SHEA FISHER - "EVERYDAY GIRL"

Shea Fisher was born in Portland Victoria in April 1988. She's the daughter of Australian bull riding and bareback riding champion Eddie Fisher and barrel racing champion Joanne Fisher. Shea started to ride and compete in rodeos at the age of 3 when she entered her first barrel race and for the next few years the Fisher family travelled Australia competing in rodeo competitions.

At the age of seven Shea won her first junior barrel race against 18 year old and in 1997 she won her first National Rodeo Association Junior Barrel Racing title. Shea was National Rodeo Association Princess in 2002.

At only 19 years of age, Shea is unquestionably a star of the future. A dynamic performer with a great voice, Shea's gorgeous, gutsy and has a unique story. Her debut album, *Everyday Girl*, showcases Shea's fresh approach to country music.

"From a young age, I've just naturally worn a lot of different 'hats'; there's the songwriter and performer, the rodeo chick, the beach girl and then I'm also a normal teenager who just wants to have a good time with my mates", says Shea. "It has been such an incredible journey so far, and I know this is only the beginning."

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1 2006, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred.

Please note:** This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

At the end of this year we will be receiving jackets from "Ride Tuff" for all the finals qualifiers for Breakaway Roping. I am at presently looking into fund raising for the jackets, but don't leave it all up to me. We need to raise at least \$1200 to \$1300, and we need to start looking now and not 2 weeks prior to the finals. I don't care if you are a barrel racer, bonc rider or bull rider in the first event. It takes 5 MINUTES of your precious time to ride one lap of the arena. If you don't have a horse – come and see me and I will get you one.

I would also like to see more committees present their event winners with a lap of honour at the conclusion of the events. I think the competitors deserve a little more recognition for their efforts. Just see Peta and she will arrange the necessary horses for it.

RULE OF THE MONTH

JUNIOR AGE LIMITS

Junior Barrel Race. Junior Breakaway roping. Junior Rope and Tie. Boys Junior Bull Ride. Bareback and Saddle Ride: All competitors must be seventeen (17) years or under as at 1st January.

Boys Junior Steer Ride:

Competitors must be fifteen (15) years and under as at 1st January.

Poddy Ride:

Competitors must be eleven (11) years and under as at 1st January.

TEAM ROPERS

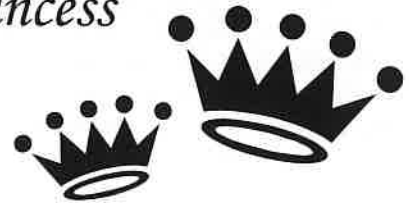

*It is compulsory for ALL competitors who compete in Junior events to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.

*All Junior competitors must wear a FULL FACE HELMET when competing in ANY Rough Stock event.

*If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

*Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS must have OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

*Junior membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior events.

If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must upgrade your membership to Open membership:

- both Men's and Ladies' Open membership of \$88
(from \$44 to \$132) plus bond of \$35 (from \$15 to \$50)

The only exception to this is where there is not a Junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this Open event by paying Open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

