IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL NO NOMINATIONS WITH ANY OUTSTANDING MONEY OWING

ALL OUTSTANDING MONEY MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU ENTER YOUR NEXT RODEO

Please be aware that due to the alarming amount of outstanding money owed to the National Rodeo Association by competitors, the Board of Directors have made a decision to refuse anyone's entries for a rodeo until all outstanding money is paid. With credit card and direct deposit facilities available, there is no reason why these fines cannot be paid prior to entering a rodeo. Please don't ask the office when attempting to enter, if you can pay on the day of the rodeo as this method of payment will no longer be acceptable.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN ASSOCIATIONS REGARDING OUTSTANDING MONEY

Competitors in default should be aware that there is an agreement between the National Rodeo Association and other rodeo associations within Australia. This agreement prevents a competitor from entering any rodeos conducted by the affiliated associations, where the competitor is in default. The names of all competitors who have outstanding monies with the National Rodeo Association will be sent to the participating associations and you will be unable to compete in any of these associations until the outstanding amount is paid in full. This also applies to any competitor who has outstanding accounts with other associations.

GUARANTOR FOR DAY MEMBERS

The National Rodeo Association does not encourage financial members to act as a guarantor for a day member, especially with the introduction of credit card and direct deposit facilities, making it easy for day members to pay when they enter. However if you, as a financial member choose to act as a guarantor for a day member, it is YOUR responsibility to ensure that day member turns up at the rodeo and pays their entries. If the day member fails to turn up or pay their

entries, the financial member who acted as a guarantor for that day member is obligated to pay any outstanding money owing from the day member. As a member, you will then not be permitted to enter a rodeo until the outstanding money is paid. For this reason, please consider who you act as a guarantor for very carefully.

All of these areas have been discussed and passed as a board decision.

NRA AGM DIRECTORS REPORT

Bill Urquhart, Executive Director, Chairman of the Board of Directors - Report

The year of 2011 was not without its problems, for our Association and Rodeo in general.

Our year commenced with a large number of events cancelled due to the extreme wet weather, and a growing lack of interest in Rodeo by some Committee members also had an adverse effect on our sport.

A major concern of the NRA Board is the reduction in championship rodeos being conducted. Whilst we have addressed the matter by attending numerous meetings with Committee representatives, which is time consuming and not always productive after driving huge distances and we have supported a few Committees financially. There is only so much we can do, some might suggest not enough, however Director's and those doing the most work have a life outside Rodeo. Members don't help when making statements in earshot of Committee members, condemning their event as most Committee personnel are volunteers. You can rest assured we will not be giving up, and will continue our endeavors to stage a larger number of Championship rodeos.

This last year that is 2011, we had to replace Directors that resigned midterm, this is not an ideal situation, and to compound matters, most meetings we struggled to have enough attending to enable a meeting to be conducted, therefore I remind Directors of their responsibilities as a leader of your sport, attend meetings, be part of the decision making process, don't leave it up to the same few. On a personal note, I go into my last year as a Director of this wonderful Association filled with many great memories, hoping that my previous statement will inspire most Directors to support each other and as we have in the past, as a team not a one or two man band.

Financially the year was a disaster. The Association lost money, not for the first time, however it cannot continue in this vein. If it does, no doubt cuts will have to be made. As I mentioned at Nambour Finals we will be looking closely into our financial situation prior to purchasing trophies for 2012. The loss of the bar at the Urban Country Music Festival and our Finals Rodeo were major contributors to our financial position. Also a huge force was the reduction of rodeos conducted.

We have spoken of moving our office to the new Equestrian Centre, this has been put on the backburner for now and will continue to operate from our office in King Street.

A number of other elements made life difficult for the NRA Administration. The ongoing uninformed comments on Facebook, etc do little to give good publicity to the sport. When used to support, the Social Media is a wonderful tool. Animal Activists again to the fore, discontent over Board choices of venues, trophies and judging decisions are just a few.

Now it's time for the positives. Number one will be the Final series. Each rodeo had its own special qualities enabling the NRA to showcase its champions and members. Altogether in my opinion we had a very successful series and a job well done by all.

The year saw some fine competition and better than average crowds, therefore we congratulate all Committees, Promoters, Contractors, Officials, members and anyone that contributed.

I must make a special mention to our wonderful office staff, Indra & Tabatha and behind the scene Joc. These ladies do an exceptional job under, at times, trying circumstances without complaint. Thank you, ladies for a job well done.

Bill Urquhart report continued...

Many people believe Dale Frahm and I make a lot of decisions outside of meetings, this is true, however we at all times attempt to convene our intake within the realms of the NRA management and when this takes place it is for a speedy resolve. All other important factors are made in consultation with all Executives. I believe the NRA is fortunate to have a couple of Directors that have as much time as we do to devote to the Association. A special thanks from me to you Dale for your back up.

To end this report, I must thank the Board members for their time and effort. Whilst I mentioned earlier in my report about Directors short comings it must not be forgotten all of the positions are voluntary, time consuming and, at times, receive a lot of flack. Once again to the Girls and Guys that form our Board, please accept my heartfelt thanks.

