



### NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM


As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

## BAREBACK DIRECTOR REPORT

As most people are aware I have served on the Executive Board of the National Rodeo Association for a number of years in the past. However this is my first year as an event director. I took on the role of Bareback Director because it is an event that I really enjoy as a competitor, a spectator and a stock contractor. I have also had some success in this event during my rodeo career and would like to think that I have something to offer in the development of Bareback riding competitors.

The Bareback has traditionally been an event that has struggled for numbers so it has been refreshing to see the number of young Bareback riders competing in the open ranks this year. It has also been very encouraging to see the participation in the Bareback at the Junior rodeos that have been conducted this year. At the Toowoomba Show Junior Rough Stock Rodeo five out of the six competitors made qualified rides. This is an outstanding effort from kids that have not been on too many horses.

One of my goals as the director of this event is to help all of these young guys, and any others that are interested, to develop into competitive Bareback riders. Anyone who would like some help with their Bareback riding should feel free to approach me for assistance at any time.

It is good to see a real battle in the Bareback standings this year with Heath Wallace, Guy Hall, Tom Durbridge and Bill Church all riding well. It is also good to see Greg Meech come back from a very serious neck injury and once again be competitive. I hope to also see last year's champion, B J Shephard, make a long awaited comeback from injury later this year. This year's finals could be a real spectacle with these six guys all in good form and the younger guys coming through with a few more horses under them.

Finally I would like to congratulate all of the stock contractors who have turned out their horses in great condition this year. All of the contractors have very good pens of horses to get on and we have seen some very good Bareback riding because of it.



JUNIOR COMPETITORS - RE MEMBERSHIP


Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.


