NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees cust ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and as a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.



ROPE & TIE - "DISQUALIFICATIONS"

On behalf of all Rope and Tie competitors and as director of the event, I would like to respond to the Animal Welfare "Busts" article published to Judges in the July newsletter.

In regards to Judges decisions, we as competitors understand and agree that when a "bust" occurs, the rule book states competitors should be disqualified and fined. The welfare of the animal needs to be a priority at all times. Without taking this into consideration we would not continue to have Rope and Tie.

We are a professional association which has rules to eliminate the doubt factor and peoples personal opinions of crowd reaction. Each individual's run should be based on these rules. Judges have rules to abide by, not only to protect the well being of animals and our sport but also to be fair to each competitor.

We understand that crowd reaction can be detrimental to our sport especially when it comes to the wellbeing of the animal. However, we ask that the event be judged fairly as per the rule book, not as a result of the judges interpretation of crowd reaction.

CHANGES TO EVENT MANAGEMENT AND MOVEMENT REQUIREMENTS FROM 30 JUNE 2008.

The Requirements on Event Organisers are:

- To register their event with the Department of Primary Industries and Fisheries (DPI&F) by completing an Event Notification Form online via www.dpi.qld.gov.au or by calling the DPI&F Business Information Centre on 13 25 23.
- Must retain a record of the information provided to them by competitors attending the event for a period of six months from the date of the event.
- Encourage basic Biosecurity. All this information is available on-line at www.dpi.qld.gov.au: and
- 4. If any horse has a nasal discharge, is coughing and has a temperature over 38.5 degrees Celsius it must be reported to DPI&F where a veterinarian will make an assessment for exclusion testing (ruling out equine influenza). We are very confident that no horses will have equine influenza. However, there are some diseases that have some clinical signs similar to equine influenza.

The Requirements on Competitors are: 1. Travel Documents

All horses in Queensland can now move freely throughout the State without the need for a Waybill. However, when moving horses across the Queensland Cattle Tick Line, you will require a MoveEasy Waybill in addition to a Travel Permit issued by an Inspector. The permit requirements will vary depending on the place of origin, the intended destination, and the time spent away from the place of origin. These permit conditions must be adhered to or your Travel Permit may be cancelled. An inspection and treatment for Cattle Ticks may also be required. If required, multiple movement permits are available.

Information on moving across the Tick Line can be obtained from your local DPI&F Biosecurity Inspector. Call 13.25.23 for the location of your nearest DPI&F Office.

For Horses travelling Interstate, you are required to contact the Department of Primary Industries Office in the Sate or Territory to which or through which you plan to travel.

- Documentation Required For Event Organisers
 Persons in charge of a Horse/s attending an Event must
 provide the following information to Event Organisers
- i. The number of horses they are in charge of at the Event
- ii. The Property Identification Code (PIC) for the property from which the horse/s had travelled to attend the event
- iii. The name and address of the 'Person In Charge' of the horse or horses at the event. (Ref: Qld Govt DPI&F).

Please ensure that your PIC number is on your affiliation form.

NOVICE STATUS:

To be entitled to novice money, <u>novice competitors must</u> <u>inform the Central Entries</u> of their status when nominating for their event and only when there is no novice event in the same category on the day. (As advertised in the Central Entry Information section in the magazine).

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.


Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow offi ce staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office by fax, email or phone when the payment is made. If the payment is not received by the offi ce on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo. Should you wish to make a claim please also contact the NRA Head office for the appropriate claim forms.

ALL JUNIORS & PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Proof of age documents need to be forwarded to the NRA office immediately or nominations may be refused. Don't jeopardize your standings by not abiding by NRA rules.



IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the NRA offi ce otherwise nomination will not be accepted.
- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo events.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- <u>Note*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
