





### NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

### CENTRAL ENTRIES EMAILS:

Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

### To NRA Members,

Please be advised that you are required to pay your nomination prior to your ride at a rodeo. The members who fail to pay their nomination on the day of the rodeo will be monitored by our Central Entries Staff.

Repeat offenders will have their privilege of paying nomination on the day <u>revoked</u> and will be <u>required to pay nomination prior to the</u> <u>day of the rodeo.</u> In extreme circumstances nominations may even be refused.

It is vital that all members competing at a rodeo pay their nomination before the start of the rodeo.



# Notes from the Office. Please read carefully!



### SHADOW BULL FIGHTER/PICK UP MAN AT RODEOS

If you would like to be a Shadow Bullfighter or Pick up Man at a specific Rodeo then you need to approach the Contractor for that Rodeo. The Contractor must then let the N.R.A. Office know.

Unless due to special circumstances, a maximum of three Bullfighters or Pick up Men (two official and one shadow) are to be in the arena at any one time.

All Shadow Officials must be N.R.A. Full or Associate Members.

## NOTICE TO ALL STOCK CONTRACTORS

Because of Insurance and Administration requirements it is necessary that any prospective Shadow Bullfighters or Pick up Men be registered with the N.R.A. Office seven (7) days prior to the Rodeo.

Requirements are:

- 1) Advise Office seven (7) days prior to Rodeo
- 2) At minimum, must be a Day Member plus pay insurance

### REMINDER TO ALL COMMITTEES AND RODEO PROMOTERS

Arena Size Rule:

Page 23, Rule 8 (b) Without prior approval of the Board, a Portable Arena, minimum height of 1800mm. Rodeos conducting any Timed Events must be a minimum of 50 metres from the Catch Pen to the front Time Box and a minimum width of 30 metres to comply with recommendations of the governing body.

Page 9, Rule 10 (b) The arena must be completely top dressed or ripped to a minimum of 75mm and a maximum of 100mm.



### IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events.

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS: Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS: Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE** PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride. Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

**Breaking Open:** 

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (\*R\*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.


