

Rough Stock Judges. This judging is to take place when you place your Finals nominations.


A last word on this year's Finals is to wish all Members, Committees, Contractors and Officials a successful series.



BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE Afull report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Old.

This month's Rodeo action kicked off at ROSEWOOD POINTS AWARD EVENT on September 29 which saw Cameron Taylor win the OPEN BULL RIDE on 79 points, Joel Hill the SADDLE BRONC on 75 and Ashley Clem on 71. The BARREL RACE was a hard fought event with all round champion cowgirl Cheyenne Whitwell taking the win on 16.300 which was just ahead on Maddison Swan on 16.359 seconds, Cheyenne also won the JUNIOR BARREL RACE.

The following weekend was action packed with KYOGLE BULL RIDE held on Friday October 5 with Frazer Babbington making a cracking ride for 81 points to take home over \$1200 in prize money.

BOONAH WILDSIDE series event was also held on the same night with Cameron Taylor taking out the BULL RIDE there on 75 points. Meantime Jack Capewell won the SADDLE BRONC on 77 points, Dinny Moran the BAREBACK on 78 while junior competitor Cheyenne Whitwell won the OPEN BARREL RACE with a 13.631 second run which was just ahead of Jenny Harth who ran 13.659. Fellow junior competitors Jackson Worsfold won the JUNIOR BULLRIDE with 75 points while Taylor Schultz took out the UNDER 16 EVENT with 70 point ride.


On the Saturday night GRANDCHESTER RODEO roared into action with Cameron Taylor continuing his fantastic run by taking out the BULL RIDE once again as did Dinny Moran in the BAREBACK, while Maddison Swan stepped up to come out on top in the BARREL RACE.

The following weekend was also a busy one for competitors with LOWOOD WILDSIDE SERIES being held on the Friday night. This event saw Frazer Babbington win the OPEN BULL RIDE while consistent competitor Joel Hill took out the SADDLE BRONC and novice competitor Richard Peterkin put up a strong performance to win the BAREBACK.

Many competitors then travelled to KUMBIA for the first ALL AROUND RODEO to be held there in quite some time. This event was exciting for the junior competitors as Sam Champ made the BULL RIDE his own by scoring 79 points to take the win while Cheyenne Whitwell took out the OPEN BARREL RACE. Toorbul bronc rider Brad Warburton won his pet event on a score of 77 as did Ashley Clem in the bareback with a score of 76. At the time event end of the arena Jesse Townsend was a standout performer, taking out first place in the ROPE AND TIE and second place in the STEER WRESTLING just behind Clinton Clem. Former local cowgirl Tammy Augustin won the BREAKAWAY ROPING in what was a toughly contested event. It took a smoking run by Lee Shegog and Jason McPhee to win the TEAM ROPING with a time of time of 5.583 seconds.

CANUNGRA BULL RIDE was also held on the Saturday in the evening with James Hayes taking home over \$2000 from the event with one of the biggest purses on offer. John Foster won the novice with 70 points while Jack McArthur covered two head in the junior to score 129 points.

A JUNIOR RODEO was held at KUMBIA on the Sunday which saw good nominations and competition from all junior members of the National Rodeo Association.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS: <u>Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN</u> <u>APPROVED HELMET with chin straps</u> <u>fastened at all times during the ride</u>
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:

 <u>Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE</u>

 <u>PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP</u>


 <u>FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride</u>

Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from

\$15.00 to \$75.00).

*NOTE: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.







From 1950's Bushman's Carnival to 2012 Kenilworth Rodeo

As remembered by Max Guldbransen, Toogoolawah Racehorse Trainer

In 1956, Mary Valley's
Kenilworth Rodeo Committee
was the first to introduce ZEBU
(now known as Brahmans) into
the bullock ride and Gordon
Bishop stock contractor then took
them to the Brisbane Ekka for the
first time to really test the riders,

This rodeo may well be remembered for its drama as Rex Hughes ended his rodeo career in the champion bullock final.

Rex, an experienced, good rider, was the "spurring kind" in cowboy terms, which set off the Zebu bullock and it was too quick, tipped him up and badly cut an artery on his head. They couldn't stop the bleeding and he was rushed to the Nambour Hospital and never rodeoed again. But he did live to talk about it and raise a family in Kilcoy.

Back then the Kenilworth rodeo was called the Kenilworth Bushman's Carnival and had a big campdraft and a bullock ride.

Famously Artie Hughes and Crown Jewel won three Kenilworth campdrafts in a row – 1956, 1957 and 1958.

Bill Boxsell ran the yards during these years and at night there was always a dance after the rodeo and the out-of-town cowboys camped overnight.

Of course they all tried to charm and chase the local girls. The sawmiller's daughter caught Max's eye one night and he remembers she had Hacks. Perhaps she too has good memories and keeps an interest in her horses still.

In 1957, Bob Burke from Woodford won the "big cup", an all round cowboy cup for the highest points and it was engraved with "Aggregate Points in Rough Riding 1957 Kenilworth Bushman's Carnival presented by W N Boxwell".

This was for both the buckjumping (now called saddle bronc) and the bullock ride but there were few buckjump competitions then and 90% bullock rides so Kenilworth always stood out on any young rider's calendar.

Rodeo as we know it, came in only during the 70's and by then Kenilworth Rodeo had also introduced the bronc riding, roping and bulldogging to its event line up.

At one of these 70's Kenilworth rodeos, my dad Max, had forgot to pack the bridle and had to use just the halter to dog off his half Arab Kaloga but the horse went fine, backed up into the box like the good boy he was and did his job well.

The late Buddy McLaughlin dogged off him too that day but neither man took out the money.

Later in the 80's Des Guldbransen, 19 years was carrying on the cowboy tradition of working hard during the week, playing hard on weekends and travelling all over the country in the name of sport or was it those sweet country girls?

He was luckier than his father, Max in the 50's at Kenilworth and did win the bullock ride in 1981 which featured on the front page of the Nambour Chronicle newspaper.

The 2012 rodeo at Kenilworth held in September was once again a success.
