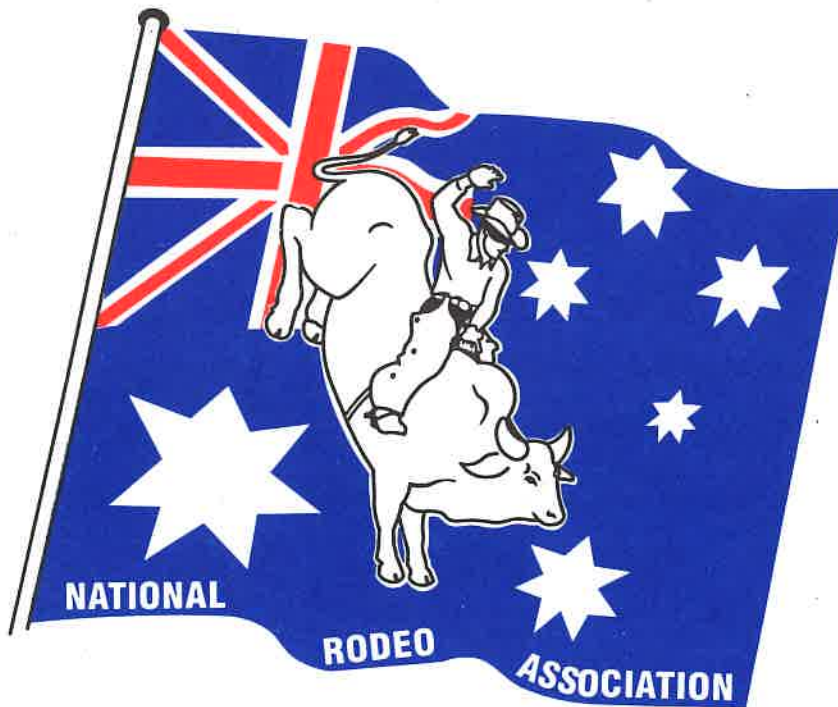

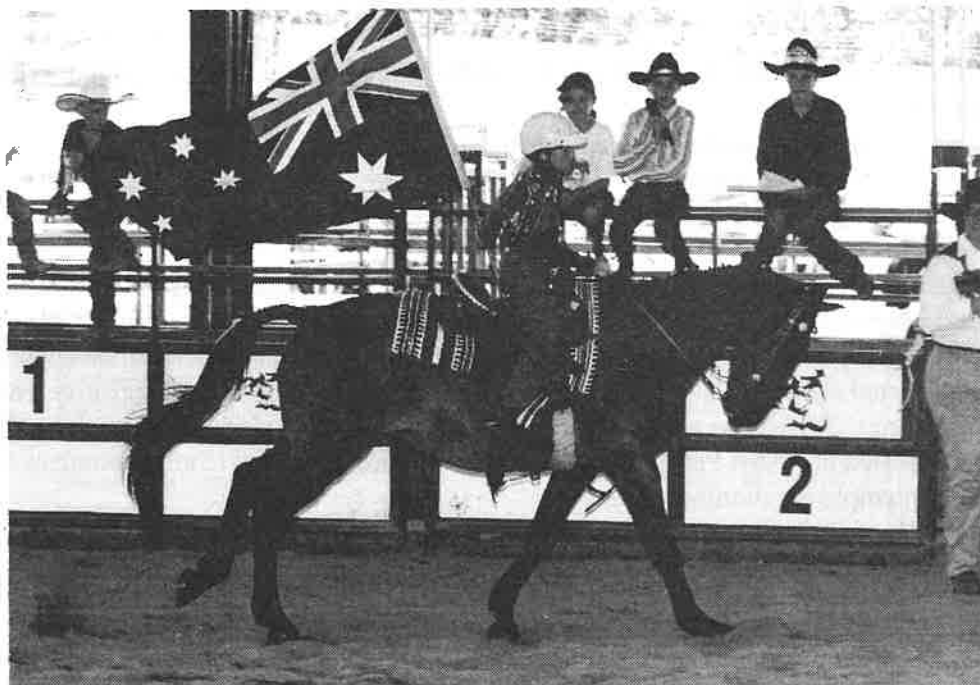

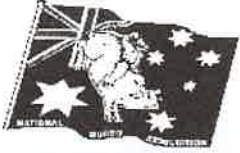

**--->>> OUTSTANDING FEES:**

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

**COMMITTEES:**

**--->>> NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM**

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

**--->>> ASSISTANCE WITH RODEO ORGANISATION**

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organization of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

**--->>> PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE**

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2006 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

**--->>> NRA OFFICIALS**

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

***All NRA approved rodeos must have:-***

***two (2) NRA approved Judges, and  
one (1) approved timekeeper.***

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News. Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

## Operations Director Report

---

### Breakaway Roping

I would like to take this opportunity to discuss some points of concern, which have come to my attention over the last couple of months. But before I go any further please do not take this report the wrong way – NO! I am not perfect and YES I have made mistakes, but as I have grown older, I like to think that I have grown a little wiser and a little more educated.