Financial Report done by Bill

Loss of bar income meant that the money was down – turnover was \$383,000 for 2011 and 2010 was \$502,000

Washouts, cancelled rodeos, folded committees, caused loss of rodeo income.

Struggling committee confronted by contractors who tell them to drop their time event. Get quotes etc, don't stick to one contractor. Committees run the rodeos not contractors, Contractors are just hired for their rodeo.

Board installed NRA levy which has helped. We looked at boosting finals prize money. NRA levy was down to \$18,000.

We need to look at ways to cut cost and turn around funds, will be discussed if association can afford trophies, etc

Our expenditure didn't drop. We will be looking seriously at ways to make members pay before their ride. Also looking at adopting other association's steps (ie: don't pay / don't ride).

A lot of costs are one's we cannot do anything about, such as auditing costs. Looked at moving, looked at cutting costs with newsletter, we will have to make certain changes.

One thing that doesn't help, are people who have taken legal action for something that they thought they should have won.

Membership was down by \$3,500 for men, \$1,300 for women. Need to structure the loss.

Shandelle Voll - Executive Director Report

This has been my first year as a Director. There have definitely been ups and downs which have resulted in me growing bigger shoulders. All in all it has been a pretty successful year.

It's good to see people putting their hand up to help. There are a lot of people with things to say but they won't say it.

I would like to say thank you to Kim Clarke for her card. I look forward to 2012 with less rain.
Luke Gall - Executive Director Report

I was thrown in the deep end this year. On the livestock side of things with Animal Activists, if we can just keep them off our backs for a little longer, Members need to remember to do their part.

Dale Frahm - Executive Director Report

Further to what has been said about our finances and income – I just wish to endorse the difficulties we experienced last year and to some extent the year before in maintaining a steady income stream.

With the loss of this income, through bad weather and the loss of two very profitable liquor bars, I personally found it very difficult to justify – in my own mind the large expenditure on end of year trophies. However as a token of respect to our members the Board voted in favour – all to the good.

I just hope that the weather and other outside conditions are a lot kinder to us this year – both to the NRA and the affiliating committees.

Besides the weather conditions to make things difficult, we also had a major incident where some ill informed animal Activists made it difficult for the Ipswich City Council to decide on the future of rodeos in the greater Ipswich area.

Fortunately the rodeo fraternity rallied together and with some glowing references from the Monash University and the DPI in Qld we were able to sway the vote in council in our favour. Thank you to everyone and every organisation that rallied to the cause of Rodeo.

Although this problem was settled at the time – it will not go away, it will only intensify.

It is imperative that we in Rodeo be totally aware of our Animal welfare – health, size, appearance and handling techniques. If they win on one event they will move onto the next. Please be aware at all times.

Bill has mentioned the new Equestrian Centre in Caboolture. We have had several meetings with the new management and are currently looking at several options – however, whatever happens, because of our past history of working together and many years of loyalty, we have given a commitment to the Caboolture Show Society that we will work together on any future developments.

Finally I can't say enough about our office. Every year administration requirements increase, but every year the girls rise to the occasion. Ladies, you handle the rough spots as well as the smooth and it's to us on the outside you make it look easy. Thank you very much.

Thank you all for attending, and thank you for the support which you have provided during the year.

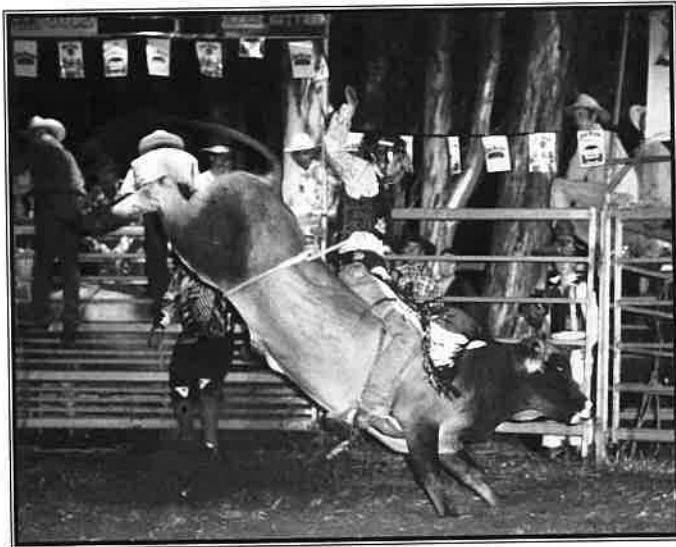

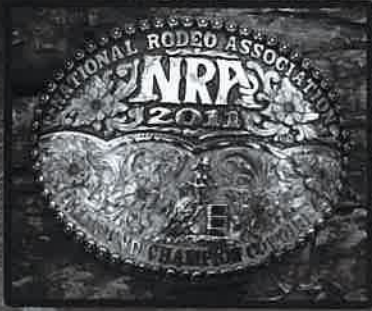
IMPORTANT RULES

- All Juniors (including Day members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride.
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open"

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.
