When you nominate just tell us that you wish to do your payment electronically and we will give you a reference for the direct deposit, or take your credit card details.

If you choose to do a direct deposit to our account, you must contact the office by either a phone call, fax or e-mail and let us know you have completed the transaction and what reference was used.

When using your credit card there will be a small fee of 2% of the amount added to the total transaction to cover the administration costs.

We are pleased to announce that the office is now able to offer you the choice of paying your nominations, owings and membership by Direct Deposit to our Bank Account or by Credit Card.

This will make it easier for you on the day of the Rodeo – you won't have to find the Central Entries person to pay your nominations – it will all be done beforehand.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.




(All owing must be included with memberships to become financial). **ALL UNFINANCIAL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN DELETED FROM OUR DATA BASE INCLUDING OFFICIALS.** Please take advantage of the automatic entry form available from the office or Central Entries. Memberships received after the 1st March 2007 will incur a \$11 late fine. Please note: This includes all stock contractors and arena officials. (Contractors and Arena Officials will be deleted from the official listing if they are unfinancial).

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

RULE OF THE MONTH

CENTRAL ENTRIES - CANCELLATIONS

Any cancellations before 12 noon Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 administration fee which will

accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 6pm Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a committee levy plus \$5.50 administration fine (with or without a Vet's/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's/Doctor's certificate, then only the committee Levy and \$5.50 administration will be paid. After 12 noon Friday no cancellations will be accepted by NRA office.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. **Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred.**

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one

week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.





IMPORTANT RULES

- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must UPGRADE your membership to Open membership:- both Men's and Ladies' Open membership of \$88 (from \$44 to \$132) plus bond of \$35 (from \$15 to \$50)*
- **Note***: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.


MUDGEERABA KALEN RAMSAY CHARITY RODEO

The Annual Mudgeeraba Community Rodeo is scheduled for Saturday the 6th of October 2007 starting 3pm. The Rodeo has benefited many of the regions community groups that share in the proceeds of the night to enable them to continue their good work throughout the community.

This year the committee has decided to give a smaller percentage of funds raised to each of the community groups, and with the approval of all groups involved is giving the majority of funds raised to benefit a child. In association with "Variety Queensland, we have found a young boy, Kalen Ramsey, who has a life threatening heart condition and will require ongoing hospitalisation, surgery and aftercare during his lifetime. 




HAVE YOU USED SMOKELESS TOBACCO?

In Australia, the sale of oral snuff and chewing tobacco was banned nationally in 1991 due to concern about the possible health effects of these products (particularly the risk of mouth cancer). Smokeless tobacco users are allowed to import the product in small quantities for personal use. In the United States, smokeless tobacco use is commonly associated with rodeos through sponsorship by smokeless tobacco companies. Before the Australian federal ban, smokeless tobacco promotions were also held at Australian rodeos.

It has been argued that allowing some forms of smokeless tobacco to be sold in Australia may be good for public health if smokers switched from cigarettes to smokeless tobacco. Other people argue that most Australian smokers would not want to use smokeless tobacco. However, very little is known about who would be interested in buying these products if the current ban was relaxed.

Researchers at the School of Population Health at the University of Queensland are currently looking for people who have used smokeless tobacco to participate in a short survey to better understand who may be interested in using these products if they were allowed to be sold here. The survey can be completed over the phone or by an anonymous written questionnaire.
