NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees "Frust ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and ears a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.



Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association. Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 1st March, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited.

All competing members must be financial before the start of their event, including arena officials.




"SHEA RELEASES 2ND ALBUM & TAKES AMERICA BY STORM"

The last three years have been very busy years for Country/Pop music sensation, Shea Fisher. Not only did she sign her first music contract with ABC Music, her first and second singles 'Just the Excuse' and 'Everyday Girl' went #1 on the CMC Channel and she toured with the likes of Steve Forde, Adam Brand and Lee Kernagan. NOTICE ON CANCELLATIONS

When cancelling, either by phone or answering machine, you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, membership number, reference number and event. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted. Cancellations before 12 noon on Monday preceding the rodeo will incur a \$5.50 Administration fee, which will accumulate and invoices will be issued after four (4) of such cancellations. Cancellations after 12 noon Monday and before 12 noon Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur a Committee Levy plus Administration fine (with or without a Vet's/Doctor's Certificate). Any cancellations after 12 noon Thursday preceding the rodeo will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet's/Doctor's Certificate is received, then only the Committee Levy and Administration fine will apply. After 12 noon Friday the NRA Office will accept no cancellations. The hotline may be used on the day of the rodeo. Any un-notified cancellations will incur full nominations plus a turn-out fine. Cancellations must be done through the NRA Office or an NRA Director to be accepted.

CENTRAL ENTRIES EMAILS:

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have: two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.





JUNIORS IN RODEO



IMPORTANT RULES

 All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events.

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
- Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
- Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE
 PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP
 FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute
 Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- <u>Note*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
