NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

CENTRAL ENTRIES EMAILS:

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

To NRA Members,

Please be advised that you are required to pay your nomination prior to your ride at a rodeo. The members who fail to pay their nomination on the day of the rodeo will be monitored by our Central Entries Staff.

Repeat offenders will have their privilege of paying nomination on the day revoked and will be required to pay nomination prior to the day of the rodeo. In extreme circumstances nominations may even be refused.

It is vital that all members competing at a rodeo pay their nomination before the start of the rodeo.

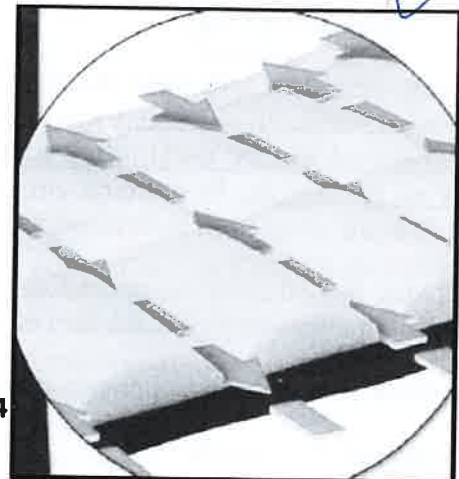

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.

- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

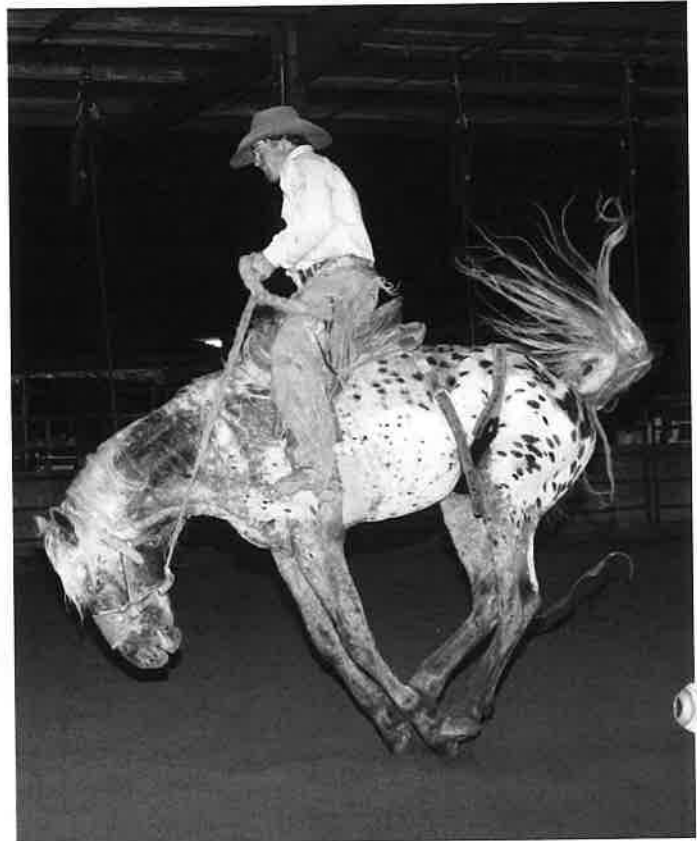

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
 - (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 - (3) Completes second year of membership
- In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

Paramedic (General Duties) - Is trained in advanced emergency care using protocols, procedures, pharmacology's. Has a superior knowledge of anatomy and physiology. They must have a Cert IV In Health Care (Ambulance) or equivalent.

Paramedic (Advanced Life Support) - Is trained in advanced emergency care using protocols, procedures, pharmacology's. Has excellent knowledge of anatomy and physiology. Has the ability to conduct staff mentoring and supervision. They must have at least 2 years full time use of skills as an PGD and completed advanced care modules of the Diploma.

Paramedic (Intensive Care) - Is trained to Paramedical level of emergency care using protocols, procedures, pharmacology's. Excellent knowledge of anatomy and physiology. They must have at least 3 years full time use of skills as an EMT and have completed a Diploma Health Science Ambulance HLT50407 or equivalent as well as modules from the Advanced Diploma. Has the ability to conduct staff mentoring and supervision.

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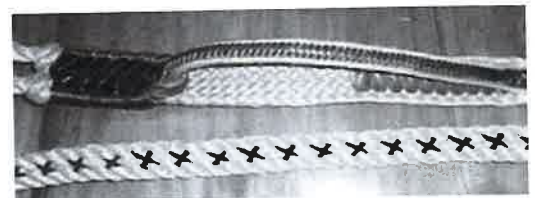
