NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

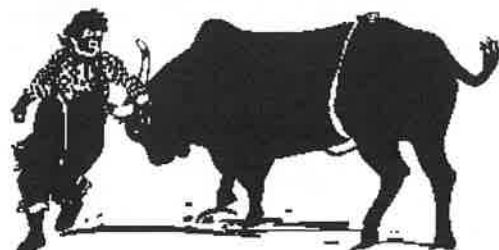

The above mentioned Associations have submitted a list of competitors with outstanding fees and fines to all concerned each month.

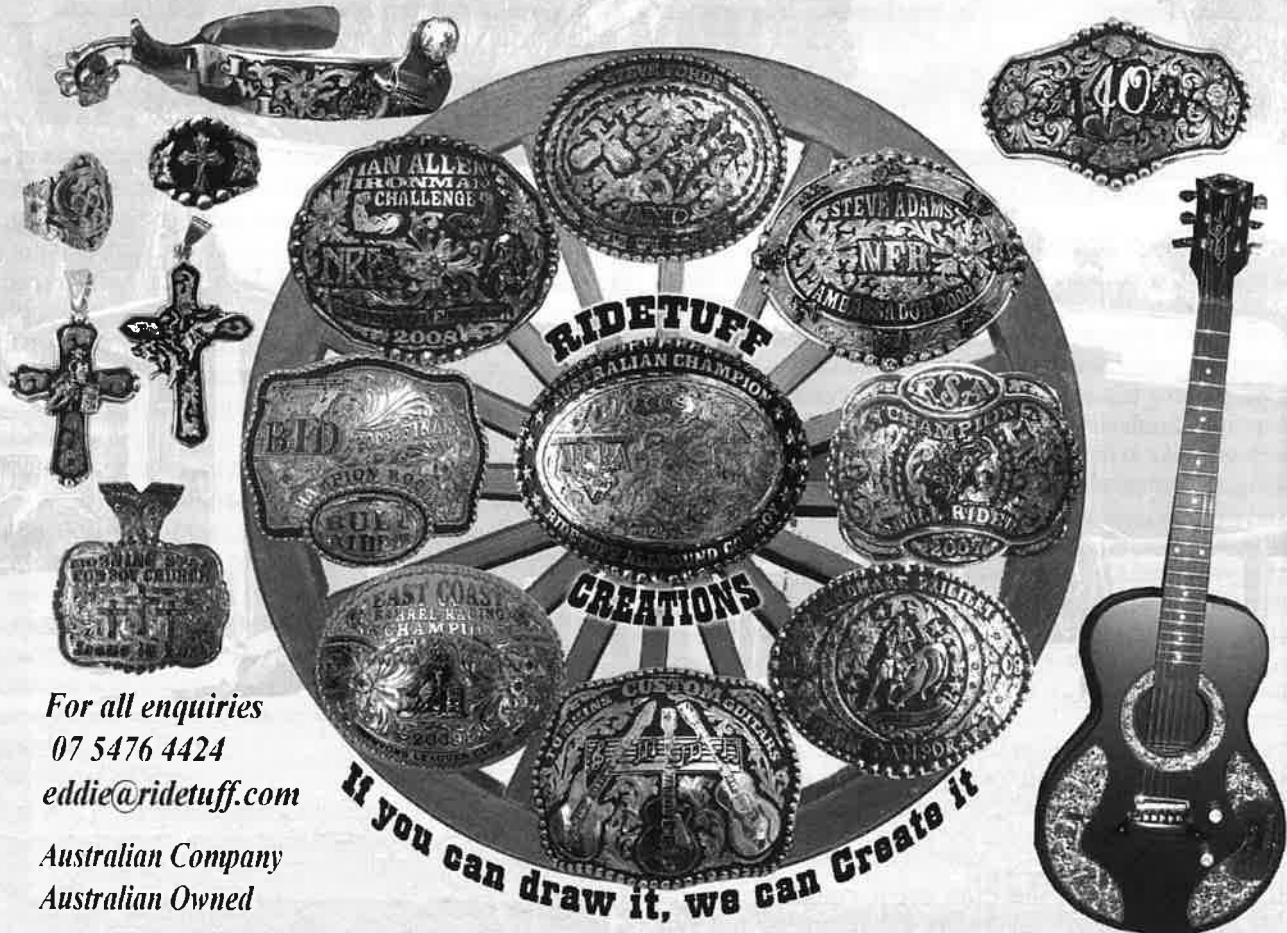
Should a competitor have outstanding fees or fines with any of the participating associations they will be ineligible to compete in any event until these fees and or fines have been settled with the relevant Association.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

RULE OF THE MONTH

DRESS CODE

(a) All rodeo personnel competing and officiating at a rodeo must be in full western dress one (1) hour prior to the rodeo commencing or when they enter the rodeo grounds, and one (1) hour after the rodeo.

Western attire consists of a hat, boots, jeans or western pants and a long sleeve western shirt with sleeves buttoned down and a collar. All attire must be worn in a neat and tidy manner. The rule applies to competitors, chute boss, announcers, pick-up teams, judges, time keepers, central entries personnel, stock contractors and their assistants. Clowns may wear runners. Sleeves may be rolled up on riding hand in Rough Stock events.

(b) Should an appointed Director or Official deem a competitor to be wearing unsuitable attire, the competitor may be called from the arena:

- (i) Instructed to change attire
- (ii) Fined
- (iii) Disqualified for non compliance in either (i) or (ii).

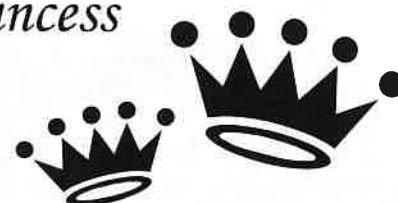

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

E.I. REPORT COMMITTEES:

Please advise the DPI of your event – this can be done by email on line on the DPI Web Site or by contacting the DPI Business Information Centre on 13 25 23.

Please ensure that your PIC number is on your affiliation form.

COMPETITOR INJURIES

There are an increasing number of injuries which are not being reported to the office. Please make sure that an injury occurrence form is completed for any injury incurred at a rodeo. This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo. Should you wish to make a claim please also contact the NRA Head office for the appropriate claim forms.

Now that all horse movement has been made easier please do not take it for granted - please help yourself and our committees by having the correct paperwork completed prior to the rodeo.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractor, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS AND CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Please note that all payments must be received by Wednesday before the rodeo that you are competing in. Therefore please ensure that all transfers are processed by Monday 9.00pm to allow office staff to check payment has been received. Please ensure that you print receipts for any electronic payments that you make and you advise the office by fax, email or phone when the payment is made. If the payment is not received by the office on Friday and you have no proof (receipt), you will have to pay on the day of the rodeo. If the payment is then credited to our account we will make a refund to you if you have paid twice.

As Caboolture Rodeo has a new format the points gained at the Junior Rodeo will be credited to the end of year points standings.

The Rough Stock will be credited as per age groups.

The Timed Events will be calculated on the fastest times overall of all age groups combined. That is in the Barrel Race for example the times for the U7, U11, 12-15 and 16-18 will all be combined and the top four times will be credited with points towards the end of year Junior Barrel Race Standings.

IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age lodged at the NRA office otherwise nomination will not be accepted.
- It is compulsory for ALL Juniors to wear a PROTECTIVE HELMET when mounted or competing in ANY Rodeo events.
- ALL Juniors competing in ANY Rough Stock event must wear a FULL FACE HELMET and APPROVED VEST.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.*
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **Note***: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
