NRA NEW RULING

That all Parents/Guardian accompanying any junior competitors into a competitor's only area (ie. Behind the chute box area and time event areas) must abide by the NRA ruling in dress code for members.

Parents/Guardian must be in full western attire, onsisting of a hat, boots, jeans or western pants and a long sleeve western shirt with sleeves buttoned down and a collar. All attire must be worn in a neat and tidy manner.

Failure to abide by this ruling in the restricted competitors only area will result in the Parent/Guardian being removed by the security and the junior competitor's entry will be withdrawn. This motion was carried unanimously.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or na does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.



The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.



Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

All competing members must be financial before the start of their event, including arena officials.

NOTICE TO JUDGES

NRA JUDGES:

Judges cannot judge the event in which they compete on the day. In the case where a judge is competing, it is his/her responsibility to supply a suitable replacement for the said event on the day. Announcers and/or other officials adjudicating on the day are not considered suitable replacements. i.e. Judge and Announce, Judge and Pick-up and Judge and Clown at the same time.

If a replacement cannot be found, the judge must honour his/her commitment and judge the event and forfeit nominations.

NOMINATIONS WILL NOT BE TAKEN IF YOU HAVE ANY OUTSTANDING OWINGS. PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL OUTSTANDING OWINGS ARE PAID UP PRIOR TO ANY UP-COMING RODEOS NOMINATION.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

RULE OF THE MONTH

DRESS CODE

(a) All rodeo personnel competing and officiating at a rodeo must be in full western dress <u>one (1) hour</u> prior to the rodeo commencing or when they enter the rodeo grounds, and <u>one (1) hour</u> after the rodeo.

Western attire consists of a hat, boots, jeans or western pants and a long sleeve western shirt with sleeves buttoned down and a collar. All attire must be worn in a neat and tidy manner. The rule applies to competitors, chute boss, announcers, pick-up teams, judges, time keepers, central entries personnel, stock contractors and their assistants. Clowns may wear runners. Sleeves may be rolled up on riding hand in Rough Stock events.

- (b) Should an appointed Director or Official deem a competitor to be <u>wearing unsuitable attire</u>, the competit may be called from the arena:
- (i) Instructed to change attire
- (ii) Fined
- (iii) Disqualified for non compliance in either (i) or (ii).



There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo. Should you wish to make a claim please also contact the NRA Head office for the appropriate claim forms.

Now that all horse movement has been made easier please do not take it for granted - please help yourself and our committees by having the correct paperwork completed prior to the rodeo.

All NRA approved rodeos must have:two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow office staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office by fax, email or phone when the payment is made. If the payment is not received by the office on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

1) TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:

Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN
 APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.

2) ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:

• Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride. Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

Approved properly fitted protective VEST.

If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock WILL be turned out.



IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the NRA offi ce otherwise nomination will not be accepted.
- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo events.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- <u>Note*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
