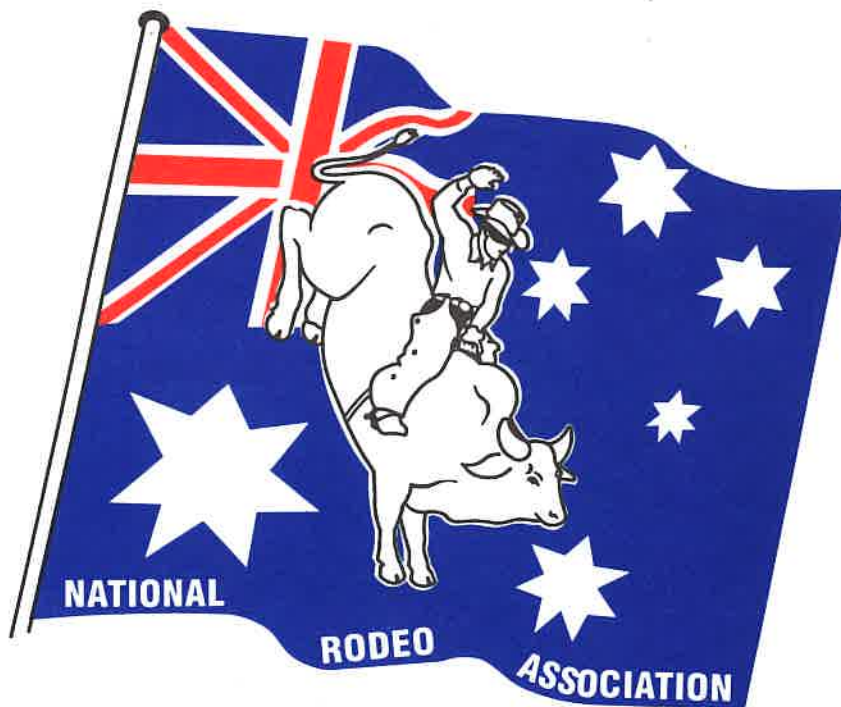

Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2006 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial) Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st February 2006 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of members must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

--->>> OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BRA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines. The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month. Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

COMMITTEES:

--->>> NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

--->>> ASSISTANCE WITH RODEO ORGANISATION

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organization of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

--->>> PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from **Open Competition only**. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an **R** beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open."

Rookie Breaks Open:

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.

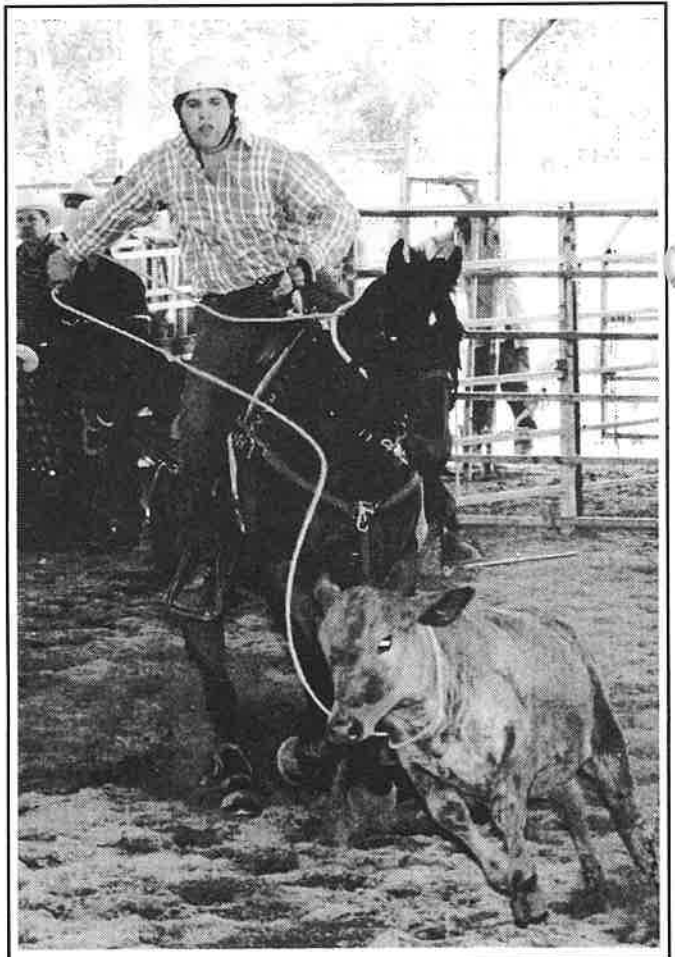

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY In Junior Events. If you wish to compete In an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

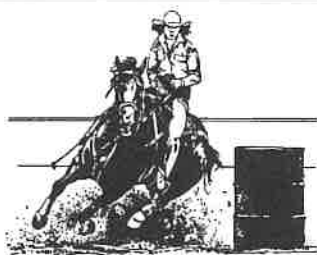


JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT DAY - CANUNGRA 25th June 2006

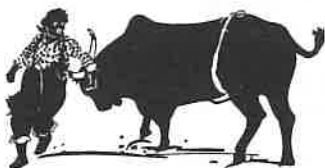
