### E.I. UPDATE


Firstly I would like to thank members and committees or their understanding, co-operation and patience as we have worked through the E.I. crisis.

The latest information available is that the red zone has changed to amber and the amber zone to white.

### WHAT THIS MEANS:

If you wish to float a horse WITHIN in the (new) AMBER zone, you will only need a WAYBILL (No Permit!) (You can download and fill out a waybill for each float move, from the DPI website OR buy a waybill book from your local DPI office) www.dpi.qld.gov.au

If you wish to float a horse across another zone colour, or Interstate, you WILL need a PERMIT. (For instance, moving Old Red to Old Amber - now New Amber to White, WILL need a permit).

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

# E.I. Update DPI web site: www.dpi.qld.gov.au

If you wish to compete at an event or go to a training day, you will apply for a PERMIT through the event organiser. (You will need your waybill to get to event, and write on it the Event Permit number that the organising committee gives you BEFORE you leave. Contact your event organiser for details).

If you are unsure which zone you are in, please check the DPI website for the zone maps. (For further clarification, call the call centre on 132523, and have your Lot on Plan numbers on hand to speed up your query). PLEASE NOTE: Movement within zones will involve quarantine under certain circumstances - please ensure all requirements on your permits are strictly adhered to.

We are now another step closer to our aim: To have all of Queensland WHITE! (EI Eradicated)

PLEASE NOTE: All HORSE movements require a waybill (Equine Influenza specified)\*\*. If travelling to an event one (1) copy of your way bill will be required by the committee and one kept for yourself.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A DUPLICATE COPY OF YOUR WAYBILL AND THAT YOUR WAYBILL HAS BEEN COMPLETED CORRECTLY IF NOT YOU WILL BE TURNED AROUND AT THE GATE. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO HAND YOUR WAYBILL TO THE GATE KEEPERS - OR IF THE COMMITTEE REQUIRE IT, TO CENTRAL ENTRIES WHEN YOUR ENTRIES ARE PAID - THIS MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE RODEO.

A health declaration form \*\* will also have to be completed for those attending events.

(Your way bill will have to correspond to the information on the horses you have given when entering the event with central entries - any deviations will also mean that you will not be able to compete at that event).

If you require a travel permit to attend an event, please apply for it early. The DPI are doing their best to keep up with permits with more and more movement happening and more events taking place. Please try to apply at least three weeks before the event.

Saddle and Bareback riders please note - bio security will be utmost - disinfecting footwear, gear, equipment and vehicles may be required. Please co-operate with committees on these matters. PLEASE: Co-operate with committees with all requests regarding E.I. requirements and bio-security regulations. We have done well so far so do not undo all this good work.

### \*\*THESE FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ON THE DPI WEB SITE OR THROUGH THIS OFFICE.\*\*

### COMMITTEES:

All events must be registered and sanctioned by the DPI before your event can take place. Events in the amber zone MUST apply for a permit from the DPI. Events in the white zone must register their event with the DPI. These need to be submitted at least one month prior to the event. (Please note NRA will be able to assist you with your horse details form). To our current information this will be done till the end of the year.

PLEASE NOTE: The property on which an event is held MUST BE REGISTERED. Registration applications are available through the DPI. A Property Identification Code will be issued and must be used on event applications as well as the Real Property description of the grounds. Your PIC must be on your affiliation form before your event can be approved by the Board. Protocols for holding events and Bio-security procedures must be adhered to.

# Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



### NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

# ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow office staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office when the payment is made by fax, email or phone. If the payment is not received by the office on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

### **COMPETITOR INJURIES**

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

### NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

### COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

The National Rodeo association would like to take this opportunity to advise our committees that the NRA has secured a very competitive Public Liability Insurance Policy, which offers a cover of \$10 MILLION.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your 2007 rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.



# JUNIORS IN RODEO





### **IMPORTANT RULES**

- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo event.
   All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the NRA office otherwise nominations will not be accepted.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.\*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Bother Men's and Ladies Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00)
- All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the office otherwise nominations will not be accepted.
- <u>Note\*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
