NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

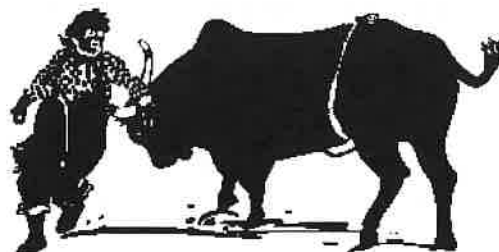

OUTSTANDING FEES:

A reciprocal agreement has been made with APRA, ABCRA, CRCA and BA in relation to collecting outstanding fees and fines.

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

All competing members must be financial before the start of their event, including arena officials.

ATTENTION : ALL JUDGES

Time Event and Rough Stock Judges,

It is compulsory to fill the New Judges Report form at every rodeo.

Flag to be carried by a flag judge must large a clearly visible (brightly coloured) for all to see. Failure to carry a flag will result in an immediate fine on the day.

Flag judge can only confer with the barrier judge on the day and no other.

NRA rule book section:

Page 71

(a)1

A judge who does not carry a flag will be penalized. Failure of the judge to carry a flag shall eliminate the judge from disqualifying any competitor for failure to mark a horse out for that event.

Page 72

(c)

Changing of scores in rough Stock Events is not permitted. Judges to confer regarding penalties and rerides only, not after each competitor.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

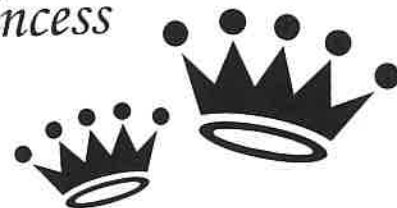

IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
- **Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.**
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
- **Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.** Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- **Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.**
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

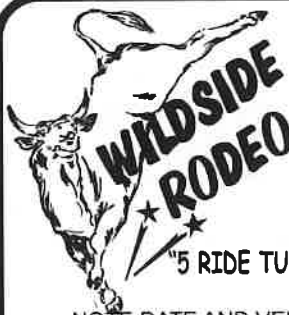
