26 BUCKING HORSE OF THE YEAR TITLES!

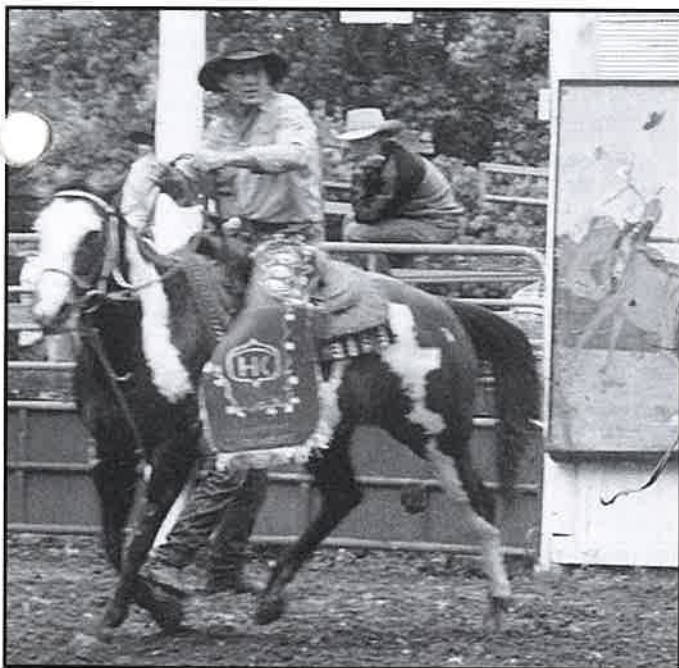
Kerry began his association with Rodeo at the age of sixteen and during his riding career was crowned the 1969, 70, 71, 73 & 74 Rope & Tie Champion and the 1971, 73 & 74 Steer Wrestling Champion. During this time he set an Australian record time of 3.0 seconds in the Steer Wrestling contest. Kerry was also one of the best rough stock competitors on the circuit finishing runner-up several times for the Saddle Ride and Bareback Ride titles. He was also runner up to the All Round on numerous occasions.

Kerry has won a record total of six (6) Pick Up Man of the Year titles with the most recent being in the current rodeo season.

He was a foundation member of the NRA (formerly SEQRRA) and has retained this membership for the entire duration of the organisation. His membership number is the second recorded.

Kerry has been a stock contractor with the NRA since its inception and has won a record 26 Bucking Horse of the Year titles and a record 9 Bucking Bull of the Year titles. He currently contracts stock to around 50 rodeos per year.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees - Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organization of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2006 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges, and
one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chuteboss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer - all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.



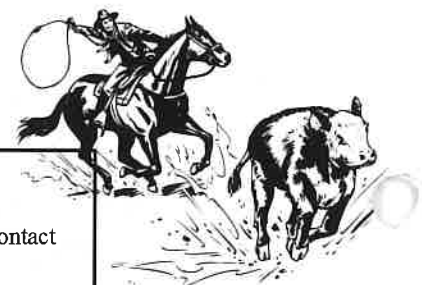

Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2007 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial). **ALL UNFINANCIAL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN DELETED FROM OUR DATA BASE INCLUDING OFFICIALS.** Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st March 2007 will incur a \$11 late fine. **Please note:** This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



JUNIORS IN RODEO

It is compulsory for ALL Competitors who compete in Junior Events to wear a Protective Helmet whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo Event.

***ALL JUNIOR COMPETITORS MUST WEAR A FULL FACE HELMET WHEN COMPETING IN ANY ROUGH STOCK EVENT.**

If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

JUNIORS competing in **OPEN EVENTS** **MUST HAVE OPEN MEMBERSHIP.**

JUNIOR COMPETITORS – RE MEMBERSHIP

Junior Membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior Events. If you wish to compete in an Open Event, you must upgrade your membership to Open Membership. Men's open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). Girls open upgrade of membership is membership upgrade of \$88.00 (from \$44.00 to \$132.00) plus upgrade of bond of \$35.00 (from \$15.00 to \$50.00). *The only exception to this is where there is not a junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this open event by paying open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.*

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

TEAM ROPERS

Any Team Ropers needing a partner - please post next to draws. Do not leave to the last minute. ONLY after all avenues of finding a partner from Team Roping entries have been exhausted, can a substitute be used.

GRAND ENTRY

A list will appear at the Central Entries office for all Championship Rodeos of competitors for the Grand Entry. If you are unable to participate it is your responsibility to provide a replacement and to advise the Central Entries personal as soon as possible so the Rodeo Queen and Announcer can be advised.

RULE OF THE MONTH

Misdemeanours:

Shall be considered for Turnout fines, Cut horse fines, Late entry fines, Busted Calf fines, Scratchings, Cancellations, Failure to pay nominations on time, Dishonoured Cheques, Dress Infringements, under the influence of alcohol or drugs, abusive language, failure to obey direction from Directors or Officials.

NOTES

Common Courtesy - Please consider others when parking at a rodeo. Committees usually have certain sections for trailers and floats, competitor parking and spectator parking. Please use the area assigned to your requirements, limiting your area without jeopardising the comfort of others.

Gate Entry - Please have your membership card on hand if committees request this at the gate. Committees gate keepers are very busy so be polite and make their job as quick and easy as possible.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent or changed into cheque form. Cash will be forwarded to the next available rodeo. **If a cheque is requested a cost of \$5.00 be incurred and these will be deducted from the money before the cheque is sent.**

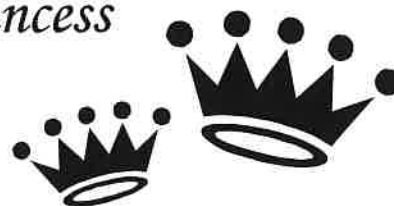

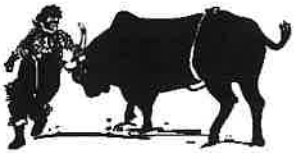
