EQUINE INFLUENZA

If we are to succeed in the fight against Equine Influenza and get rodeo back into the arena now is a very critical time. It is crucial that we continue to abide by movement controls and take appropriate measures to stop the disease spreading to new communities and possibly the rest of Queensland.

IMPORTANT:

From 28th September, 2007 it has been a legal requirement under the Stock Regulation (2005), for all owners of properties on which one or more horses (and other animals of the Equidae family) are held, to register their property.

If your horse is on agistment, please ask the owner of the land for their LotOnPlan details (written on their rates notice). This will help DPI&F cross reference horse ownership with land ownership.

Please register your horse on www.dpr.qld.gov.au/horse-registration or contact the DPI on 13 25 23.

DO NOT MOVE HORSES

It is still illegal to move horses out of the red zone and anyone who wants to move a horse within the zone must apply for a permit from the DPI&F.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

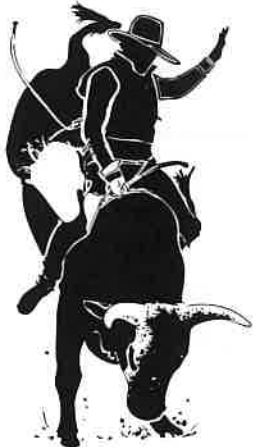

(All owing must be included with memberships to become financial). **ALL UNFINANCIAL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN DELETED FROM OUR DATABASE INCLUDING OFFICIALS.** Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st March 2007 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



RULE OF THE MONTH

SECTION 9 (a)

In the case of a final, with prize money of \$1000 per event, the money shall be split evenly over the 1st, The final and the average with points given on the average only.

In the case of no scores in the final, the prize money for the final shall be paid out on the average.

To be eligible in the average, a competitor must compete on all possible head of stock.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow office staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office when the payment is made by fax, email or phone. If the payment is not received by the office on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. **Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred.**

IMPORTANT RULES

- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must UPGRADE your membership to Open membership:- both Men's and Ladies' Open membership of \$88 (from \$44 to \$132) plus bond of \$35 (from \$15 to \$50)*
- **Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

TOM DURBIDGE BENEFIT BULL RIDE

Maidenwell Hotel – 5th October 2007

The Tom Durbidge Benefit Bull Ride was held at the Maidenwell Hotel on Friday night 5th October and a resounding success it was. A crowd of about 400 turned up at Maidenwell which was exceptional considering it was only advertised 9 days prior to the event and Maidenwell only has a population of about 25 people.

The bull ride was run by the newly formed CMC Rodeos consisting of the partnership of long time stock contractor Hank McArthur and successful rodeo competitor Brad Cavanagh. The event was held to raise funds for all round competitor and good guy Tom Durbidge. For those that don't know, Tom was back doored by a bareback horse and kicked flush in the middle of the face at the recent Mt Isa Rodeo. Tom was knocked out immediately from the impact and had to be flown to Townsville Hospital for further treatment. He has all but had a full face reconstruction and currently has about 30 plates still inserted in his head. Mt Isa hasn't been the best hunting ground for Tom in the past couple of years as last year there he broke his hip in the bull ride.

"I think I'll ride again", Tom said "but I think I'll give Mt Isa a miss from now on."

A open and novice bull ride as well as a poddy ride was held at Maidenwell. There weren't a lot of riders on hand so all competitors got on 2 head in each event. Full credit must be given to all riders for doing this in order to give the vocal crowd an entertaining 2 and a ½ hours of non stop action.

The open bull ride was won by many times New Zealand All Round Champion Daryl Church. Daryl was only in Australia for a few weeks and decided to drop in for this special cause. He rode CMC Rodeos "Murphys Blue Boy" in the 1st round and "Hernia" in the 2nd round to take out the title. Local cowboy Tim McArthur from just down the road at Cooyar was the only other competitor to ride 2 head to take out second place. Ben Ruhle was third after riding his 1st round bull. There were no other qualified rides recorded.

The novice bull ride was taken out by up and coming cowboy Jos Wilson who resides in the Sunshine Coast Hinterland. He was the only cowboy to successfully get two qualified scores in the novice section. Second went to Beaudesert cowboy Jared Borghero while Kingaroy Gene Clarke and another Beaudesert cowboy in Shane Egan took out 3rd and 4th respectively.