I would firstly like to point out one simple fact – that you as a rider are to blame for any mistakes your horses make. YES, it is true! You are the driving force behind what you have created. You control the speed and you control the signals. If by chance your horse lets you down at a rodeo, it may be that you have given the wrong signal or you have asked of him/her what you have not yet taught them. A horse is only as good as its rider. Believe me, I have had some horses throughout my rodeo time, and with every one I have ridden and trained, I have learnt more and more. No horse is the same! They have different needs and sometimes they take longer to teach. Just because you have purchased a horse with great breeding, it doesn't mean they will become an overnight success.

So please, next time you stuff up in the rodeo arena, DON'T be pulling or jerking on your horse's head for no reason – the only thing this does is make you look like an idiot, not in front of me but in front of the whole public that is watching you! And DON'T go out the back and slap your horse or treat him unkindly, because YES people are still watching you – ME!

Take the time before you enter the rodeo arena and think of what you are going to do. What your plan is for the day, and how you will attack that plan. Remembering that 90% of the pressure you are feeling, your horse is feeling. Your body language dictates what your next move is going to be – it can be as simple as "Yes, I have the faith in myself and my horse to perform the task," or it can be "Don't you dare stuff up or I'll go on flogging you." I can tell you now – no horse is going to perform under threat!! WOULD YOU!

I may sound a little harsh with what I am saying – but it is evident that horsemanship and sportsmanship are lacking at this present time, and I know a lot of you have the ability to rise above and be more professional. Take your problems home and work on solving them in your back yard. DO NOT DRILL YOUR HORSE AT THE RODEO! For that matter do not drill yourself either. If you are having problems, please take the time to talk to someone who is more experienced and ask for their advice. Who knows, it just might help you and it doesn't cost you a cent. It may just be a simple thing as a bit, or a training method you may need to change. Just because you have got the biggest hunk of steel you can find to put in your horse's mouth, it doesn't mean he is going to stop any better. Keeping your horse square, balanced and collected is also a benefiting factor.

I guess what I am trying to say is that you are very much in the public eye, and people do not always forget what they see, sometimes it can stick in their mind. We have certain Animal Welfare regulations that we need to abide by, not only for contractors but for competitors alike. Your presence and attitude contribute a lot to what the general public's opinion will be.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank our rodeo contractors for their contribution to our rodeos, but in the same instance, we need healthy, good looking cattle and horses. The general public are not fools, they are the judge and jury!

Last but not least, I was fortunate enough over the last couple of weeks to attend a roping clinic held by Craig Hamilton from the USA. I have never to this day met such a competitive, positive and most of all well-educated cowboy. I have won some titles in my rodeo career, and thought YES I know quite a lot about roping. WRONG! I am at present on a big learning curve – one that will take me even further in helping to develop my own mental state of mind and how to CORRECTLY train time event horses. Craig has an ability to lift your attitude and his positive attitude and belief in you is amazing. Do you know how it feels to have someone believe in you so strongly, that it makes you feel ten feet tall and bulletproof – I DO – and now I am going to put this into play. I feel stronger mentally knowing that I still have a lot to learn about roping and training horses. Not a lot of people attended the roping schools, which I thought was sad only for the loss of information to them. But as for Mick and myself – it was the best money we have yet contributed to our roping careers.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Lachlan Hornery for bringing Craig back over to Australia, and to thank Craig himself for his time and effort spent on Mick and myself.

OH! One very last comment – I would like to see more cowboys and cowgirls in the grand entries at our rodeos. Don't rely on anybody coming to round you up – you are all grown up now! Also I would like to see more rodeos presenting the winners of the events with a lap of honour. It is about time we as a rodeo family start promoting and cheering our winners with a lap of honour. So hopefully, all you rodeo promoters please take note and put some gratitude back to the competitors

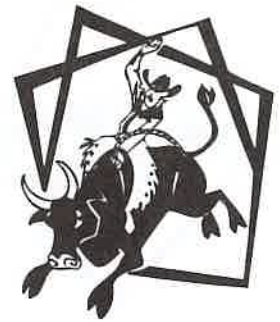
