day please refer these to your event director.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, membership number, reference number and event. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. Cancellations before 12 noon of Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee, which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 12 noon Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus administration fine (with or without a Vet's/Doctors Certificate. Any cancellations after 12 noon preceding the rodeo will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vets/Doctors certificate is received, then only committee Levy and Administration will be paid. After 12.00noon Friday the NRA Office will accept no cancellations. The hotline may be used on the day of the rodeo. Any unnotified cancellations will incur full nominations plus a turn out fine. Cancellations must be done through the NRA Office or an NRA director to be accepted.

PRE PERFORMANCE:

All members please note. Individual committees set programs and it is up to their discretion, which events are to be in the pre performance or main performance. Therefore it is up to you, the competitor to call the Central Entry line before a rodeo where a pre performance is advertised. Where possible this is available from 12 noon Thursday prior to the Rodeo.

GATELIST:

The gate list is a list of competitors competing on the day at a particular rodeo. This is issued to committees to allow competitors admission to the rodeo. Competitors only are admitted. You must have your membership card on hand for identification if the committee requires it. In the case where you are competing and your name does not appear on the gate list, you must pay your admission fee and take your ticket to the Central Entries person on the day for verification and refund.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed - (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Thursday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owing for turnouts or fines etc. on that particular day. This will ensure your entries are valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical Out is found necessary from an event at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the First Aid Officer on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential; otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claim forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer at the Rodeo and must be completed and faxed to the N.R.A. office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE:

For persons officiating in the arena at a Rodeo, eg. bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$15.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day prior to the commencement of the rodeo, if they require this cover.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from **Open Competition only**. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an **R** beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open."

Rookie Breaks Open:

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.