There was only 1 score recorded in the poddy ride over the 2 head and this was by star of the future in Caboolture cowboy Lane Heaton. Lane scored the highest score of the night with a massive 80 points. Lane donated half of his prizemoney to Tom who was there on the night to witness the event that was run for him by a few of his mates. Tom told Lane to put his money in his pocket but Lane insisted that Tom take the money. Good on you Lane, you're a little champion. Ben Ruhle and Tim McArthur also donated their prizemoney to Tom to help him to the road to recovery.

Brian Rance, a renown bullfighter from Rosewood, sent a bullfighting shirt that he wore at the bullfighting world championships in America to Maidenwell to be auctioned off with the proceeds going to Tom. The shirt was auctioned off to the crowd and made an incredible \$330. Brian, your contribution is much appreciated. A calcutta was held on the last round of the open bull ride and this raised a further \$310 for the cause.

Announcer Midge Thompson introduced Tom to the crowd just prior to the calcutta and he got a huge reception. Tom who has plenty to say at the best of times was reluctant to speak on the microphone but had a few words to say to the crowd in particular thanking Hank & Brad for putting the event on as well as the thanking the riders, officials and the crowd for turning out to this event.

All officials donated their time for the night to help out a good friend of theirs. Midge Thompson was announcer, Terry O'Neill and Scott Augustin were judges, Jared Borghero and Daniel Horne were bullfighters while Trent Jackson was the timekeeper. Jordan O'Neill, Fraser Babbington and Josh Retchslag pulled gates or helped out where necessary. The stock and arena were donated by CMC Rodeos. The contribution from these people is much appreciated.

The only disappointing part of the evening was that a few of Tom's close riding mates decided that they couldn't make it to the event. However after the event Tom and a few of his mates went to the bar, had a few beers, told a few old rodeo stories and before they knew it, it was daylight and time to have a camp before heading off home.

The event hopefully has raised \$1000 to \$1500 for Tom. We hope this money helps Tom on the road to recovery and we hope to see Tom on the rodeo trail as soon as possible.

EQUINE INFLUENZA *Continued...*

Stop the spread - Prevent, Decontaminate, Inform.

Prevention: Prevent all non-essential vehicles and visits to premises that hold horses.

Decontaminate: Clean and disinfect vehicles, yourself and your clothing before visiting or leaving properties holding horses.

Inform: Report all suspected cases of Equine Influenza to a vet or phone 132523.

How is Equine Influenza spread?

The virus is usually spread by:

- ◆ Direct contact between infected and susceptible horses.
- ◆ Indirect contact with contaminated tack or equipment
- ◆ Susceptible horses occupying buildings or vehicles recently occupied by diseased horses.
- ◆ Close contact between contaminated horses and people. The virus gets onto people's clothes, hair and shoes and can be passed onto horses.
- ◆ Movement of animal material.

Once an animal has recovered and a sufficient time (30) days has elapsed they pose no risk to other horses.

Watch your horse for sign of the disease

Watch all horses on the property for any signs of respiratory disease. The signs of equine influenza are a rise in body temperature, increased respiratory rate, coughing, sneezing and nasal discharge. They may also be depressed, off their feed and have stiff and stiff muscles.

Isolate any horse with signs of respiratory infection. Always attend to healthy horses before sick horses. Call your vet if your horses have a respiratory infection. (The vet will contact DPI&F) if they suspect equine influenza.

NOTE: Most horses recover from equine influenza with veterinary treatment. Horses will not be destroyed if they have the disease. They will be quarantined to prevent spread to other horses.



PLEASE NOTE **"Horse Flu"**

Due to the Equine Influenza and the small number of rodeos conducted before the lock down, after much thought we have decided to carry over the points for all horse events into next year.

The open bull and junior bull buckles will still be calculated to and presented at Greenbank rodeo.

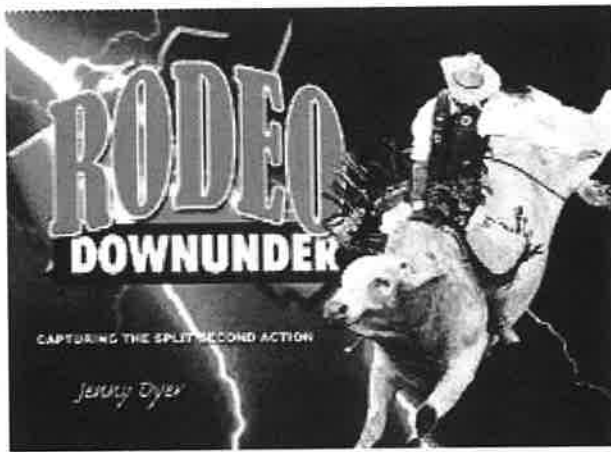
