NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1 2006, campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

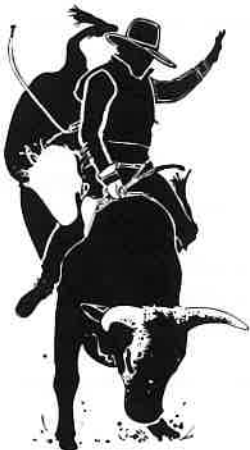

Unfinancial members will be unable to compete at 2007 Rodeos. (All owings must be included with memberships to become financial). **ALL UNFINANCIAL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN DELETED FROM OUR DATA BASE INCLUDING OFFICIALS.** Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st March 2007 will incur a \$11 late fine. **Please note:** This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing is they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

RULE OF THE MONTH

CENTRAL ENTRIES:

CANCELLATIONS:

Any cancellations prior to 12 noon Monday will not incur a fee. Cancellations Monday 12 noon to Thursday preceding the rodeo unless otherwise stated incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 with or without Doctors/Vet's certificate. Cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Doctor's/Vet's certificate is supplied, then only a committee levy and administration fee will be paid.

MEDICAL OUT:

If a competitor is injured at a rodeo and is nominated in another event, a medical certificate must be obtained from the first aid attendant on the ground and presented to the central entry officer on the day before the event concludes. Failure to comply with the above the competitor pays full nomination fee plus turn out fee.

INSURANCE FORM:

In the case of a competitor being injured during the course of the rodeo he/she must obtain an injury occurrence form from the Central Entries office on the day and submit a copy to the NRA Head Office 12 noon Monday.

NOTES FROM THE OFFICE:

This year the Caboolture Show Rodeo will be held on FRIDAY 8th June and SATURDAY 9th June. The Junior Rodeo will be on Saturday 9th June.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred.

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

TEAM ROPERS

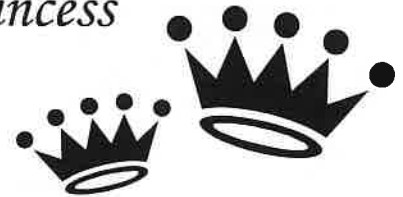

If you are unable to participate it is your responsibility to provide a replacement and to advise the Central Entries personal as soon as possible so the Rodeo Queen and Announcer can be advised.

PLEASE NOTE

*It is compulsory for ALL competitors who compete in Junior events to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET whilst mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.

*All Junior competitors must wear a FULL FACE HELMET when competing in ANY Rough Stock event.

*If you fail to comply with this direction, officials have the right to withdraw you from an event.

*Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS must have OPEN MEMBERSHIP.

*Junior membership entitles you to compete ONLY in Junior events.

If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must upgrade your membership to Open membership:

- both Men's and Ladies' Open membership of \$88
(from \$44 to \$132) plus bond of \$35 (from \$15 to \$50)

The only exception to this is where there is not a Junior event (the same as the event in which you wish to compete) on the day. In this case you may compete in this Open event by paying Open day membership. With this option, for any placings in this event on the day, prize money is paid to you but no points are awarded to you for this event.

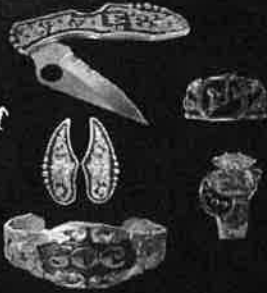
