## NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

As from July 1, 2006 campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

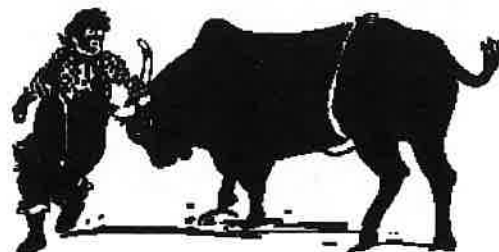

Again in 2009 my official role on the Board of NRA has been Animal Welfare. As you are probably aware we are currently guided by the NSW Welfare of Animals in Rodeo.

I am pleased to report that 2009 was practically incident free – with very few incidents or injuries reported regarding animals or complaint from the public.

In compliance with QLD DPI requirements, NRA has included an incident report sheet in with the administration requirements for rodeos. This sheet must be completed after each rodeo by judges and officials on the day.



## Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



It is interesting to note that when combining information from our reports and that of APRA, the percentage of injuries compared to animals used in rodeos across Australia was approximately 0.08%.

This time last year I reported that the QLD Code of Conduct for Animals in Rodeo was to be completed by the end of 2009. My latest information is that the Legal fraternity are still procrastinating over the wording of the document and are due to meet in February 2010. We will see what eventuates.

Whilst I have the chair I would like to thank Terry O'Neill for taking charge our involvement in the Caboolture Urban Music Fest. Terry and his band of volunteers did a huge job, and the resultant income was very welcome.

Terry also took charge of both Caboolture rodeos – the Show rodeo and the second round of the NRA Finals. I don't think anyone could question what an exceptional job he did. The new arena format allowed for approximately 150 extra people in to the licenced area, which was appreciated by the public and was profitable to NRA as well. Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.  
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events\*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **Note\*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

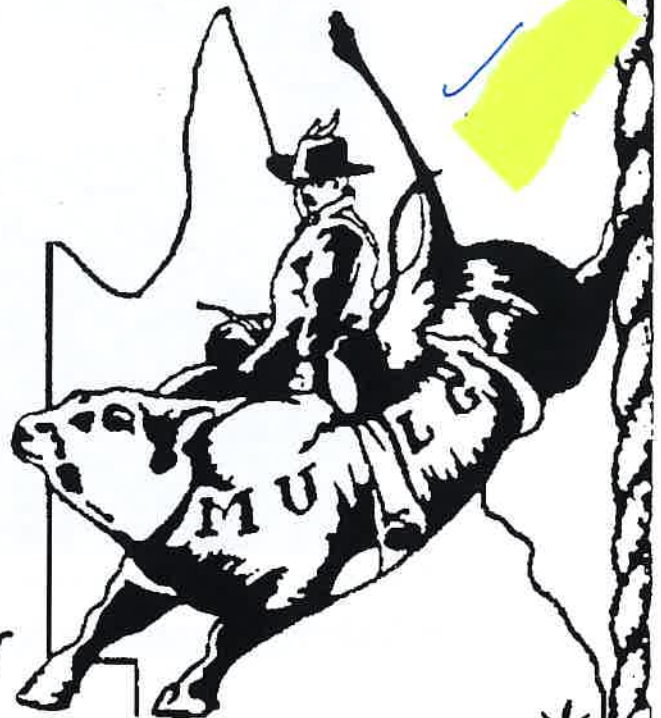

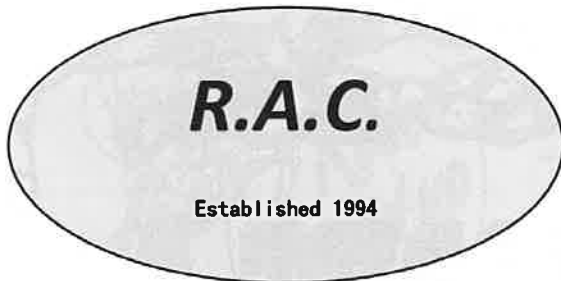

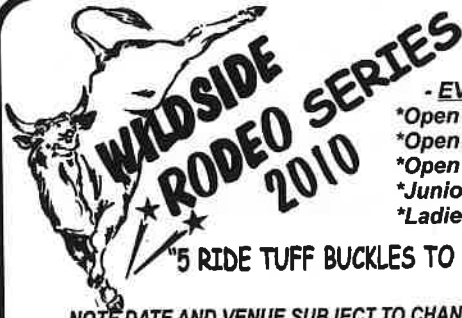

**Novice Competition:**

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.

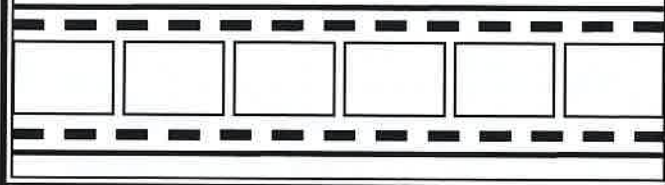
