



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

E.I. Update

Our latest news on the Equine Influenza situation is that the zones are changing constantly, which is very encouraging and a step in the right direction to getting events back on track. By June the state is expected to be declared white - that is the DPI are satisfied that the state is E.I. free. After this, free movement of competition horse will be allowed.

Time Event Competitors - PLEASE register your property. Properties which have cattle will already have a PIC (Property Identification Code). Properties which only have horses may not. This is very important, as it will be required as the property of origin for forms for any horse movements that take place.

Before the state is declared white some movement will be allowed to events which have qualified with DPI regulations. These regulations will include Bio Security, Way Bill, Health Declaration Form.

Event organizers can apply by completing forms available on the DPI web site or by contacting NRA for the relevant paper work.

As events are approved to commence so will the NRA points system commence. That is Bull Riding event points have been counted as of the Ipswich finals. Should all Saddle Ride and Bareback events commence in February for example - their event points will be calculated from the first permitted event. Saddle and Bareback riders please note - bio security will be utmost - disinfecting footwear, gear, equipment and vehicles may be required. Please co-operate with committees on these matters.

Please Note: Memberships will be due for competitors as soon as their events are permitted and will be calculated percentage wise (as for the number of months of the year available for competition of the particular event).

Should events be permitted but restricted these rodeos will be classified as non points for that particular event. In this case please support your committees as they are willing to get events up and running as soon as possible.

Included in this newsletter (also available on the web site) is a register of horse information for timed event competitors. This will be formatted into a data base of all NRA members. This will assist committees, if we can supply this information to them. It will also mean that entries will not have to be taken ONE MONTH prior to the event as is envisaged at the present time.

Once events have been approved please co-operate with committees with any regulations they may insist on to keep our sport E.I. free.



Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow office staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office when the payment is made by fax, email or phone. If the payment is not received by the office on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

JUNIORS IN RODEO



IMPORTANT RULES

- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event. All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the NRA office otherwise nominations will not be accepted.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a **FULL FACE HELMET** and **APPROVED VEST**.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Bother Men's and Ladies Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00)
- All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the office otherwise nominations will not be accepted.
- **Note***: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

OPEN BULL RIDE BOUNTY BULL



Dear Members,

At this year's 2008 Stanthorpe Rodeo, the Stanthorpe Rodeo Committee has secured additional sponsorship for the open bull ride, kindly donated by the Country Club Hotel Motel, Stanthorpe.

This sponsorship is in the form of a bounty. One lucky open bull ride competitor will be eligible to win this bounty. The rules pertaining to this contest are:

- Competitors must nominate through NRA Central Entries System
- The Competitors that draws the bull in the last round of the Open Bull ride competition shall have the opportunity to win the bounty.
- The competitor that draws the bounty bull will win the bounty bull, **NO PREFERENCES will be given for the Open Bull Ride**
- If the competitor fails to make a qualified ride the bounty will jackpot at the 2009 Stanthorpe Rodeo.


