



This must be received by the office at least one week after the occurrence. Please contact the NRA Office if you have not reported the injury at the rodeo.

#### UNCOLLECTED PRIZE MONEY

Any prize money not collected at rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prize money is paid in cheque, the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by N.R.A. if the prize money is paid in cash.

Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and mailed out and a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prize money for expenses incurred.

#### IMPORTANT RULES

 All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

**Junior Competitors** who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events.

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
   <u>Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED</u>
   <u>HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during</u>
   the ride.
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
   <u>Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.</u>
   Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events\*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- <u>Note\*:</u> If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

- TEAM ROPERS must nominate with a partner. Team Ropers are allowed one run only.
- Points Any enquiries into points in the standings must be made to the NRA Office no later than Monday 7th November 2011. NO INVESTIGATION WILL BE TAKEN AFTER THIS TIME!
- Final Points will be tallied after GREENBANK, ALL POINTS will be calculated and checked before the finals.
- To be eligible for aggregate buckles, competitor MUST HAVE COMPETED IN ALL (3) rounds of the finals.







### ROOKIE AND NOVICE

#### **Rookie Competition:**

A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.

A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.

Points are accrued from Open Competition Only.

(Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).

A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open"

### Rookie Breaks Open

(1) Wins a title

(2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event

(3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

### ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

### Novice Competition:

A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.

A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

#### Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. 
