It started with a conversation between Mick Maroske, Graham Browne and Will Kelly, they wanted to help the flood victims but with work and road closures everywhere it was hard to know where to start. One says to the other well how else can we help, we only know about rodeos; so let's hold one. They made some calls and it seems there were a lot of people out there who thought the same. Friends and family all got on board and everyone they spoke to said, how can we help?

The generosity of businesses and individuals local and afar was astounding, even those who had Iffered losses themselves, Goods and services to the value of \$40,000 plus was donated to sell, raffle and make the night a success including gifts to the Grantham guests. The rodeo competitors donated all prize money as well as the administration fees normally paid to the National Rodeo Association. Please be advised that you are required to pay your nomination prior to your ride at a rodeo. The members who fail to pay their nomination on the day of the rodeo will be monitored by our Central Entries Staff.

Repeat offenders will have their privilege of paying nomination on the day <u>revoked</u> and will be <u>required to pay nomination prior to the day of the rodeo.</u> In extreme circumstances nominations may even be refused.

It is vital that all members competing at a rodeo pay their nomination before the start of the rodeo.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT.

2010 commenced with the introduction of a \$5.00 levy to assist in upgrading our finals and upgrading Juniors and Seniors Rodeos. Whilst this new introduction was met with mixed emotions, it proved successful in giving flexibility to the Board and Finals committee to negotiate with old and new committees. The figure presented at the last AGM did not realise the expected financial gain, however it made a substantial contribution to the National Rodeo Association's finances.

Early in 2010 we had to seek assistance from members and other associations to battle a concerted attack on the sport by Animal Activists. Fortunately sanity prevailed and Rodeo survived. But we cannot rest as I am sure we will have to defend our sport in the future. Therefore it is paramount that as a group we must at all times ensure that we do not give these groups any ground for attack.

Comments on Facebook are of concern and the Board sought Legal advice. From this advice, we are prepared to take action against members that use this medium to discredit the Association or persons ie. Board Members, Committees, Contractors, Sponsors, etc. Members using Facebook to express their dissatisfaction with decisions made should seek clarification before posting inaccurate comments that don't serve any purpose except self gratification and make the decision maker's job more difficult.

I must pay tribute to the support I personally received from the Executive Board, Operations Board and Finals Committee members. Our job is no bed of roses, however working as a team it is surprising what the group can accomplish. Whilst we do not all agree at times, I believe the overall decisions in most part have been the correct ones.

In 2010 a number of committee meetings were conducted and I am pleased to advise of some success, number one being Stanthorpe going back to Championship status. Widgee, Maryborough, Woodenbong and Killarney are others we have met with and in 2011 we will continue to promote the NRA through such meetings.

The Finals format was a success and knowing what we now know and help from members this year will improve even more. Most members we trust will strive to make the Top 12 and a Finals berth. We will be conducting Finals meetings early this year and any assistance is welcome, so don't be shy, offer your help.

Our rule book is out of print. What is needed prior to new ones being printed is we must update rule changes. This is a priority in early 2011 as is, once the rule book is upgraded, a Judges Clinic which will be organised. However again I ask for support from all concerned.

I must confess the job I find most difficult is purchasing Trophy Saddles & Buckles, again you can't please everyone; however we looked at quality and a price which we considered affordable. The buckles from Eddie Fisher and the saddles from Tod Slone. Luck was on our side with the Australian Dollar increasing in value after we placed the order thus saving money on the original price. Suzanne Brooks also helped out by bringing the saddles from America in her container of products, again a major save.

Sponsorship is difficult to achieve. We as an Association receive substantial support in this area for which we are grateful and are always striving to gain more and will continue this pursuit. While being mindful of the economy and most companies being hounded for financial support. We must express our sincere gratitude to those that have been a contributor. I have not named any one person or company as I do not wish to offend by leaving someone out. Again I thank you all.

Some people leave the Board as of today and new Directors will be elected. To those departing, we all, as members, thank you for your valued contribution and trust we can count on you for continued support as members. 
On fund raising, Kate O'Neill was in control of the bar at the Caboolture round of the finals. Well done Kate and thank you very much.

BARREL RACING DIRECTORS REPORT.

Firstly I would like to congratulate the 2010 Champions, Finalists and all competitors for a great 2010 season. Entries are still high to our event each and every weekend. 2010 saw the introduction of request for assistance from fellow competitors to assist the Director to set the Barrel course. It has been a requirement at each rode that competitors check their draw prior to the rodeo. If the competitor has drawn out last or 2^{nd} last in the draw they must meet the Director/Deputy Director and/or allocated person by the Director, at the arena one hour prior to the commencement of the rodeo to assist in setting up the course. If a day member draws in these last two positions then the responsibility will turn to the third last competitor and so on. These competitors must also (if committee are not available) assist rolling drums out on commencement of event and assist with timer placements.

Unfortunately this instruction had not been successful having been introduced over six months ago. It continues to be the same competitors setting the course each week, and at times I have been out there on my own which is near impossible when I need someone to hold the other end of the tape measure! This same format is working quite well in our fellow associations with a fine consequence if not adhered to. N.R.A. has introduced with no consequence fine but further negotiation needs to be taken and a fine may now need to be introduced due to very minimal commitment from competitors. You are all encouraged to assist at any time, even if you are not the last two drawn out. It is great to get an insight into how to set a course and what needs to be considered while doing this.

Unfortunately a further frustration, that seems to be apparent more and more is related to ground conditions and size of courses. Some barrel courses timed at just 12 seconds, this is too small. We are fortunate to see a barrel race on the program but would like to encourage committees to consider access to resources to enable a good size arena and are able to prepare the ground to be safe for all competitors and their horses. There is nothing worse than riding into an arena hoping your horse will even just stay on their four legs! Our horses are worth too much to all competitors, the years of preparation to get them to that level does not warrant competing on unsafe ground.

Nevertheless, our own safety is paramount. I encourage all competitors to establish links with your local committees to contribute to these areas.

Please I encourage all competitors to approach me and contribute to better our event.



On Monday 28th February 2011 we had to have Rebel euthanized as his arthritis had gotten the better of him, although his heart felt differently. Rebel was 30 ½ years old and Dean and I have had him for 22 years. Dean had been competing on rebel in the Steer Wrestling for some time when Doc Cavanagh gave him to us; both Brad & Troy used to Barrel Race him in the Junior Barrels back in those days.

Many cowboys used to mount out of him and many more learnt to Steer Wrestle on Rebel. I began to Barrel Race him and every year that we competed we made it to the finals, he continued to Barrel Race and place up until he was 19. I also used him as a Rodeo Queen Horse and Grand Entry horse. At the age of 24 we started to use him as a heeling horse and I would Breakaway Rope on him at home. Rebel taught both of my children to ride and he has only been retired for 18 months. I was still winning Team Penning Competitions on him at the age of 28. Dean even ran him in a Draft at Teebar and got a round out of him. I remember when we first got him we were running scrubbers and my father-inlaw was shouldering a beast around, Dean was horrified and said 'don't tell Doc!' Doc said 'whatever you've been doing with this horse, keep doing it'. Rebel was my mustering horse 5 days a week, give him a wash Friday and he was a Rodeo horse on the weekend, most weekends for years he more than paid our way in run money.

For the last 6 years he has lived in our house yard, so we could pamper him and look after him — pay him back for all the wonderful years he has given us. As you can tell (and plenty of people will tell you) I thought the sun shone out of Rebel, on Monday I rang Doc and thanked him again for giving me the best gift (other than my children) anyone has given me — my once in a lifetime horse! He will be sadly missed.

 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.


Breaking Open:


