

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property tentification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:



CENTRAL ENTRIES EMAILS:

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

NRA OFFICIALS:

Judges and officials are to be appointed from the NRA approved officials list published in monthly NRA Sports News.

All NRA approved rodeos must have:two (2) NRA approved Judges, and one (1) approved timekeeper.

All contract stock must be selected from Contractors listings published in NRA Monthly Sport News.

Please contact the N.R.A. Office at least two (2) weeks prior to your Rodeo with names of your Contractors, Judges, Chute boss, Timekeepers, Pick-up Team and Bull Fighting Clowns, Announcer – all of whom must be N.R.A. Members.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY

Any Prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prize money is paid in cash. Cash will not be sent by mail, it will changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.



 All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
 Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED
 HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during
 the ride.
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
 Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE
 PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP
 FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- Note*: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

This year welcomes the fifth year of competition in the Ian Allen Iron Man Challenge.

The Iron Man Challenge was named after a fellow competitor who has shown true spirit and dedication to the sport of Steer Wrestling and as a result, the Ian Allen Iron man Challenge was born.

lan has been a true inspiration having had 40 years of experience under his belt thus far. He has achieved seven runner-up titles before becoming Steer Wrestling champion in 1986 and he continues to perform at every event possible.

lan has qualified for 30 finals rodeos, won some of our biggest rodeos in our country, including Warwick and still competes at the age of 56.

The aim of the challenge is to encourage competitors to be more consistent and travel to as many rodeos as possible. It has been proven that consistency wins this title.

The Challenge rules operate as follows:

- Catch a steer receive that time;
- 2. Miss a steer and receive 40 seconds;
- 3. Not entered at a rodeo and receive 60 seconds.

An aggregate of points is taken over the year of competition and the competitor with the lowest time wins a "Ride Tuff" lan Allen Iron Man Challenge buckle.

The Challenge has been lucky enough to secure a major sponsor for the next five years from Simon at "Beachmere Fibreglass" to ensure this award will be around for some time to come.