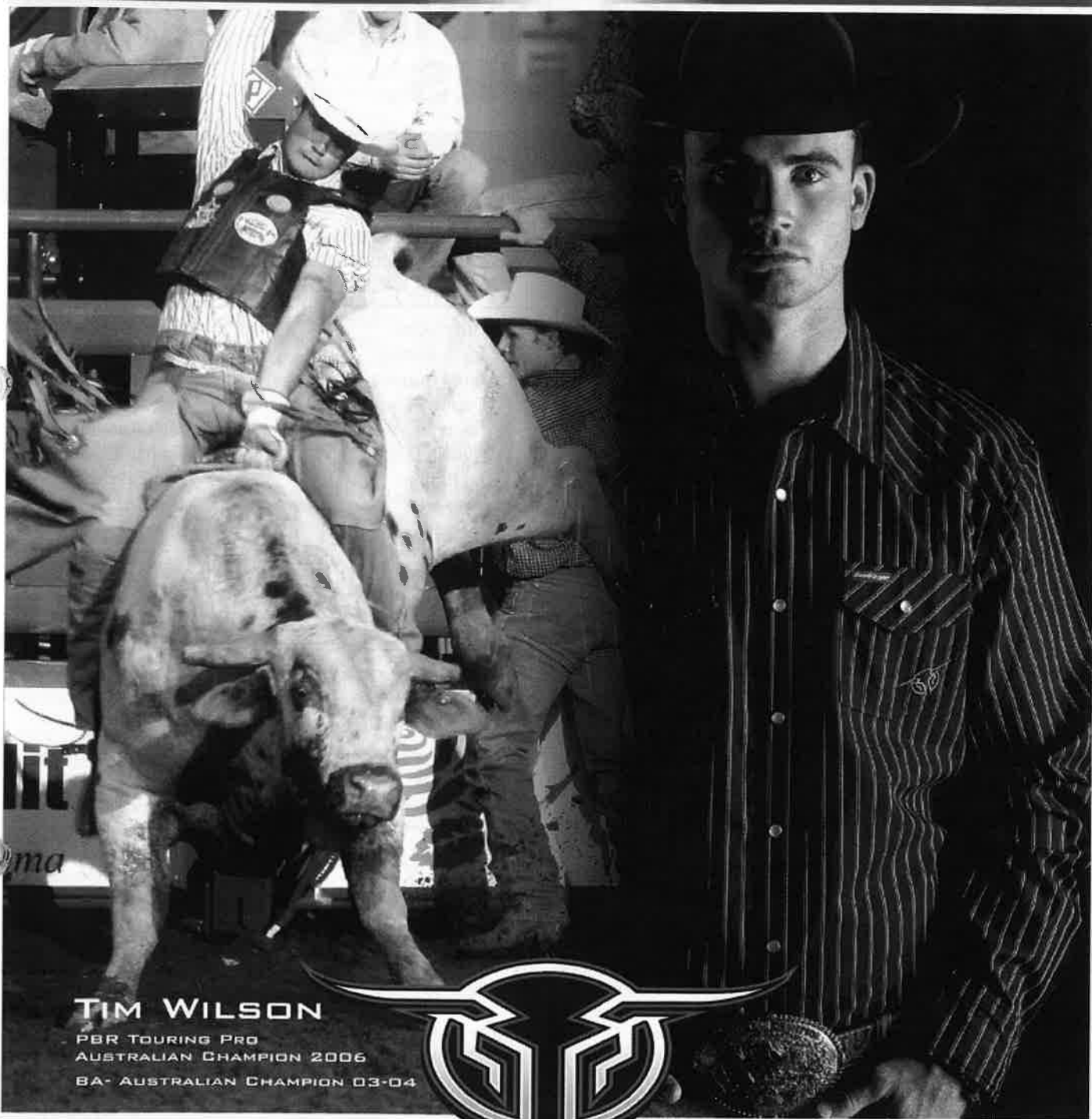

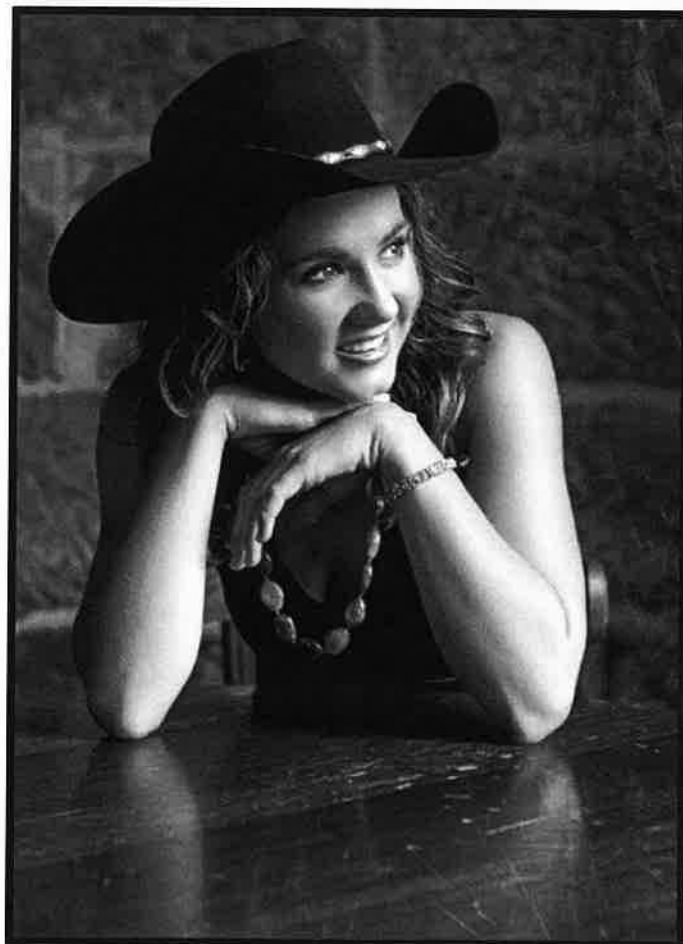
