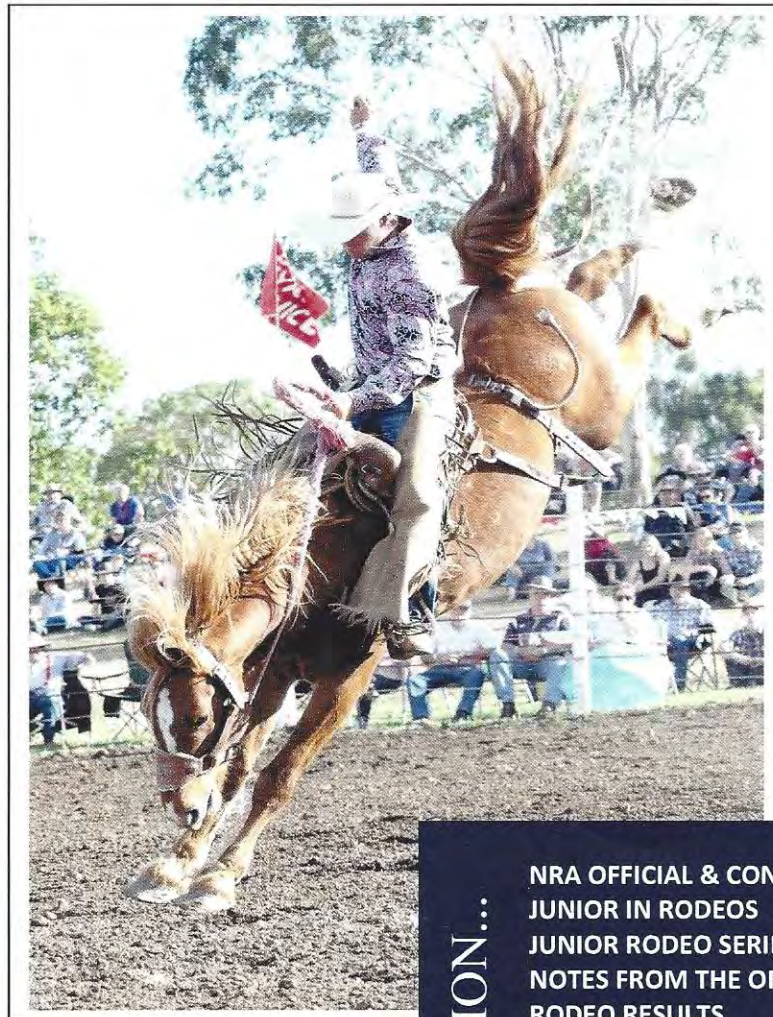

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification. **Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:**

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- **Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.**
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies'
Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

RULE CHANGE

ATTENTION ALL TIME EVENT STOCK CONTRACTORS

Following on from the recommendations from Steer Wrestling Stock forum conducted at Toogoolawah Rodeo on 28th September the following rule change was carried at a meeting of the Full Board on 8th October, 2013.

All **Steer Wrestling** Cattle horns shall be a minimum of 225mm on both horns. The measurement will be from the base of the horn to the tip of the horn.

The horn spread of **Steer Wrestling** cattle shall be a maximum of 800mm from tip to tip with a recommended length of 750mm.

Cattle Horns shall not be pushed with force through the front of the time event box but may only be guided by hand to keep their head straight.

Cattle tails are not to be touched. Stock may be pushed forward by getting behind the stock in the time event box or by placing an arm behind the back legs to push them forward.

Stock Contractors are expected to co-operate in trimming cattle's horns to allow them to freely pass through the Time Event Box. It is also recommended that all Time Event Boxes be a minimum of 750mm wide. The NRA will work with all of our committees over the coming year to help implement this recommendation.

The horn spread of cattle used in both the **Team Roping** and **Steer Undecorating** shall also comply with the above rule.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

With finals just around the corner, weekend competition is tougher than ever as competitors battle it out to take home the end of year awards.

The Kyogle bullride at the end of September saw Matthew Young go home in first place for the open Bull Ride followed by Frazer Babbington, Jeffrey Moretto and Ryan Dickens. Brad Witchard took out the Novice Bull Ride, Dylan Talbot the junior bull Ride and Matthew Emes the Under 16 junior bull Ride.

At the Rosewood Wildside series event the open bull ride was won by Jeffery Moretto over two head, while Jack Capewell was the winner of the Saddle bronc and Jordon Moore the Open Barrel race. Meantime in the junior events Jack McArthur took out the Junior Bull Ride, while Lane Mellers was the winner of the under 16 junior bull ride and Blake Weier the Poddy Ride.

Toogoolawah Charity Rodeo was the first all round event for the competition month. The open bull ride and bareback proved to be tough going with Jackson Worsfold the only competitor to ride time in the bull ride and Steele Allston in the bareback. Mark Collins put on a good performance in the saddle bronc to be ahead of Michael Maher, John McNamee and Joel Hill. Jesse Townsend had a good day at the timed event end of the arena to win the Rope & Tie and place second in the Steer Wrestling behind Thomas Whitwell with Thomas also taking out a win in the team roping with Gene Hingst. It proved to be a day for multiple placing with Kylie Siebenhausen winning the open and junior breakaway roping and placing second in the open barrel race behind Jordon Moore.
