INSURANCE

Personal Accident Insurance - IMPORTANT NOTICE from our Insurer:

- 1) **Non Competing Official** – eg. Chute boss, Judges, Time Keepers, Announcers, Back yard workers etc. Unless you are a competitor on the day it is advised that you take up the Personal Accident Coverage of \$11.00 for Non Competing Officials at every rodeo at which you are involved.

This payment must be done to the central entries staff at the rodeo **PRIOR** to the commencement of the rodeo.

Any Non Competing Official **not a current member of NRA** must also pay a Day Membership of \$15.00 together with the \$11.00 to be fully covered at the rodeo.

Should you not wish to take this insurance coverage up on the day, you will not be covered for the personal accident coverage if there has been any unforeseen injuries that you incur at that rodeo.

- 2) **Competitors** – Who **do not pay** their **ENTRY FEES** prior to the start of the rodeo is not covered with any competitor's insurance coverage for the day.

Should you be injured during the rodeo you are deemed **uninsured** for the rodeo and therefore **not eligible** for any personal accident coverage that you otherwise will be entitled to.

We strongly advise that all **non competing officials pay the \$11.00** personal accident coverage, and it **essential** that **all competitors pay their nomination** prior to the start of every rodeo in which you are involved.

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

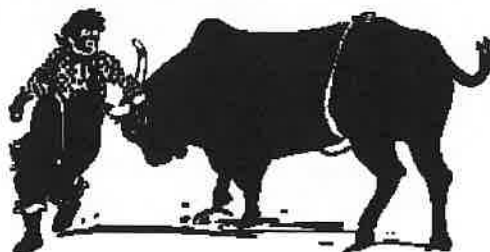

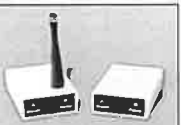

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

**All NRA approved rodeos must have:-
two (2) NRA approved Judges,
and one (1) approved timekeeper.**

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.
