Email nominations should have Name; Membership Number; Rodeo; Event; Rookie/Novice status only. Please call the NRA office for any queries e.g. cancellations.

Dear Friends in Rodeo

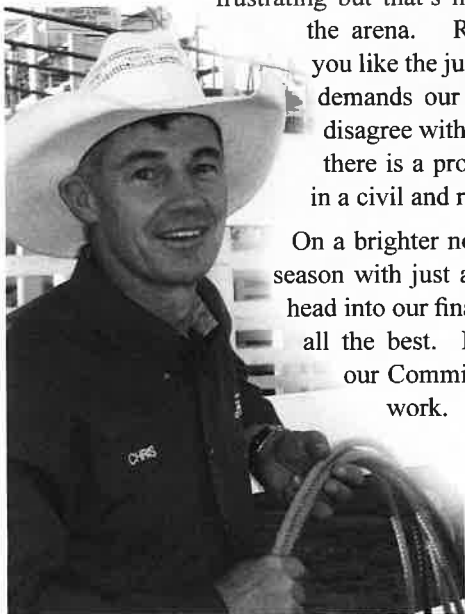

There was some very positive discussion as well as trialling a new device (many thanks to Trevor and Tina Ross for the use of their arena and stock). The device worked well and it is being tweaked at the moment. When it is introduced it will be the standard device across all Associations. There are also some other initiatives that will come into play to minimize any stress on stock. Ray Hopper, a Member of Parliament also attended the meeting. He has been commissioned to show why Rope and Tie may continue. After talking with us all and observing the new device he was reasonably confident that he could put a positive case forward. However it is imperative that we all, competitors, contractors, judges, etc. do everything possible to look after the stock. 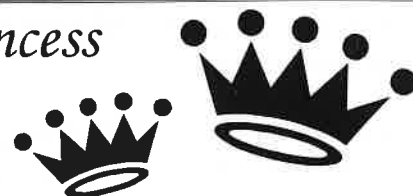

BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

THIS month was action packed with rodeo action in South East Queensland with six National Rodeo Association sanctioned events being held.

The Warwick St Mary's bull and bronc event kicked off the month with New South Wales' Corey Waterson taking the lion's share of the prize money with a win in the open bull ride with 85 points. Home town cowboy Mark Collins scored 84 points in the saddle bronc to take the win while Jack Kidd took out the bareback with 76 points, Scott Flight was the only score in the novice bull ride with 68 points, Beau Creighton the junior steer ride on 68 points and Cameron Southern the poddy ride on 65 points.

The Wondai Show bull ride also ran on the same night with Nanango local John Foster having a stellar night by taking out the open bull ride with a 74 point ride as well as winning the novice bull ride with a 72 point ride. Another local competitor, Jackson Worsfold, won the junior bull ride on 68 points while Joshua Jones won the junior steer ride and Triston Murray won the poddy ride.

The following weekend rodeo action moved to New South Wales for the Urbenville Bull Ride. The event saw Reece Weller top score for the night in the open bull ride with a 78 point ride. He was followed closely by fellow competitors Matthew Carlo, Matt Boland and John Foster. There were just two scores in the novice bull ride with Daryl Kerry winning the event and Jake Watts placing. Winners in other events on the night were Callum Miller in the junior bull ride, Matt Southern in the junior steer ride and Ty Thompson in the poddy ride.

The Noosa Show Rodeo was also held on the same night with Jeffrey Moretto scoring high to win the open bull ride while Dale Jones took out the saddle bronc, Ashley Clem was the only rider to cover two head in the bareback as was Keelan Alexander in the novice bull ride while Cody Groves won the poddy ride.

The only all around event for the month was Kenilworth Show Rodeo which saw good nominations and great weather for a full day of rodeo action.

Although no one cracked the 80 point mark in the rough stock there were a full board of placings in each event.

On the day Jayden Sims won the open bull ride, Cameron Taylor the saddle bronc and Ashley Clem the bareback. At the time event end of the arena the Augustin brothers were one and two in the rope and tie with Steve winning and Scott placing second. In the steer wrestling Dave Mawhinney continued his winning form from Mary Valley by taking the win. The barrel race was extremely close with Kim Clarke winning the event followed by novice competitor Maddison Swan who was just 0.009 behind Kim. The breakaway roping was also very close with junior competitor Shanae Payne winning the event with a 2.662 second run followed by Tammy Augustin on 2.677 seconds. Shanae had a great day in the breakaway roping, also taking the win in the junior breakaway with a 3.045 second run.

Other winners on the day included Lee Shegog and Matthew Speedy in the team roping, Sheri Johnson in the steer undecorating, Jackson Worsfold in the junior bull ride, Cheyenne Whitwell in the junior barrel race and Cody Groves in the poddy ride.

Later in the day competitors headed to Mulgowie for the Mulga Bull Ride.

The Mulga crowd witnessed Cameron Taylor scored 82 points in the open bull ride for the win, Scott Flight 72 in the novice for the win, Matt Southern 71 to win the junior, under 16 bull ride winner Lane Heaton 74 and Dan Ruhland was awarded 64 points to win the poddy ride.

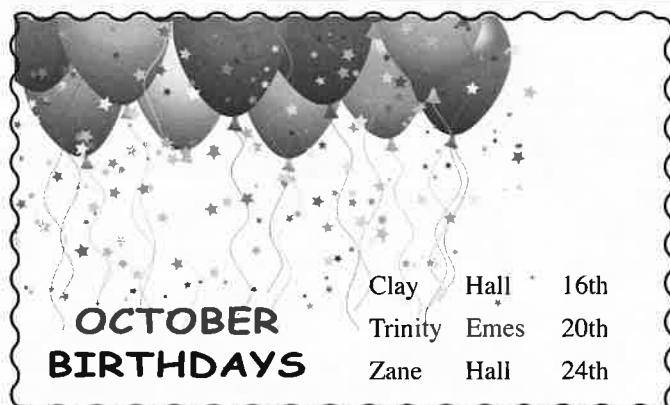

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events,

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all time during the ride.
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must WEAR A PROPERLY FITTED FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride. Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock Will be turned out.
- These rules include ALL Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST still abide by the Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN events must have an UPGRADED Open membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events*.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- Note*:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with this option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

As the 2012 season draws to an end, we have all our Junior Events going down to the wire. This always makes for a great competition and spectating, give it your all, but mostly have fun!!!

- Final Points will be tallied after GREENBANK, ALL POINTS will be calculated and checked before the finals.
- To be eligible for aggregate buckles, competitor MUST HAVE COMPETED IN ALL (3) rounds of the finals.

Aggregate Buckles will be supplied for ALL STANDARD EVENTS including TEAM ROPING (Header and Heeler) and Steer Undecorating.

(Finals nominations includes \$10.00 towards finals aggregate buckles and \$13.00 per entry fee for 2012 Final Shirt for these events)

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
 Points are accrued from Open Competition Only.
 (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open"

Rookie Breaks Open

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS.

Novice Competition:

- A novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of N.R.A. for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member.

Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All inquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the N.R.A. Office.

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register.
