

### NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

### **COMMITTEES:**

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.



### **CENTRAL ENTRIES EMAILS:**

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

### **NRA OFFICIALS:**

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have:two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

### UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

### **IMPORTANT RULES**

All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS: Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:** Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride. Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events\*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- Note\*: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.



### **Rookie Competition:**

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their fi rst or second year of membership.

Points are accrued from Open Competition Only.

(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).

A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open"

### Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

### ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

### **Novice Competition:**

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Offi ce.

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter.




