THE COWBOY WAY

Sunday 1st July 2007 at the Mulgowie Hotel was a day which proved that the bond between the Rodeo Community was as strong as ever. With around three hundred people gathering in a relaxed atmosphere that was more like a family BBQ instead of an assembly of top bucking bulls and bull riders all ready to face off and do battle.

The reason for this gathering was not to see who had the best bull or who the best rider was. The goal of this "family" gathering was to rally round a mate, who while doing what he loved almost paid the ultimate sacrifice. That mate is professional bull rider Saras Ramsay, who only a few weeks earlier sustained near fatal injuries at a rodeo which has had him in a serious condition in hospital since.

In an effort to help ease the burden on his wife and two children stock contractor and former professional bull rider Mik Foxlee got on the phone to his fellow stock contracting peers to see what they could do. Eight days later Foxlee had his bulls and those of four other top contractors. Tony Bruggy from Kyogle in New South Wales made the trip up with eight of his best, along with Terry O'Neill from Caboolture, Ricky Ruhland from Mt Walker and Hall Rodeo Company of Willowbank who all donated their time and top bulls to help the cause.

Terry has had a long and productive association with the NRA. Commencing as a rodeo committee member, being the father of a former top cowboy in son Brett, official and executive director.

1995 saw Terry accept a non directorship as a marketing consultant. He was elevated to an executive director in 1996 and missing only two meetings continued in this capacity until his resignation.

The Jim Beam Silver Buckle Series was negotiated by him in 1995 and for some 11 years Terry managed this Series, somewhat of a record for a sponsorship agreement. We all owe him a debt of gratitude for its success.

Our Coffee Fix Bull Riding Series in another example of his ability to negotiate with sponsor to ensure a successful result, as this series goes from strength to strength. Many NRA members have won trophies manufactured by Terry. I am please to say many more will as he is continuing to provide end of year surprise awards.

On behalf of the NRA board, members, friends I wish Terry and family a wonderful future and offer our sincere thanks for the contribution and dedication.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1 2006, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2007 Rodeos. (All owing must be included with memberships to become financial). ALL UNFINANCIAL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN DELETED FROM OUR DATA BASE INCLUDING OFFICIALS. Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st March 2007 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. <u>Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred.</u>

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

RULE OF THE MONTH

DRESS CODE

(a) All rodeo personnel competing and officiating at a rodeo must be in full western dress one (1) hour prior to the rodeo commencing or when they enter the rodeo grounds.

Western attire consists of a hat, boots, jeans or western pants and a long sleeve western shirt with sleeves buttoned down and a collar. All attire must be worn in a neat and tidy manner. The rule applies to competitors, chute boss, announcers, pick-up teams, judges, time keepers, central entries personnel, stock contractors and their assistants. Clowns may wear runners. Sleeves may be rolled up on riding hand in Rough Stock events.

- (b) Should an appointed Director or Official deem a competitor to be wearing unsuitable attire, the competitor may be called from the arena:
- (i) Instructed to change attire
- (ii) Fined
- (iii) Disqualified for non compliance in either (i) or (ii)

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

GRAND ENTRY

A list will appear at the Central Entries office for all Championship Rodeos of competitors for the Grand Entry. If you are unable to participate it is your responsibility to provide a replacement and to advise the Rodeo Queen as soon as possible so the Announcer can be advised.

TEAM ROPERS

Any Team Ropers needing a partner – please post next to draws. Do not leave to the last minute. ONLY after all avenues of finding a partner from Team Roping entries have been exhausted, can a substitute be used.

As these schools will be held regularly, the Juniors are encouraged to participate in no more than 2 events over the full weekend, to enable more detailed instruction and structuring of the activities. It is also important for the Juniors interested in certain events to have their own equipment (eg. ropes, pigging strings, horses, helmets etc). Many thanks to Doc, Troy, Terry, Alan, Tanya, Denae, Melissa, Darren, Amanda, Greg, Debbie and Dawn, plus all of the other helpers. It would be appreciated by our Juniors if there are any other Open competitors/members willing to assist at the next school. A 2nd Rough Stock School is in the planning, so keep looking in the newsletter for the date.





IMPORTANT RULES

- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must UPGRADE your membership to Open membership:- both Men's and Ladies' Open membership of \$88 (from \$44 to \$132) plus bond of \$35 (from \$15 to \$50)*
- <u>Note*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
